COACHES POST GAME COMMNTS

We just don't get the break on clese calls. I did not think the officiating was too good.#

(The TD play, with Fitzpatrick tossing to Gillespie, was one of the surprises concocted for Clemson this past week).

(This was only the second touchdown of the year for Maryland and Gillespie is the only other player besides wick Carlson to have scored for the Terps)

CLEMSON COACH FRANK HOWARD: "Well, we were just lucky to win that one. Of course, we pulled off some good plays out there, but we just weren't sharp. We gonna have to get better for those Wolfpack IR fellows next week. A was sorry to hear that N.C. State lost. I was he hoping they would come down here with a clean slate.
