VIRGINIA'S DICK BESTWICK: I think we're getting just about as much out of our kids as we ~~can~~ can get. Under the circumstances -- with all the people we have hurt -- I thought we played them a great first half. The score (at the half) should have been 3-0, 3-3, maybe even 0-0. But when you are down to your sixth or seventh man in certain positions and you have so many people hurt, you just can't play with peak efficiency. Their kicking game hurt us as much as anything in the football game, because we were backed up in poor field position all day. As I came coming into the game, I was more impressed with their kicking game than with any other phase of their football team. People criticize their offense; I don't see how. An offense is supposed to win you football games when they have the chance, and that is exactly what Clemson's offense does. They don't make any mistakes or turnovers, and they score what it takes to win. They also have a great defense -- Davis and several others are truly outstanding football players. The ACC could have two teams up there close to the top five, depending how other teams do this week. Hopefully, the media will recognize that this is not just a basketball conference, it is also a football conference.

I tip my hat to Danny Ford and his coaching staff. I think we were ready to play emotionally, and I think this was borne out in the first half. They came out with the fullback in the second half and did what they had to do to control the football game. I think this was every bit as hard a football game as any they have played.

The fans wdown here are the best in the country. They are such good people. This is what football should be all about -- the way they have it at Clemson. Out at the motel, you don't see a bunch of drunks, you see families there. They have children coming to the football game with their parents, and they have parties like you are supposed to have. This Clemson operation -- I can't say anything negative about it. I'd be proud if every school in the country operate like Clemson does.

CLEMSON COACH DANNY FORD: I'm real proud of our team for the way it played today, especially the seniors. The seniors, as well as our coaches, did a good job this week getting the team ready for this game.

The defense got itself a zero for the first time this year, and the offense put 27 points on the board. There are several times we could have done better on short yardage situations, but we didn't have many mistakes and that's a big plus for us.

Coach Bestwick, as always, has his team well prepared. They have a lot of their young men hurt and that is bound to have hurt them.

But we didn't have any fumbles or interceptions and it looked like they were having a lot of fun out there. The kicking game was good and we had good coverage. Right now, I can't think of anything we did wrong, but I'm sure we'll see several things when we look at the film.

We're getting some good competition right now between our two tailbacks and the two fullbacks. I was very glad to see the line take ~~control~~ control of the game. We're real proud of our offensive line. I don't think we've played as good as we can on both sides of the line as yet, but we're improving all along and that's what counts.
