

## THE GAME

· This will mark the 91st meeting between NC State and Clemson - the 40th in Raleigh.

- The Wolfpack won the last meeting between the two squads in Carter-Finley, knocking off No. 9 Clemson in double overtime in 2021. Prior to that victory, the Tigers had won eight straight in the series.
- Three of the last six contests against Clemson have been onescore games and two of the last six (at Clemson in 2016 and 2021 in Raleigh) have gone into at least one overtime.
- For more than three decades, the series between NC State and Clemson was dubbed the Textile Bowl, as that industry has a major economic impact on both states and both universities boast renowned textile colleges. NC State's College of Textiles produces more than half of the textile graduates in the nation each year. The North Carolina textile manufacturers donate money to NC State's scholarship fund every year in honor of the Wolfpack's MVP from the game.

## THE WOLFPACK

## **NOTING THE PACK**

- Wolfpack head coach Dave Doeren is just one win away from tying the school record for coaching victories.
- LB Payton Wilson leads the ACC in tackles (11.6/game). That mark ranks third in the FBS.
- Wilson was named the Butkus National LB of the Month for September and is a three-time ACC LB of the Week this year.
- NC State leads the ACC in third down conversion defense (.275) - that's the third best mark in the FBS.
- The Wolfpack has won 18 of its last 21 games in Carter-Finley Stadium.
- True freshman receiver KC Concepcion accounts for 27% of the Wolfpack's receptions (37 of 135).
- Concepcion is the first true freshman in school history to post two 100+ yard games in a season.
- In his first start of 2023 (and just the third of his career), MJ Morris threw a career-best four TDs and tied his career-high with 265 passing yards vs. Marshall.
- RB Delbert Mimms ranks sixth in the ACC and 35th nationally with six rushing TDs. That's two more TDs than any Pack player had in all of 2022.
- NC State is 12-for-12 inside the 10-yardline this season (11 TDs, 1 FG).
- The Wolfpack ranks 11th in the FBS in team sacks. The sack attack is led by reserve defensive end Red Hibbler.
- The Wolfpack has lost two of its top four safeties for the season (Jakeen Harris, Rakeim Ashford).
- Five starters from the 2022 Wolfpack defense are now on NFL rosters.

## GOING THE DISTANCE

Transfer kicker Brayden Narveson may end up wearing the Wolfpack uniform for one year, but he will permanently have his name etched in the NC State record book.

Prior to this season, the transfer from Western Kentucky had made three 50+ yard field goals: a 53-yarder in 2020, another 53-yarder in 2021 and a 51-yarder in 2022. Prior to last week's game at Duke, his previous long with the Wolfpack was a 49-yarder vs. Notre Dame.

After a Shyheim Battle interception on Duke's opening drive, Narveson lined up for a 57-yarder. The result? The kick was good and NC State had a new school record for longest field goal. Narveson's kick was a yard better than the previous mark set 33 years ago by Damon Hartman vs. UNC (1990).

### **DEFENDING THE DEFENSE**

Entering game 7, NC State's defense has not necessarily posted the numbers it's gained a reputation for over the past several seasons.

One reason for that is injuries - particularly at safety. Another - and probably more significant reason - is that *five* players from last year's defense are currently on NFL rosters.

Despite that, the Wolfpack still posts some of the best numbers in the FBS in several defensive categories.

NC State leads the ACC in third down conversion defense (.275) - that's the third best mark in the FBS.

## **IT'S HOW YOU FINISH**

Sophomore MJ Morris started for just the third time in his short career vs. Marshall. That start didn't exactly get off to a good start.

In the first quarter, Morris was 1-7. His first pass of the game was an interception and he was 1-7 with two picks in the first quarter (although his one completion was a 17-yard TD strike to KC Concepcion).

He came out hot in the second frame, however, completing seven straight throws, including a 39-yard TD pass to Trent Pennix. After that first quarter, he completed 64% of his passes for the rest of the game, finishing with a career-best four TD throws and tying his career best with 265 passing yards.

