TOM REED, N.C. State: "Clemson had an excellent day in football. It was a very good day for them, but it shows obviously wasn't for us. The thing that was difficult for us was putting the ball in the end zone. The real problem was keeping people in there on offense. We lost our center (Jeff & Hojnacki) and had to use our starting guard (Chuck Massaro) who used to be the backup center in there. Then he got hurt, as did others like (Bhil) Brothers, (Mack) Jones, (Mike) Miller and Danny Peebles. It's difficult to score when you have to keep shuffling people around. Like I said, it was a great day for Clemson at Clemson.

On the play of QB John Heinle: "He did a good job."

Asked to mention the positives: "It's tough to find anything real positive. The kids prepared hard and they played hard. We've got to get a lot of our people back. Everybody's trying. They're bound and determined that some **khing** good things are going to happen. They're coming closer together. But I've never had a year like this one. We started six freshmen today. In defense of our young men, they gave much more than the score indicates. There's no resemblance to the team we put out there today and the one we started with in pre-seasonx. I just don't know. Our kids didn't quit, they just wouldn't quit."

DANNY FORD OF CLEMSON--We did just about everything we were supposed to do and showed improvement over last week. I think this game turned out to be a real confidence builder for us.

This kind of game is one that we still couldn't relax in. They try and onsides kick and come within an arm of getting it. Had they gotten the ball, it could have been a 14-point game. I really didn't relax until six seconds were left.

But we intercepted some passes, we got to the quarterback more than once and we made some other key tackles on short-yardage plays. We're happy we did some things this week that we didn't do last week that were in a positive way. We realize that North Carolina State was banged up, we were banged up at times also. But we thought (Eric) Nix came in and played well for (Jeff) Lytton and (Ty) Granger came in an played well for (Richard) McCullough.

If we were going to win the game today, we had to take control from the start and we did that. When we came back with the football at the start of the third quarter, we had to take control against the wind and we did that. We forced them to pass when they possibly didn't want to and we intercepted and that helped out. All in all, we're proud of our performance.
