"Well, I hate to see good bunch of boys go out there against top comstition and lose like that. We just beat em on defensey but they got what counts—the score. I thought our defense played the finest game I ve ever seen any team play. They never quit and weren't impressed one bit by a big-name team. I was real proud of em."

Although we contained him better than I expected, he made a couple of big plays and they hurt. I thought John Fulmer did a heckuva job for us when Rayburn got hurt."

"We got more breaks than we deserved. Nobody can complain about 'Bama getting all the breaks cause they didn't. But we when you got those breaks, you gotta have the punch to take advantage of them and score. I was very proud of the whole team and if they play like what they did out there today, we're gonna win the rest of 'em.'

QUOTES FROM AIABAMA COACH PAUL BRYANT:

(To Frank Howard, who scame into the alabama dressing room) "If coaching had anything to do with it, you'd have won the game."

"We were tickled to death to win, but of course we are proud any time we get victory. Actually, we were lucky to win. Clemson outbattled us in the second half. I thought they had a better plan.

"We had no sustained drives, qx particalarly at the last when we decided not to pass. They hurt us defensively and but keeping the ball a lot.

"Wehad a few big plays in the first half and then again at the last of the game, which helped.

"I think they were calling automatics at the line and we were not changing defenses fast enough. I think we can throw on anybody but we'd also like to run that way.

"Well, I hate to see good bunch of boys go out there against top cometition and lose like that. We just beat em on defense but they got what counts—the score.
