#### COACHES QUOTES: GEORGIA TECH'S BILL CURRY

"That was one of those very gratifying wins. It was Georgia Tech's first win up here. It was very significant for this team. Now if we can play at home like we do on the road, we might have a chance to be good. Obviously, we caught Clemson at a time when their offense is young. But our defense did a great job, and we got enough points on the board.

"We got an incredible break on the long throw (to tight end Tim Manion), that John shouldn't have thrown. Sometimes those things happen, but we were very fortunate in that respect today. But we played good enough de ense to win anyhow, and I think that was the thing that made me the most proud."

(On the missed field goals)""David Bell kicked the ball very well in practice. A lot of things go into kicking a field goal. We lost our starting snapper the play before the first field goal attempt, so our timing was a little off. The kickers could have made all three of them, and should have, but the mechanics were not proper."

"Mike Snow (Tech punter) was outstanding today. He was one of the key factors in the game."

"We had some key runs today. Right there at the end, I was awfully proud of the first down we made, and getting the clock controlled so we could finish the job."

(On whether Curry expected the defense to perform as well) "No. I never would have expected that in this day and time. I did expect our defense to come back very strongly today."It seemed like everybody did (play well)."

(On the offense) "We're still struggling on offense, and losing Dewberry for a while there and having him play hurt (bruised left shoulder), we were afraid to drop him back very much. We were afraid to do a lot of our offense. We really shut down there for a while in the fourth quarter, and I was glad we could get some first downs at the end."

"I remember very frustrating periods in the game where I thought we had a chance to do something offensively, and just couldn't quite pull the trigger. We had to resort to trickery to score, and that's okay, if you have to do it. We were extremely lucky to be down there at that time."

(On the turnovers by Clemson) "Those were not all gifts. Most of them were contact turnovers. There was some hitting going on out there by both teams. Only one of them was a mishandled ball. And we mishandled one and gave it to them for a field goal."

CLEMSON COACH DANNY FORD: This undoubtedly is the sorriest coached football game I've ever coached. This was a poor showing by <u>MY</u> football team and they are mine when they lose. We just didn't do anything good, I don't think. The defense played pretty well at times.

But the way we fumbled, and didn't pick up the blitz, and other things we did wrong shows that we just well prepared for this game...and I'll take the full blame for that. Again, it was a bad coached game on my part.

We're a long ways from being a football team. We're already in our third week of the season and the seventh week of practice, and we're still doing things elementary.

There have gotta be some good things come out of this game, but I can't say what they are right now. I didn't see a great deal of improvement today over last week. Last week I think we went two steps ahead of what we did the week before (against Virginia Tech), but this week, we lost those two steps
