Quotes from Clemson Head Coach Frank Howard:

"South Carolina just simply played better than we did. They were a better team than us today and all my good wishes go with them to the Peach Bowl.

"I don't see how they can talk about how big we are because they are

bigger than us.

"It was the boys' idea for the white shoes, but I want told them that they would look mighty silly wearing white shoes if they got beat. The

last time we wore colored (orange) shoes we won, but it wasn't the shoes, it was what was in them. It's not the shoes but the people in them.
"We worked on playing with kak two tight ends this week behind locked gates, but one of them got hurt early (Jimmy Trembley) and we had to get off that. I only had one tight end so we had to go to something else.

"We played about like we have the last two Saturdays and that hasn't

been good.

"Another thing, I'll retire when I get good and ready and not before. Nox Z I didn't say I would be the coach next year, but I'll retire when I get ready.

Coach Paul Dietzel: "It was a great victory. I told our players in the dressing room 'now we can talk about the Peach Bowl. I'm glad we ended up on a fine note and I understand West Virginia cans from behind to beat Syracuse (13010). That makes them 9-1 and they will be a real challenge but it will a pleasure to meet them in the Peach Bowl. I am sure there willbe thousands of Gamecocks in Grant Field for that one.

"It was a rather strange game. My wife asked me this morning if they were rady to play and I told her they had better be. In the first quarter it looked like we might blow them off the field, but we lost our momentum for a while and you can't do that against any good team and Clemson is a fine team -- and all of a sudden it was 17-13.

"I think there were two plays that changed the complexion of the game. Bill Parker was involved in both of them. The first was when he had his punt blocked when we missed two assignments at the line of scrimmage. Clemson seized the initiative then. The second was Parker's pass to Zeigler on the fake punt for a vital first down. Parker is an old high school quarterback and we have been practicing that a long time without using it. The signal to try it is when Parker goes into the game, I yell to him to 'do your thing', and he did it perfectly.

"Zeigler, of course, was great all day. But he is always a great receiver. Muir as usual had an outstanding day. I say again he is best inside runner in the United States and a true All America.

"Tommy Suggs is a great leader, a scrambler and a fine all-around quarterback. I felt all dong we could throw on Clemson and Tommy carried out our game plan perfectly, throwing for more than 200 yards.

"We will take a couple of weeks off and then get down to work for our bowl game. It's a great feeling."

Quotes from Clemson Head Coach Frank Howard:

"South Carolina just simply played better than we did. They were a better team than us today and all my good wishes go with them to the Peach Bowl.

"I don't see how they can talk about how big we are because they are

bigger than us.

"It was the boys' idea for the white shoes, but I that told them that they would look mighty silly wearing white shoes if they got beat. The last time we wore colored (orange) shoes we won, but it wasn't the shoes, it was what was in them. It's not the shoes but the people in them.

"We worked on playing with kax two tight ends this week behind locked gates, but one of them got hurt early (Jimmy Trembley) and we had to get off that. I only had one tight end so we had to go to something

else.

"We played about like we have the last two Saturdays and that hasn't

been good.

"Another thing, I'll retire when I get good and ready and not before. Not I didn't say I would be the coach next year, but I'll retire when I get ready."

Coach Paul Dietzel: "It was a great victory. I told our players in the dressing room 'now we can talk about the Peach Bowl. I'm glad we ended up on a fine note and I understand West Virginia came from behind to beat Syracuse (13910). That makes them 9-1 and they will be a real challenge but it will a pleasure to meet them in the Peach Bowl. I am sure there willbe thousands of Gamecocks in Grant Field for that one.

"It was a rather strange game. My wife asked me this morning if they were rady to play and I told her they had better be. In the first quarter it looked like we might blow them off the field, but we lost our momentum for a while and you can't do that against any good team and Clemson is a fine team -- and all of a sudden it was 17-13.

"I think there were two plays that changed the complexion of the game. Bill Parker was involved in both of them. The first was when he had his punt blocked when we missed two assignments at the line of scrimmage. Clemson seized the initiative then. The second was Parker's pass to Zeigler on the fake punt for a vital first down. Parker is an old high school quarterback and we have been practicing that a long time tithout using it. The signal to try it is when Parker goes into the game, I yell to him to 'do your thing', and he did it perfectly.

"Zeigler, of course, was great all day. But he is always a great receiver. Muir as usual had an outstanding day. I say again he is the best inside runner in the United States and a true All America.

"Tommy Suggs is a great leader, a scrambler and a fine all-around quarterback. I felt all dong we could throw on Clemson and Tommy carried out our game plan perfectly, throwing for more than 200 yards.

"We will take a couple of weeks off and then get down to work for our bowl game. It's a great feeling."
