NEED TO KNOW

PRESEASON HYPE

- Clemson was tabbed as the overall ACC Champion by the league's head coaches, earning six first-place votes. The Tigers were also picked as the Atlantic Division Champions, with five first-place votes.
- Ousmane Sylla got a lot of love this preseason, being named to the United Soccer Coaches Forwards to Watch list as well as the Preseason ACC Players to Watch list.
- Alex Meinhard joined Sylla on the USC Forwards to Watch list, while Joran Gerbet was named to the United Soccer Coaches Midfielders to Watch list.
- Meinhard was also named to the MAC Hermann Trophy Watch list prior to the season opener.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

- Since Mike Noonan arrived at Clemson in 2010, the Tigers are 102-37-16 at Historic Riggs Field. Last season, Clemson led the nation in total attendance (31,639) and finished second nationally in average attendance (2,637).

SCORE EARLY AND OFTEN

- Against UCF, Ousmane Sylla converted on a penalty kick just 42 seconds into the game, giving the Tigers a 1-0 lead on the second-fastest goal in program history.
- During the Mike Noonan era, Clemson is 134-11-10 when the Tigers score first.
- Clemson is 95-5-6 under Noonan when leading at the half and 124-9-5 when the Tigers score at least twice.
- Clemson won all its games in 2022 when scoring at least two goals (11-0-0) and the Tigers have never lost under Coach Noonan when the team scores at least three goals.

NEW FACES

- There are plenty of new faces on the 2023 Clemson United roster. The Tigers added four DI transfers (Joran Gerbet, Gael Gibert, Alex Meinhard, Jackson Wrobel) and 10 freshman this offseason.
- Gerbet and Gibert both transferred from Oregon State, where they were All PAC-12 players and Gerbet was the PAC-12 Player of the Year.
- Meinhard transferred to Clemson from Tulsa, where he was All-AAC and the AAC Offensive Player of the Year, while Wrobel transferred from Wofford, where he earned All-SoCon honors.
