COACH AL GROH--WAKE FOREST

"This is a dramatically different football team that 70,000 people saw today than they saw two years ago. I think that's a tremendous credit to the heart of our players. It's really at this moment a small consolation to them. I think the fact that it's a small consolation to them is why the game was why the game was played as hard fought and with as much pride and fight as it was.

"We certainly had our chances to win the football game. It's very disappointing to be on the one yard line and come away without any points. That was probably one of the biggest plays in the game.

ON THE FINAL PLAY

"We changed the call a little bit and ran a different play than what we had called. We had good protection completed the pass and had a chance to run with it but their boy came over and made a real good play. It's not necessarily designed to go to that particular receiver. It was just designed to throw the ball to an open man. Obviously it was unfortunate that we were throwing it for seven yards instead of for two because it's very obvious that we would have made two with that completion.

"I've never had a moral victory. There aren't any such things in the minds of the participants. I think a moral victory is something that can be seen from someplace other than the playing field."

COACH DANNY FORD -- CLEMSON

Danny Ford told his team in the dressing room before coming into the interview: "I don't like the way you played today, but I like the results better."

TO THE PRESS: You have to give Wake Forest a great amount of credit on how well they played against us. They just kept coming back and played very hard. They hurt us on their passing, but that didn't surprise us. They did get a little more running than we thought they would. They did a good job preparing for us.

We won and we played good enough to win. But I can't believe we had our minds on the game fully today. I can't say that is the truth, but it appears that way. Of course, a lot of that can be attributed to the way Wake Forest played. I don't believe our football team was convinced that they had to go out and play as hard as they could. They just didn't play the quality of football I think they're capable of.

This is a hard group to get going. They play the way they have to play (to win) and that is very dangerous. Whether we're living on borrowed time or whether we're the kind of people who play just well enough to win--we'll find out very shortly. This part of the season that is coming up (North Carolina, Maryland and South Carolina) is one that we'll have to have great preparation for and go out and execute on Saturday. It's not going to take long from now on out to find out just what kind of team we have and what kind of team they want to be. It's been a hard 6-1-1 so far for us.
