"We put it all together today and played like we are capable of playing. It was our best all-around game of the season when you consider offense and defense. We've probably had days when we did one or the other better, but not when we played so well overall.

"I'll say this about the Clemson team. They kept coming after us and that is a tribute to their coaching staff. I coached with Hootie Ingram and I can tell you that any team of his will always come after you. He's a fine football coach.

Today he broke the ACC single season record for carries, held by Brian Piwrolo of Wake Forest with 252 (1964). The career record is 601 by Clemson's Buddy Gore. He broke the ACC career reshing record of 2695 held by Virginia's Frank Quayle, He broke the Carolina school career rushing record of 2814 held by Charlie Justice. The school career record for carries is 576 held by Justice.

Don now has 16 touchdowns this year. The ACC record is 17 by Piccolo in 1964. * Kicking specialist Ken Craven today tied the Carolina school record for most PATs in a season with 33. The record is shared with Bob Cox (1948). Craven broke the ACC season record last week.

....

"We put it all together today and played like we are capable of playing. It was our best all-around game of the season when you consider offense and defense. We've probably had days when we did one or the other better, but not when we played so well overall.

"I'll say this about the Clemson team. They kept coming after us and that is a tribute to their coaching staff. I coached with Hootie Ingram and I can tell you that any team of his will always come after you. He's a fine football coach.

"AcCauley certainly had another big day--like he has had every week. Men, he is plain and simply a great football player. Oglesby ran well, too. And I thought Miller did a fine job of directing out attack.

"I was especially proud of the defense. We came up with a lot of big plays, interceptions and blocked passes. Brafford had a fine game. So did out tackles, Flip Ray and Bud Grissom.

This is our 10th game of the season and we're supposed to be ready to play. But we had some people who didn't lay it on the line. I'll take the blame for 90 per cent of it, but 10 per cent goes somewhere else.
