COACH DANNY FORD

I am real proud of our football team today. We got a good effort and execution from our offensive team, our defensive team as well as out kicking game.

But you have to give Kentucky credit. Even when we got up 24-0, they came back at us and scored a touchdown. They hung in there. Coach Claiborne doesn't like what he is seeing right now, but he'll get it turned around...you can count on that. We know that he is used to success and that's what he's going to have.

I thought Eppley and Parete both played well. Mike got a lot of confidence early because of the success we had on our first drive. And a lot of this can be credited to the play of our offensive line. I thought they came off the ball real well and that helps any quarterback out, especially one starting his first game.

Our defense played very physical. I don't know how many sacks we had, but it was a few. Kentucky did a good job on its screens and draws, and we knew that would be coming because we had seen it in previous games. But I'm satisfied with the play of our defense. Both nose guards played well (Perry and Devane), Dan Benish was in there quite a few times and Billy Davis did an outstanding job on his punt returns, as well as that interception.

I think the only thing we can fault with our team today is its play in the fourth quarter. But again, Kentucky had the determination that they weren't going to be shut out and they took it to us. We've got to do something about getting a new fourth and short play. We just aren't doing well there at times.

But overall, all did their job and it was a very pleasant homecoming for us.

COACH JERRY CLAIBORNE OF KENTUCKY

"They whipped us...moved us off the ball offensively, especially on that first long drive. Eppley did a fine back-up job. We were kinda hoping we'd be able to ~~throw the needle~~ Concentrate on their running game, but he threaded the needle.. he threw as well as Jordan.

"They put so much pressure on our passer. We couldn't get set at times to throw the ball.

"Several times we were right on top of them (receivers), but he got the ball to them and they made some fine catches. Jenkins was running for his life most of the time.

"It was encouraging to see Choo Choo Lee back. He had some good runs and some good catxches.

"We still don't react tough enough under pressure. I thought we could do better again: the run....they whipped us on both sides of the line."