Last season, Morris became the first Wolfpack QB since Philip Rivers in 2000 to start at QB. (Of note: Rivers graduated early and went through spring practice prior to his freshman year, while Morris arrived in June of 2022).

Morris, who had played meaningful snaps in four career games prior to the Marshall game (the fifth game he played he was in for just three plays), came off the bench to lead the Pack to victory against Virginia Tech last season, throwing for three touch-downs. He came back the next week versus Wake Forest - his first game as a starter - to throw three more TDs. He was named ACC Rookie of the Week for both of those contests.

After starting the 2022 Boston College game, Morris suffered a knee injury and missed the rest of the season.

Although NC State's red zone offense has been mediocre this season (12th in the ACC, .783), the Wolfpack has enjoyed great success inside the opponent's 10-yardline. ## KC'S YAC = A-OK

Freshman KC Concepcion isn't just good at catching the ball, he knows what to do with it once he's caught it.

For the year, Concepcion has 410 yards on 37 receptions. Of that total, 55% (224 yards) has come after the catch (or YAC). Against Marshall, 85% of his total yards (87 of 102) was YAC.

The two-time ACC Rookie of the Week earned PFF's highest wide receiver grade for week 6. On3 has named him a midseason true freshman All-American.

### PACK PICKS A PECK OF PASSES

Although the NC State pass defense hasn't been as effective as the run defense, opponents beware when you let it fly against the Pack. NC State ranks second in the ACC and 28th in the FBS with eight interceptions this season

What's even better about that number is that those INTs have come from six *different* players (3 from CBs, 2 from safeties, 1 from an LB, 2 from a nickel).

Last season, NC State ranked first in the ACC and third nationally with 19 passes picked. The Pack has tallied 26 INTs in the last 19 games.

## (NO) SAFETY IN NUMBERS

The safety positions looked to be one of the most experienced on the squad heading into 2023. Free safety Jakeen Harris had 46 career games and 20 starts under his belt, while strong safety Devin Boykin had 34 career games played with nine starts.

Just five snaps into the 2023 campaign - in the opener at UConn, Harris suffered a season-ending injury. His backup Sean Brown stepped up into that role.

Late in the UConn game, on a special teams play, safety Rakeim Ashford - a veteran backup at both safety spots - was knocked out on a late hit, taken off the field on a stretcher to the hospital and would miss the next two games while in concussion protocol.

On the first play from scrimmage at Virginia, Boykin was injured. Bishop Fitzgerald - who had been practicing at free safety - came in to play that position, along with Cecil Powell. Before the game was over, Powell was also on the sidelines with an injury.

Versus Louisville, Brown was having the game of his life with eight tackles, two sacks for 25 yards and a forced fumble before being ejected for targeting, leaving Fitzgerald and Ashford as the only safeties left.

And then vs. Marshall, with Brown sitting out the first half, Ashford was injured on the first play from scrimmage and is out for the season.

#### **GRAY AREA**

Even though we're only seven games into the season, kick returner Julian Gray is posting numbers that could end up being among the best in school history.

Gray enters the Clemson game averaging 28.6 yards per kick return. That mark would rank seventh in school history if he is able to maintain it.

Gray ranks fourth in the FBS (second in ACC) this week in that category.

#### HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

NC State has won 18 of its last 21 games in Carter-Finley Stadium.

In 2022, NC State tied the school record for the longest home winning streak at 16 before falling in the last home game of the season. That streak, which tied the mark set under head coach Lou Holtz from 1972-75, was the sixth-best active home winning streak in the FBS at the time.

Since the beginning of the 2017 season, the Wolfpack has posted a 35-9 mark in games played at Carter-Finley Stadium.

