WAKE FOREST COACH AL GROH:

☒ "Once again I was proud of our team's effort, but once again it makes the pain that much more severe for our players. I feel particularly bad for our older players, especially since we will not be coming down here next season.

"Obviously, those two key turnovers hurt us--created a 10-point turnaround. I think I know what happened on the fumbled snap. I don't need to look at the films on that one. But, I think the odds were pretty good that we would have been in the endzone, which would have changed the game.

"A.J. Greene made a great block on the field goal attempt, after coming close several times. He is an exciting young player for us, and he played exeeptionally well today.

"Bruce Mark was just outstanding, and would have been even if he hadn't intercepted that screen pass. You know, he had to play his first game down here five years ago, when unfortunate injuries to ~~xx~~ out team ~~xxxxxx~~ dictated him playing early. I think he showed today what kind of football player he has become.

"We did play our youngest line-up of the season today, but I'm not looking at the future right now. We're only concerned with winning next week's game with Duke."

NOTES: Michael Ramseur broke the Wake Forest career scoring record ~~■~~ today. He now has 194, and passes James McDougald's 192. Topper Clemons moves into the no. three spot on the Deacon all-time rushing~~list~~ list this afternoon. Coming into the game, he had 2,205 yards, and he now has 2,299.

CLEMSON COACH DANNY FORD: We're happy and we're sad. We're happy that we won the ball game and overcame a lot of things and we're sad that Steve Berlin is lost for the year. (Berlin was injured on the game's first play, will be operated on the first part of the week--his right knee--and has had his Clemson career ended. Coach Ford gave him a game ball in the post-game talk in the Clemson dressing room.)

Wake Forest battled us all the way just as they have done every opponent this year. Elkins is a definite threat anywhere on the field, just as Ramseur and Clemons are.

Our offense kept the ball a lot in the second half and this gave our defense a rest where they would be more ready to go when they did go back in. I don't think we were quite as ready to play this week as we were last week (against N. C. State), but that's my fault.

We did a lot of good things this afternoon and there were some bad ones also. We must have set a record for penalties. The officials earned their pay this afternoon on just us. And I guess I'm the coach in charge of turnovers and penalties. Nobody else wants that job. But our players overcame all of these adversaties and showed a lot of class.

We've got three tough ones coming up now (North Carolina, Maryland and North Carolina) and all three of them will be a full day's work, especially since two of them are on the road. But I'm sure our guys will be ready to meet the task--at least they'd better be ready.
