

CLEMSON HEAD COACH FRANK HOWARD'S COMMENTS:

"I sure feel better than I in did one week ago. Wake Forest has got a good team, better than I thought they had. I didn't know they would be nearly as strong as they showed us they were.

heck of a teamo

"We didn't play too badly, but I didn't like the way Wake Forest ran around out ends. (Ivan) Southerland was out so we put Charlie Mayer in and used three other boys, (Winston) Lawton, (Don) Ethredge and (George) Ducworth on the other side.

Mayer did a heck of a job and he played their end sweeps better than anyons else.

"One thing that might have hart us some was our first touchdown. I believe we got it too easy. But the way we ran up and down the field, we should have besten them.

(Rick) Medlin was doing a good job before he hurt his ankle. We got more out of our

fullback today than we have in juite a while.

"(Ray) Yauger had another fine game. I would like to have Yauger and (Jack) Anderson back there together. If you don't have two great backs, then you give the ball to one and that's what we did with Yauge.

CLEMSON HEAD COACH FRANK HONARD'S COMMENTS:

"I sure feel better than I is did one week ago. Wake Forest has got a good team, better than I thought they had. I didn't know they would be nearly as strong as they showed us they were.

"We really needed a win and we got joo But I still say that Wake Forest has got one

heck of a teamo

"We didn't play too badly, but I didn't like the way Wake Forest ran around out ends. (Ivan) Southerland was out so we put Charlie Mayer in and used three other boys, (Winston) Lawton, (Don) Ethredge and (George) Ducworth on the other side.

Mayer did a heck of a job and he played their end sweeps better than anyone else.

It's good to have a bench so you am put some boys in there when you need them.

"One thing that might have but us some was our first touchdown. I believe we got it too easy. But the way we ran up and down the field, we should have beaten them.

(Rick) Medlin was doing a god job before he hurt his ankle. We got more out of our

fullback today than we have in puite a while.

"(Ray) Yauger had another ine game. I would like to have Yauger and (Jack) Anderson back there together. If you don't have two great backs, then you give the ball to one and that's what we did with Yauge.

"I think the biggest play in the game was the catch by (Jim) Sursavage. It was supposed to be caught by Charlie Mate's. But Sursavage caught it and it turned out to be a great

play because we went on to reak the tie.

"The game was tied for ome time, but you know, I always think I'm joing to win. I may not win all the time, but I think that I am going to."

WAKE FOREST COACH CAL TOLL'S COMMENTS:

"We stopped oursel'ss more than the opposition stopped us. Again, we made the mistakes which cost a victory in our last two games.

"I thought at haftime we would win . . . we we been a good second half team all season. We didn't have a let down. We just fumbled it away again.

"Our kids plays well again. We moved the ball, but just didn't get enough points to win. Our passag game is improving every week.

"The turning pint? When that kid (Clemson's Sursavage) made a great catch on us on that fourth-sd-ten play which set up their go-shead touchdown. Had he not come down with that is, the game would have probably ended li-li.

"Hauger is the hardest running back we have faced this season. Why, he's bigger than most of to boys we had trying to tackle him. And he ran right through tackles several times.

"Was there anything pleasing about today's game? Mes. The fact that we never quit. We gave an all-out effort all the way...and really, that's all I can ask of to boys."
