COACH FRANK HOWARD'S QUOTES ON WAKE FOLEST GAME :

I thou, ht & our first team defense was excellent for a first game showing except for that one play when their boy Johnson scored in the third quarter. Of course, we've got some work to do and it as ain't gonna be easy with the manner schedule we got facing us for the next five games. But our defense has a lot going for the next five games.

It was obvious why we didn't pass much. When you got a sophmore quarterback in there like Waters, you hate to go in there and throw disgression to the winds. It'll shake up a kid without much experience. So we pust cranked up there our running game and let it go at that.

The reason I didn't put Addison back in there was simple.

We were winning with Waters and on top of that he was looking good. So why put in an injured man who can get patched up and do something for you later in the season. I don't think ADDison is hurt bad, just a bruise I think. He did a heckuva job on the sidelines coaching Waters. I'm just thankful Waters came through for us.

We finally made up our minds what to run. We figured that sticking with the sweeps, no fancy stuff and what to run. But like I said, we gotta a long, long way to goos

"Even though we were beaten, I feel we played a much better game than we did in the opener last week. We were more alert and showed more aggressiveness. We did not make as many glaring mistakes on either offense or defense as we did last week.

"Our fumble and the penalty picked Clemson up considerably. They were the two big plays in the game as far as I am concerned.

"We moved the ball well at times but we not consistenty. The changing and switching of the Clemson defense gave us trouble, but we would have done a great deal better with a little better blocking from the offensive line.

"I feel we are the type of team that will get better each week.

"I am not taking a thing away from Duke, but Clemson appears to be a much better club. It is much stronger. The Clemson backs ran well, and I was certainly impressed by that Number LL (Gore). The QB who replaced Addison did an outstanding job. Clemson has an excellent offensive line.

"I still think we have a good team. Our kids will bounce back and we'll win a few. $^{\rm 18}$

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COACH FRANK HUWARD'S QUOTES ON WAKE FOREST GAME:

I thought sour first team defense was excellent for a first game showing except for that one play when their boy Johnson scored in the third quarter. Of course, we've got some work to do and it as ain't gonna be easy with the maker schedule we got facing us for the next five games.

But our defense has a lot going for the next five games.

It was obvious why we didn't pass much. When you got a sophmore quarterback in there like Waters, you hate to go in there and throw disgression to the winds. It'll shake up a kid without much experience. So we a just cranked up these our running game and let it go at that."

The reason I didn't put Addison back in there was simple.

We were winning with Waters and on top of that he was looking good. So why put in an injured man who can get patched up and do somethin, for you later in the season. I don't think Addison is hurt bad, just a bruise I think. He did a heckuva job on the sidelines coaching Waters. I'm just thankful Waters came through for us."

Our offense started to go early in the second quarter when we finally made up our minds what to run. We figured that sticking with the sweeps, no fancy stuff and what would work. But like I said, we gotta a long, long way to go.

"Even though we were beaten, I feel we played a much better game than we did in the opener last week. We were more alert and showed more aggressiveness. We did not make as many glaring mistakes on either offense or defense as we did last week.

"Our fumble and the penalty picked Clemson up considerably. They were the two big plays in the game as far as I am concerned.

"We moved the ball well at times but we not consistenty. The changing and switching of the Clemson defense gave us trouble, but we would have done a great deal better with a little better blocking from the offensive line.

"I feel we are the type of team that will get better each week.

"I am not taking a thing away from Duke, but Clamson appears to be a much better club. It is much stronger. The Clamson backs ran well, and I was certainly impressed by that Number LA (Gore). The QB who replaced Addison did an outstanding job. Clamson has an excellent offensive line.

"I still think we have a good team. Our kids will bounce back and we'll win a few. $^{\rm 11}$
