STATEMENT BY COACH HOOTIE INGRAM OF CLEMSON

I'm proud of the way we played in this game. Every phase of the game was better than what we showed against Kentucky. I feel a lot better about this team now at 0-2 than I did with the one last year at this time when they were 2-0.

We're a 1,000 per cent better, and our players are playing to the best of their ability. I'm happy with our program here at Clemson, except a few of our fans with 50-yard line seats who were booing our kids at the end of the game.
