<u>USC linebacker Carl Hill</u> -- "Before we got in the huddle (after USC scoring go-ahead TD) we said that we had been playing a great second half and that we were not going to let them score with only 54 seconds to play. We gave the seniors a good last win on the road. (What coaches said to them at halftime) -- "they were running the same plays that we were practicing on all week. We didn't change much at halftime but the coaches gave us a pep talk.

USC defensive lineman Fitzgerald Davis -- "We found out that the best defense is to pressure the quarterback and we put a four man rush on them and decided to take them head up. We put more pressure on the quarterback in the final 54 seconds. We knew we had them when they had third and long.

<u>USC offensive lineman - Carl Womble</u> -- "We waited on the big break and finally got it. We really came together today as a team. It was a total team effort. We had a lot of confidence going into the final drive. We knew last year we had the confidence going into the final drive and we didn't want a repeat this year."
