To Robert C. Edwards, president of Clemson, was in the interview, and made a statement of confidence in the Clemson coaching staff, the Clemson football than and Coach Howard.

STATEMENT BY COACH EARLE EDWARDS OF N. C. STATE

It was great disappointment. We had great chances. You have got to make good

then you get the opportunities. We had too many chances to do well. When they stop you it is good defense and the stop you deploy it is rotten offense. Mean we deploy the stop you
