STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOUARD

I believe we not beat worst today than we did last week. I thought after the Duke game we'd wake up and play, but we didn't. We just got a good beating like we've been giving them in the past.

But we just sat there and took the licks and didn't give any. We just didn't play well.

North Carolina is probably playing the best ball of anybody in the conference now. They moved the ball on us pretty good. I don't know why boys react some Saturdays and others they don't.

Somebody asked Howard about the limp he had and he replied that he was still hurting some when that Maryland player went out of bounds two weeks ago and ran into him. He said a victory would have helped the hurting stop some.

Hugh Morton came up to shake Howard's hand at midfield and Howard told him. "Looks like you're beating me at both fishing and football now." This was in reference to a statement made by Howard about fishing with Coach Bill Dooley: "He's my fishing buddy. He beats me fishing and I beat him in football."

#### STATEMENT BY COACH BILL DOOLEY

This was a very big win for us because we have a streak going and it gives us extra momentum going into the Duke game. I'm very proud of the way our football team played today.

Our defense did a great job in the second half, coming back to shut them out. There were some very big plays for us, certainly the interceptions were key plays in them game.

Johnny Swofford was doing a great job for us before he got hurt. He has an injured wrist and it may be chipped. Lanier came in to play well.

I was pleased with the way we were able to run on Clemson. Not many people have done that. The teams which have beaten Clemson did it by throwing the ball.

Believe me, I have great respect for any team coached by Frank Howard. He's one of the great coaches and one of the most colful men in the game. I told him after the game that I hope the reports about him giving up coaching are not true. I'd like to see him continue. He's good for this conference and good for the game of football.

McCauley had another great day. Isn't he something? That second touchdown run of his was an outstanding individual effort. Yauger is a great player, too, and I'm just happy we were able to do as well as we did against
