STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

The condition of tailback Buddy Gore, and his status for the rest of the season, has not yet been determined. Trainer Fred Hoover said that he had an injured knee, but that the full extent would not be known until he was taken to the hospital and x-rayed.

Coach Bob Ward of Maryland told Howard at midfield, "I've been telling people all week long you have a mighty powerful team and you proved it today."

Howard said later:

I don't think we played too well, especially in the first half, but we started blocking better in the second half and began opening some holes. Course, this Yauger got a lot of yardage on his own. I'm sure glad he's gonna be around for two more years.

"Our pass defense is getting a little better each week. But with all of those good passers we've been seeing this year, guess they're bound to learn something.

"Our offensive line is blocking now about as good as any we've ever had. That was a question mark at the first of the year, but they do a pretty consistent job for us now. And they've been most of the year.

"This seventh game always seems like a bad one for us. Last year against North Carolina, and it was on the road too, we didn't look too well, but we won. And you can always be thankful for that."

"The 16-0 ~~score~~ was no disgrace...I'm not happy with it, but our players fought hard the whole time. I'm disappointed in the way in which we protected (didn't protect) our passers, but it was our defensive unit's best game. Defensively, we played well throughout, with only one let-up.

Clemson is tough on defense, a lot like N.C.State. We were hitting them hard at the end, but it was against their second-stringers. Yauger is a good, tough runner and hard to stop.

The officiating was lousy, but that's the way it's been all year. We score touchdowns and they call 'em back. On almost every pass they seem to detect someone holding or illegally downfield. It doesn't do any good to file an official complaint, but I'm going to keep up my beefs.

We alternated O'Hara and Astrana, because Alan hadn't practiced all week and O'Hara needs a little experience.

Maybe if we got ahead sometime (if the officials wouldn't nullify almost every go-ahead TD we make) we could play a different type of game, but it seems we're always struggling to catch up.

I thought Gareis, Chadick and Van Sickler played outstanding games on defense and Demszuk also played well. If we had just been able to generate some type of offense. . .

Merritt's going to be all right and probably make a good pro prospect.

STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

The condition of tailback Buddy Gore, and his status for the rest of the season, has not yet been determined. Trainer Fred Hoover said that he had an injured knee, but that the full extent would not be known until he was taken to the hospital and x-rayed.

Coach Bob Ward of Maryland told Howard at midfield, "I've been telling people all week long you have a mighty powerful team and you proved it today."

Howard said later

I don't think we played too well, especially in the first half, but we started blocking better in the second half and began ~~making~~ opening some holes. Course, this Yauger got a lot of yardage on his own. I'm sure glad he's gonna be around for two more years,

"Our pass defense is getting a little better each week. But with all of those good passers we've been seeing this year, guess they're bound to learn something.

"Our offensive line is blocking now about as good as any we've ever had. That was a question mark at the first of the year, but they do a pretty consistent job for us now. And they ~~xx~~ h ve been most of the year.

"This seventh game always seems like a bad one ~~zif~~ for us. Last year against North Carolina, and it was on the road too, we didn't look ~~gam~~ too well, but we won. And you can always be thankful for that."

"The 16-0 ~~score~~ was no disgrace...I'm not happy with it, but our players fought hard the whole time. I'm disappointed in the way in which we protected (didn't protect) our passers, but it was our defensive unit's best game. Defensively, we played well throughout, with only one let-up.

Clemson is tough on defense, a lot like N.C. State. We were hitting them hard at the end, but it was against their second-stringers. Yauger is a good, tough runner and hard to stop.

The officiating was lousy, but that's the way it's been all year. We score touchdowns and they call 'em back. On almost every pass they seem to detect someone holding or illegally downfield. It doesn't do any good to file an official complaint, but I'm going to keep up my beefs.

We alternated O'Hara and Lastrana, because Alan hadn't practiced all week and O'Hara needs a little experience

Maybe if we got ahead sometime (if the officials wouldn't nullify almost every go-ahead TD we make) we could play a different type of game, but it seems we're always struggling to catch up.

I thought Gareis, Chadie Sand and Van Sickler played outstanding games on defense and Demczuk also played well. If we had just been able to generate some type of offense. . .

Merritt's going to be all right and probably make a good pro prospect.

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
