Coach Frank Howard on Georgia-Clemson game:

" Well, I thought we played a pretty good game, a lot better ~~is~~ than last week. Our defense is solid, but there in the fourth quarter they got tired and those Bulldogs found the holes.

" We were in bad shape on passing. Our quarterbacks are gonna have to learn to throw that ball before we go out there and start a passing ~~is~~ game. Those two interceptions in the first half hurt us; they went on to score touchdowns after those interceptions.

* " I think the turning point in the game was that 15-yard ~~is~~ holding penalty on us late in the third quarter. Gore had just busted off right tackle for 18 yards and we were punching 'em pretty hard. But a play like that ~~is~~ can take the wind out of your sails.

" I guess Georgia is a fifth-ranked team. They were tougher than I expected to tell the truth. Their passing game was good, but they stuck to a grinding offense and that surprised me. As far as individuals for them go, I can't single out any one. They're all ~~is~~ tough and that's why Georgia is ranked so high."

" We got some tough games ahead of us; ~~is~~ Georgia Tech is this coming week. But we're gonna be OK. I thought we were much improved over last week. Jacky Jackson's running was an example. He ~~is~~ looked a lot better out there today."

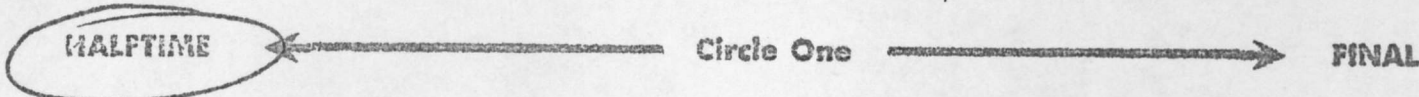

Coach Frank Howard on Georgia-Clemson game:

" Well, I thought we played a pretty good game, a lot better ~~is~~ than last week. Our defense is solid, but there in the fourth quarter they got tired and those Bulldogs found the holes.

" We were in bad shape on passing. Our quarterbacks are gonna have to learn to throw that ball before we go out there and start a passing ~~is~~ game. Those two interceptions in the first half hurt us; they went on to score touchdowns after those interceptions.

* " I think the turning point in the game was that 15-yard ~~is~~ holding penalty on us late in the third quarter. Gore had just busted off right tackle for 18 yards and we were punching 'em pretty hard. But a play like that ~~is~~ can take the wind out of your sails.

" I guess Georgia is a fifth-ranked team. They were tougher than I expected to tell the truth. Their passing game was good, but they stuck to a grinding offense and that surprised me. As far as individuals for them go, I can't single out any one. They're all ~~is~~ tough and that's why Georgia is ranked so high."

" We got some tough games ahead of us; ~~is~~ Georgia Tech is this coming week. But we're gonna be OK. I thought we were much improved over last week. Jacky Jackson's running was an example. He ~~is~~ looked a lot better out there today."

COACH DOOLEY'S STATEMENT

"The most important thing about this victory is that our team didn't lose its poise, and a lesser team would have certainly cracked. We really are not the ball club yet that people think we are and we are very fortunate to beat a good Clemson team over here.

"We couldn't be prouder with the score because we were playing a team ~~which~~ which is one of the best I've seen since I've been at Georgia.

"Clemson was in better ~~was~~ condition than we were. They looked sharper and they really exerted pressure on us in the third quarter. That is where our team did what it had to do to win the game and that takes poise.

"Clemson could become a great team. I know they are as tough as we've seen in a long time. I thought that they were going to take the game away from us in the third quarter. We were ahead 17-0 at halftime and then all of sudden we ~~were~~ were tied and Clemson looked like they were getting stronger.

"There are many players who played well for us and I think Kirby Moore deserves a ~~big~~ special tribute because he ~~did~~ came up with the big play when he had to. Dennis Hughes caught the ball well and Bent Lawrence really wanted to score on that last touchdown. He's a tough little runner.

Dooley praised the Clemson running backs ~~particularly~~ Gore and Jackson and the Tiger QBs Addison and Waters. "They really put on a show (Gore and Jackson) with their running and that Waters came us with some great plays when he had too. He really looks like a fine young ~~quarterback~~ quarterback."

The Georgia team gave the game ball to ~~offensive~~ inferior offensive line coach Ken Cooper who moved up to the varsity this year. "I think he has worked harder than anybody," said the Bulldogs All American tackle Edgar Chandler in making the presentation.
