And in a 20-minute period from 2:50 to 3:10 p.m., 0.87 inches of rain fell with another 0.08 inches during the next 30-minute period giving a total of 0.95 inches. By 3:05 p.m., hail completely covered the playing field. By the way, this was the only rain that occurred in Clemson during Oct. 1963.
