COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON: Wofford had the best game plan to go against us of any team since I've been at Clemson. They ran us ragged in the first half with their misdirection plays. They did a super job. That's a tribute to Coach Sasser and his staff and the boys who are playing for him.

As far as Clemson, I saw a lot of good things out there, especially on offense. We wanted it to get hot because conditioning is one of our problems. We looked like we were a little heavy-legged out there at times, but with the cool weather we've been having, we're not in the shape we ought to be.

We've got to get our pass defense a little better because I know that Tulane is going to item throw the ball.

But of the things we saw wrong out there, it's nothing we can't correct. Tuttle did a good job catching the ball, although there were a couple of more he should have hung onto, Austin ran well and McSwain (Chuck) looks like he's ready to run again. Perry did all right at middle guard, but we've still got to get him down to about 285 (from the present 295)

We handled the kicking game well. All four of the guys we called on did their job well, and I m expected we will continue to use all four of them. I'm happy with our second offensive line. That shows we have a little dath depth when they put a score on the board. I realize Wofford was a little tired, but our second team moved the ball okay.
