Post Game Notes

Gore had 1,045 yards rushing for the season, adding 189 today with his 856 coming into the game. This is an ACC record, breaking by one yard the mark of 1,044 set by Brian Piccolo of Wake Forest in 1964.

Gore broke the single season rushing mark at Clemson of 845 yards ~~xxx~~ held by Fred Cone in 1950. Gore's two year total is now 1,795, which is fourth high in Clemson history. Gore has one more year to play. The all-time leader is Fred Cone with 2,172 yards.

Gore's 186 yard total is his game career high. He had 131 yards against North Carolina this year.

Gore had 230 rushes for the year which is a Clemson record. The old mark was 194 set by Hugh Mauldin in 1965

Mike Fair finished 2,586 yards passing. Broke by 25 yards school record held by Dan Reeves, set in 1964.

Jimmy Addison completed 202 passes of 393 for 2,616 yards which is a school record by a three-year or ~~xxx~~ four-year back. His completion mark was 51.4%, also a school record

Zeigler's four receptions gives him 35 for the year, leader in the conference. Second high for South Carolina in a season. J. R. Wilburn had 38

Muir's 805 yards was second high in USC history. Second to Wadiak's 998 yards in 1950.

## Post Game Notes

Gore had 1,045 yards rushing for the season, adding 189 today with his 856 coming into the game. This is an ACC record, breaking by one yard the mark of 1,044 set by Brian Piccolo of Wake Forest in 1964.

Gore broke the single season rushing mark at Clemson of 845 yards ~~held~~ held by Fred Cone in 1950. Gore's two year total is now 1,795, which is fourth high in Clemson history. Gore has one more year to play. The all-time leader is Fred Cone with 2,172 yards.

Gore's 186 yard total is his game career high. He had 131 yards against North Carolina this year.

Gore had 230 rushes for the year which is a Clemson record. The old mark was 194 set by Hugh Mauldin in 1965

Mike Fair finished 2,586 yards passing. Broke by 25 yards school record held by Dan Reeves, set in 1964.

Jimmy Addison completed 202 passes of 393 ~~in~~ for 2,616 yards which is a school record by a three-year or ~~four~~ four-year back. His completion mark was 51.4%, also a school record

Zeigler's four receptions gives him 35 for the year, leader in the conference. Second high for South Carolina in a season. J. R. Wilburn had 38

Muir's 805 yards was second high in USC history. Second to Wadiak's 998 yards in 1950.
