### COA CHES CUOTES

CLEMSON'S FRANK HOWARD: I was looking for a letdown today (after the Alabama performance), but I wasn't expecting a collapse. Still, when you get 17 points, you gotta be thankful.

North Carolina played a little better than I thought they would and we're mighty happy to win. We've played good at times and lost and I guess you're supposed to win sometimes when you don't play so good.

Howard was asked about the discussion on the fair catch: He said the official said the Carolina back did not signal for a fair catch. Therefore, the ball can be picked up and returned. "I'm not too sure of the rule, but I'm gonna be a little surer next week."

Howard asked the sportswriters if this was the best game North Carolina had played, and didn't get an xweek answer either way.

Somebody asked Howard good for him, he said, "The boy I left at home (Actually, none of the travel squad was left)

Asked about Gore running so much, Howard said: "anytime he gets his hand on the ball, he's liable to go all the way. But he's gotta have good blocking to it do it, and he didn't have much of it today.

Quizzed as what he told the team at halftime, Howard said: "Nothing different, just tried to get them to wake up and play a little better. We just stood around the first half—didn't block, didn't tackle. It was a little bit worse than I had expected them to do."

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NORTH CAROLINA'S COACH BILL DOOLEY: "Its hard to be proud in defeat, but I was definitely proud of our effort today and I told the players so in the dressing room. They took the fight to Clemson and the only thing that beat us was that we stopped ourselves near the goaline.

"It was the same old story today, really. We moved the ball wratinto scoring position three times but just didn's get it into the endzone. The fumble at the one was definitely the turning point in the game. That would have given us first down and we would have had four cracks at scoring.

When asked about going into the shotgun offense, Dooley said: "Clemson is so big and strong that we felt we had to do something different to keep them off balance. I think that strategy worked because we moved close enough to score, but just didn't. Clemson certainly has a fine football team and I was amazed at just how many good players they had. They kept throwing new faces at us and it certainly showed because they wore us down in the last period."

#### COACHES CUOTES

CLEMSON'S FRANK HOWARD: I was looking for a letdown today (after the Alabama performance), but I wasn't expecting a collapse. Still, when you get 17 points, you gotta be thankful.

North Carolina played a little better than I thought they would and we're mighty happy to win. We've played good at times and lost and I guess you're supposed to win sometimes when you don't play so good.

Howard was asked about the discussion on the fair catch: He said the official said the Carolina back did not signal for a lair catch. Therefore, the ball can be picked up and returned. "I'm not too sure of the rule, but I'm gonna be a little surer next week."

Howard asked the sportswriters if this was the best game North Carolina had played, and didn't get an xxxxx answer either way.

Somebody asked Howard good for him, he said, "The boy I left at home (Actually, none of the travel squad was left)

Asked about Gore running so much, Howard said: "anytime he gets his hand on the ball, he's liable to go all the way. But he's gotta have good blocking to it, and he didn't have much of it today.

Quizzed as what he told the team at halftime, Howard said: "Nothing different, just tried to get them to wake up and play a little better. We just stood around the first half—didn't block, didn't tackle. It was a little bit worse than I had expected them to do."

\* \*

NORTH CAROLINA'S COACH BILL DOOLEY: "Its hard to be proud in defeat, but I was definitely proud of our effort today and I told the players so in the dressing room. They took the fight to Clemson and the only thing that beat us was that we stopped ourselves near the goaline.

"It was the same old story today, really. We moved the ball willinto scoring position three times but just didn't get it into the endzone. The fumble at the one was definitely the turning point in the game. That would have given us first down and we would have had four cracks at scoring.

When asked about going into the shotgun offense, Dooley said: "Clemson is so big and strong that we felt we had to do something different to keep them off balance. I think that strategy worked because we moved close enough to score, but just didnot. Clemson certainly has a fine football team and I was amazed at just how many good players they had. They kept throwing new faces at us and it certainly showed because they were us down in the last period."
