COACHES . STATEMENTS

Coach Hootie Ingram: We didn't deserve to win. State came to play and wanted to win just a little bit more than we wanted to.

It's as much my fault as anyone. When they are not ready, I'm the leader of this group and I'll take the blame.

Coach Michaels and his staff have done a good job, not only this week, but all year long, of bringing this young club along. I hope I can do a better job next week of getting them ready (for South Carolina).

Had we been ready to play today, it would have been a different ball game. We lost our pride out there a couple of times, but you just can't come back when it's not with you.

I wish we were going into the South Carolina game with a little better record, but we have made progress through the year, and we're on the floor after today, but we're just going to have to rise up. Next week will be a real test for us -- a great challenge for us. We'll have a chance to grow a lot next week.

I think a week is plenty of time to get ready for anyons and folks are supposed to get ready. They came out and played like it should be played.

We got some good effort out win of some of our players. Both quarterbacks did a good job of doing what they can do best. Hopkins came in and did a good job blocking for us in the line.

We have to take the bitter with the sweet and we got the bitter today.

Coach Al Michaels: "I'm tickled to death for the boys. They won it and put it all together today. This has been a great bunch to work with. They have been knocked down often this year, but they deserve a lot of credit for the way they have continued to practice and play. It is a fine tribute to them.

It is easier to win and keep you head up, but to get knocked down repeatedly and come back takes a lot of courage.

This was their victory (the boys). It wasn't easy. Our assistant coaches have hung in there and that is a tribute to them, also.

It hasn't been a wonderful season. But the last three games, we have played as as well as any State team recently. That is expept for the final ten wire minutes against Penn State. Other than that, it has been a good finish.

There are no individuals to single out. We had too many boys who played good football to just name a few,

"It has been a frustrating season. But if this is the end, I'm satisfied.

Clemson is a good football team. We were impressed with them. They have had problems offensively like we have.

(Ed Note: Governor Bob Scott and Chancellor John T. Caldwell came into dressing room to congratulate Michaels and squad). "Maybe they (Scott and Caldwell) should be with us all the time. They were at Miami, also."

I'm really happy for the young men on our squad. We are all proud of them...even if we had lost today, I'd still feel the same way. It was their victory and it will enable the seniors to go out with a win."

ED NOTE:::: Willie Burden ended up with 910 yards for season, a new N.C. State record. He had 735 in nine games to break the old mark of 727 by Don DeArment in 1968.