#### **ONEPACK EMPOWERED**

A generous gift from Dave and Sara Doeren will establish a new initiative at NC State to support students with executive functioning challenges and those who are neurodivergent. Their \$1.25 million commitment is among the largest made by a college football coach to his NCAA-member institution.

The new program being launched through the Doeren Family Fund will be called OnePack Empowered and will benefit NC State students who face challenges with executive function skills critical to academic success, such as organization, planning, setting priorities, task completion and decision making.

Autism and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder are just two of the diagnoses that could be linked to challenges in this realm, but students with these challenges also might have no formal diagnosis; no particular diagnosis will be prioritized or required in the program's application process.

With a focus on one-on-one mentoring, individual support plans, career readiness and additional specialized assistance the program is being designed to bolster academic and person al success and ensure students can complete their degrees.

The Doerens' commitment will pilot the program for five years, serving up to 50 students at a time. They hope to inspire other donors to join them in contributing to OnePack Empowered as a sustainable source of support and guidance for an expanding number of participants over the next several years.

## **HEAD COACH DAVE DOEREN**

- In his 11th season at NC State, his 13th season as a head coach overall. Boasts the second-longest tenure in the ACC and the eighth in the FBS.
- Named to the preseason list to for the Dodd Trophy.
- Ranks second in Wolfpack history in coaching victories (76).
- Has more nine-win campaigns than any coach in school history (three) and has now led six of his 10 NC State squads to seasons with eight or more victories.
- Between 2017-22, 20 of his players have been drafted by the NFL including an ACC-best seven in 2017 the sixthhighest total nationally. Three of his players have gone on to be first-round picks, including OT lkem Ekwonu (No. 6 to the Panthers) in 2022.
- In 2022, the Pack qualified for the eighth bowl game during his tenure, the most under any coach in program history.
  The Wolfpack has boasted 56 Academic All-ACC performers under his guidance including a program-high 13 in 2022.
- and in 2018 had a player named to the prestigious NFF National Scholar-Athlete Team.
- Three of his players have won four national awards: Bradley Chubb (2017 Nagurski Trophy, 2017 Hendricks Award), Garrett Bradbury (2018 Rimington Trophy) and Christopher Dunn (2022 Lou Groza Award).
- Over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, the Pack won 16 straight games, tying the longest home winning streak in school history (1972-74).
- 2022 NC State squad was the first since 1980 not to give up more than 30 points in a single game all season.
- Has coached bowl eligible teams in 17 of his 21 years in Division I.
- He and his wife Sara have donated \$1.25 million to establish a new initiative at NC State to support students with
  executive functioning challenges and those who are neurodivergent. Their commitment is among the largest made by
  a college football coach to his NCAA-member institution.
- Led Northern Illinois to the most successful two years in program history.
- His first Husky squad won the school's first MAC Championship since 1983 and tied the school record with 11 wins.
- His 2012 NIU team repeated as league champ and set a new school mark with 12 victories, earning a trip to the Orange
- Bowl the first BCS berth ever for a MAC school.
- Was a finalist for several national coach of the year awards in 2012.
- NIU boasted the nation's longest conference winning streak (17) and never lost a home game during his tenure.
- Spend five seasons in the Big Ten, serving as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at Wisconsin.
- Spent four seasons at Kansas and was on staff when the Jayhawks ended a seven-year bowl drought.
- In 2000 and 2001, coached the secondary at NCAA Division I-AA powerhouse Montana. The Grizzlies advanced to the national title game in 2000, losing by two points, but returned in 2001 to win the championship.
- Montana posted a 28-3 record and won two Big Sky titles during his tenure.
- Planned to go to medical school following college and become an orthopedic surgeon. He took the MCAT but after helping coach high school between his junior and senior years, fell in love with coaching.
- Lettered at tight end at Drake and was an Academic All-American.
- Earned his undergraduate degree in pre-medical biology. Earned his master's from Drake in educational leadership and began work on a Ph.D. while serving as a graduate assistant at the University of Southern California.
