GAME NOTES:

- Ray Williams 26-yard kickoff return just before the end of the first half moved him into 2nd place on the Clemson career list ahead of William Scott. Williams now has 732 yards to trail only Warren Ratchford (968).
- Donald Igwebuike kicked 3 field goals today is now 14 of 15 on the season. His first field goal was a 52-yarder into the wind and was the 5th of his career from beyond 50 yards. He had a 53-yarder against Duke two weeks ago. There have been 10 field goals of 50 yards or longer by the Tigers since they began playing football in 1896 and Igwebuike has half of them. He is also 34 of 34 extra points this season.
- Mike Eppley became Clemson's all-time career leader in touchdown passes with 25 when he passed 11 yards to Terrance Roulhac for Clemson's first score of the day in the 1st quarter. He had been tied with Bobby Gage and Tommy Kendrick. Eppley also passed for 107 yards and now has 2975 yards for his career. He needs only 25 yards to become the 4th player in Clemson history to pass for 3000 yards.
- Terrance Roulhac's touchdown catch was his 7th of the season and leaves him one short of the Clemson single season record of 8 held by Perry Tuttle.

WAKE FOREST COACH AL GROH

"The errors early in the game put us exactly where you cannot afford to be against Clemson-behind. It's a little bit frustrating right now and I really dont' care to say anything more about it. Nothing positive could come from that now.

"We came into this game needing some good fortune, but instead we created our own bad fortune. We actually had what we wanted to start the game. The wind was at our backs, we held them on their first possession and would have had good field position.

"I thought Mike Pratapas did a nice job at center. He's the type f of player that a coach is proud to be associated with. The blocked punt was simply a great play by Perry. You can't fault our player (Toby Cole) for being out of position. Talk about a road-grader--that's what Perry was on that one.

"I also thought that Mike Eppley proved what I have felt all year--that he's the class quarterback in the league. He had a terrific game. He kept it all going for them all day."

(NOTE: Mike Pratapas, the starting center for Wake, was making his first start since his freshman year when he started at linebacker. He replaced Mike Nesselt, who was dressed for the gaeme, but suffering from a knee injury.) Regular right guard Ken McAllister also did not play for the Deacons.)

COACH DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON: I thought our football team played very well today. Our offense got some*points and the defense made some things happen. And I thought our kicking game was good. We had a lot of fun out there except for the penalties —we must have set a school record for the number of penalties. (Clemson actually was penalized 12 times—the school record is 18—there were some penalties refused).

Wake Forest made it tough on us up front. Their front people played very well. We didn't get too many holes to run through. Coach Groh and his coaches had a good plan against us.

I think we had some good $\dot{x}n\dot{x}$ individual play out there, and we got something accomplished. And $\dot{x}\dot{x}$ I'm glad to see that because I never know how good this team is going to play when the game starts.

One of the keys to the game today was our being able to keep the bill so long in the third quarter when Wake Forest had the wind. (Clemson had the ball 10:55 in the third quarter compared to 4:05 for Wake Forest)

We tackled a lot better today than we did last Saturday (against N. C. State) we got some people around the football. But I know we can play much better
