COACHES QUOTES

CLEMSON COACH DANNYFORD: This group of seniors earned a lot of credit. When they came back in August, they had their goals set. First, to win the Atlantic Coast Conference title, then to win the state -championship, and then go to a major bowl. They have accomplished one of these today, and another one comes up next Saturday.

Our seniors gave great leadership this year for the other players to follow. We're proud of everyone associated with this team -- the coaches, the trainers, the managers, the strength room personnel -- everybody. If everyone had done their part, we couldn't have accomplished what we have so far this season. And I told the players I didn't want them to forget that there is still plenty left on this season.

In the first half I thought we played great on both sides of the line. Maryland played us tough in the second half. They made some good adjustments at halftime and we could tell it in the second half. Some of the pass plays we were successful on in the first half, were not there in the second half. We expected a tough game, and we got it.

Penalties hurt us a lot in the second half, and I'llk take the blame for that. The defense played well the entire game, and they gotk their touchdown after a fumble. But we kakkdxkk lacked that killer instinct. We should have put them away, but we didn't.

But we're so proud that these sniors got their second ACC titlle (the other in 1978 -- 28-24 against Maryland). Now, we gotta get ready for another big one Saturday (against South Carolina in Columbia).

COACH JERRY CLAIBORNE First half we juse defensively did not play well. We missed a great number of tackles on Jordan. We let him scramble and find an open receiver. We put good pressure on him. We did not want to get in a man to man but Jordan did an excellent job of scrambling and then hitting the open man. You cannot give him that much time. We had him several times but didn't get him down. In the second half we decided kaxalaxxman not to play man to man at all.

If we had hit a couple of open receivers in the first half we would have been coser at the half. We had several open but just did not get the ball to them.

I am proud of the way they fought back in the second half. The penaltity on fourth down was one of the breaks of the game.

Clemson is an outstanding football team. They are a worthy champion. We wish them well against South Carolina and in whatever bowl they go to.

They were making the short passes but we were missing tackles and letting them pick up extra yards. People throw on us because we play pretty good defense against the running game and have had some problems on pass defense.

Bob Milkovich came in to get a change. We were hoping Bob could give us a spark. He got a couple delaypenalties because he was trying to audible and had trouble with his mouthpiece and had to take it out to call the audibles.

We made crucial mistakes. We got the TD and got it called back. It has been a disappointing season right now. but we have one more game to play against Virginia.
