"I was tremendously proud of the team for theman comeback they made. It took a lot of class. We came right out at the opening gong and got after them.

"I think the defense improved a lot. They sure put a lot into it. I think the poorest thing we did was gettin, all those penalties. .. e had some blocking and this Musso made some kinnight tough runs when it was close. Yauger did, too.

"Clenson was hitting as hard at the last as they were when the game started, but then that is one of Coach Howard's trademarks...they never gave up.
