GAME NOTES:

Mike Eppley's 66-yard TD pass to Terrance Roulhac on the third play of the game put Eppley over the 3000-yard mark in career passing yardage. He finished the game with 3098. Roulhac's TD catch was his 8th of the season and tied Perry Tuttle's single season record. The TD pass was the 15th by Clemson this year and set a new season record, breaking the old mark of 14 set by the 1950 team.

Ray Williams now has two carries this season - both are 17-yard TD runs on reverses around the left side into the West end zone of Death Valley. OG Steve Reese threw the key block for Williams at the goal line.

This was Clemson's 26th consecutive game at home without a loss. The Tigers are 24-0-2 dating back to the 1980 loss to UNC.

William Perry had 2 tackles for loss today and set a new Clemson single season record with 21. San Francisco 49er Jim Stuckey held the old mark of 20. That gives Perry 54 career tackles for loss is now only one off the ACC mark held by William Fuller and ties him for second with Lawrence Taylor.

Reggie Pleasant had one pass broken up to tie Terry Kinard's Clemson single season record of 12.

William Perry -- It was a good defensive struggle. They have a great defensive and ours rose to the occasion. Both offensives struggled, but we made things happen with the ball.

We expected the things we saw - things like reverses. They tried to challenge us but we knew they would.

Bruce Smith is a great athlete. He is a definite Outland Trophy candidate and is one of the finest players around.

We weren't surprised by what they did. Everybody that we play starts off with those short passes. We just have to adjust to that.

I was happy with the way I played. I need to get to the ball and make things happen, and I did. I'm looking forward to going to Baltimore next week. We start thinking about that game tomorrow. I heard about their second half, and I know they can score some points. Our defensive has to ready. I know they will challenge us.

Mike Eppley -- They really had good personnel and did a great job. Their pursuit was so strong all day, and that is what finally opened up the reverse. They had pursued those options and sweeps well, so the reverse turned out to be a great call by the coaches.

I have come to learn not to expect anything. The first drive really didn't make us expect an easy time. They have a great defense, but we just hit them fast. We got momentum with these first three plays. The rest of the way was tough.

No question about taking the field goal off and going for the touchdown after the roughing penalty. We have confidence in Donald. He could have kicked it again.

COACHES QUOTES

Coach Danny Ford of Clemson: I thought we did a real fine job to win the ball game. Virginia Tech gave just about all we wanted. We could have folded at halftime because ~~were bad played as well as they were and were behind~~ we had not played all that good and were behind. If we had been any less that a good football team, we might not have made it through the fourth quarter.

The Virginia Tech defense played as good as anybody ~~had~~ has against at this year. But I think our defense came back and played good because we shut them down in the second half. But you'll have to give Virginia Tech credit. You can tell they were having fun playing football. They were always around the ball.

Our kicking game was superb again. I know you all probably get tired of my saying good things about our kicking game. But they came through again when it counted. I have always been told not to take points off the board, but we had faith in our youngster (Igwebuike) because he's only missed one this year. I know there'll be another time when he might miss one this year, but we thought it was good enough chance to take and go with the first down.

Bruce Smith is a great player. We think right now (before checking films) that our man (Reid Ingle) played a good game against him. But he's probably the best defensive player we've face since I've been here. He's a tremendous talent.

BILL DOOLEY, VIRGINIA TECH: "It was a very disappointing loss for us. We didn't come down here just to play a good game. We came down here to play a good game and win. We just came up on the short end of it.

"The kicking game played a big part in the Clemson victory. First, we rough the kicker to set up the winning touchdown. Plus, we missed two field goals which could have put us in good position. The Clemson kicker from ~~&~~ Nigeria is a powerful weapon for Clemson. They didn't need to worry when they took his field goal off the scoreboard. If Clemson couldn't move it in three plays, they knew he would come in and put the three points back up there.

"The most disappointing thing for us was to move almost the length of the field in the second half and then get nothing out of it ~~we~~ when we threw the interception. That really hurt.

"We had our opportunities to win the football game. But we were up against a powerful opponent. The Clemson line is bigger than some pro teams. You can't line up and run straight at them. That's why we tried to mix up a lot of things in our offense.

"We have to regroup now and keep our heads up high. We have a big game at Vanderbilt next week.
