THE KICKOFF

» The University of Louisville men's soccer team is back on the road on Friday for an ACC contest at Clemson. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. ET and will be televised on ACC Network Extra.

» Louisville got an 89th minute goal from Damien Barker John to secure a 3-2 victory over Kansas City on Monday. Barker John scored twice in the second half and Kansas City netted an own goal as the Cardinals picked up their first comeback victory of the season.

» Louisville and Clemson meet for the 11th time on Friday night with the Tigers narrowly leading the all-time series 5-4-1. The Cardinals are 1-3 all-time in Clemson.

» Louisville and Clemson have alternated wins over the last five meetings between the two, with the home team winning all five. Josh Jones scored the lone goal in a 1-0 victory for the Cardinals last October.

LOUISVILLE HEAD COACH: JOHN MICHAEL HAYDEN

John Michael Hayden, a Louisville native who served as an assistant coach with the Cardinals for four seasons, was named head coach of the University of Louisville men's soccer program Dec. 27, 2018.

Hayden became the fifth head coach in the history of the UofL men's soccer program, which completed its 40th season in 2018. In four seasons at the helm, he has compiled a 34-29-7 record and a 17-16-3 mark in ACC play, earning three NCAA Tournament berths.

The Cardinals made it back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2022, putting together a 9-6-3 overall record with a 4-3-1 tally in ACC play. Louisville earned an at-large bid and a host spot in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. The Cardinals scored a pair of top-10 victories during the 2022 season, opening up the fall with a 3-1 win over No. 10 Saint Louis and later adding a 2-1 triumph against No. 8 Pitt. Sander Roed and Aboubacar Camara earned AlI-ACC honors for the second consecutive season.

The 2021 season saw Hayden lead the Cardinals to the program's first ever ACC Atlantic Division title. Louisville finished with a 10-7-1 overall record and a 5-3-0 mark in conference play. The Cards earned an at-large bid and a home match in the NCAA Tournament. Louisville ranked as one of the top scoring teams in the country, finishing with the program's highest goal total in 11 seasons. Aboubacar Camara and Pedro Fonseca each earned First Team All-ACC honors, while Sander Roed was a Third Team and All-ACC Freshman Team selection. Camara's 13 goals were tied for the third-most in program history. Fonseca was later selected by Real Salt Lake in the second round of the MLS SuperDraft.

Dealing with the challenges of playing during the COVID-19 pandemic, Hayden's second season saw the Cardinals post a 5-8-1 overall mark split across the fall and spring semesters. Battling a bevy of injuries, Uoft went just 1-6-1 during the fall portion of the season, but rebounded in the spring and posted a 4-2-0 record and finished second in the ACC Atlantic Division. The Cardinals capped off the spring season with a 2-1 victory over No. 1 Clemson in the regular season finale. Elijah Amo and Pedro Fonseca were each named to the AI-ACC teams, while Aboubcar Camara was the conference's leading scorer during the spring and earned AII-Freshman laurels. Amo (Real Salt Lake) and Lamine Conte (New York Red Bulls) were both selected in the MLS SuperDraft in January of 2021, becoming Louisville's 24th and 25th all-time selections, while Jake Gelnovatch inked a professional deal with USL Championship club Memphis 901 FC.

In his first season at the helm, Hayden led the Cardinals to a 10-8-2 overall record and a 3-4-1 record in ACC play. The Cards handed eventual national champion Georgetown its only loss of the season with a 1-0 double overtime victory at Lynn Stadium. Hayden became the first Louisville head coach to lead the Cardinals to a pair of NCAA wins in their first season, including an upset of No. 14 UC Davis. The Cards qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the fourth straight year. The Cardinals advanced to the third round of the NCAA Tournament for the third time in the last four years and the seventh time in the last 10 seasons. Under Hayden, Cherif Dieye was named to the Al-ACC Second Team and was named a United Soccer Coaches All-South Region Second Team. Dieye became UofL's 23rd player chosen all-time in the MLS SuperDraft and the seventh player to be drafted in the first round.

In three seasons as an assistant at UofL from 2016-18, the Cardinals 38-13-10 overall. Louisville registered its first ACC Championship title in 2018, defeating Notre Dame, Wake Forest and North Carolina in a span of eight days to win the ACC championship. UofL reached the NCAA Tournament in all three seasons, including national quarterfinal appearances in 2016 and 2017.

Prior to returning to Louisville, Hayden served as associate head coach at Xavier University in 2015 helping the Musketeers compile 12 wins and earn a No. 10 ranking in the NSCAA poll. XU won

at No. 2 Notre Dame and No. 1 Creighton during the fall, widely considered to be the first time any team had knocked off the top two NSCAA-ranked teams on the road in the same season.

Hayden joined the Musketeers after spending two successful seasons as an assistant coach at Lipscomb University, where he helped the Bisons to a program-best 12-4-1 record and A-Sun regular season title in 2014. Lipscomb was 21-13-3 overall during his two years in Nashville, racking up several conference honors in the process. Hayden trained the 2014 A-Sun Defender of the Year, Luke Gearin, and the A-Sun Freshman of the Year, Ivan Alvarado. In 2013, he mentored A-Sun Player of the Year Omar Djabi and assisted A-Sun Coach of the Year Charles Morrow – both program firsts for the Bisons.

Ahead of his two years at Lipscomb, Hayden helped lift Louisville to a 14-6-1 record, a BIG EAST Red Division regular season championship and an Elite Eight appearance in the NCAA Tournament during a highly successful 2012 season. Before his first stint with the Cardinals, Hayden served as Director of Coaching with the Kentucky Fire Juniors USYSA club, obtaining his USSF National "X coaching license and traveling to Spain with U.S. Soccer as part of a development workshop with the international powerhouses FC Barcelona and Real Madrid.

Hayden was a decorated player before transitioning into coaching, playing collegiately at Indiana University winning back-to-back NCAA championships with the Hoosiers in 2003 and 2004. He scored an overtime header against No. 3 Maryland in the 2004 College Cup, sending IU to the title match. During his sophomore season, Hayden scored career-highs with seven goals, four assists and 18 total points – ying for the team lead with six game-winning goals. Hayden was a Big Ten All-Conference selection in 2004 and 2006 and was named to the NCAA College Cup All-Tournament Team during the Hoosiers' 2004 title run.

In 2007, Hayden was selected 13th overall in the MLS SuperDraft by the Houston Dynamo. His pro debut came on July 10, 2007 in the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup against Charleston Battery. In his rookie season, the Dynamo won an MLS Cup Championship. He wrapped up his professional career after signing with the Louisville Lightning in January of 2010.

A two-time Parade Magazine All-American at Louisville's Trinity High School, Hayden was named NSCAA/adidas Kentucky Player of the Year along with Gatorade and Eurosport honors. When he signed with IU, he was recognized as a top-25 recruit by Soccer America.


In 2007, Hayden married Hollie Minogue, who played soccer for Louisville's women's team and the couple has two sons, Liam and Jacob.

BARKER JOHN STEPS FORWARD WITH SCORING SURGE

The early portion of the 2023 season saw newcomer Gage Guerra leading the way offensively with six goals in the first five matches. However, the junior forward has not been on the pitch since subbing off in the 64th minute at Evansville due to injury.

In the nearly 300 minutes since then, Damien Barker John has taken over the top goal scoring role, finding the back of the net five times during that span.

Barker John scored late at Evansville, before tallying a brace against NC State and again versus Kansas City. Against Kansas City, the sophomore scored the tying goal in the 70th minute and the game-winner with less than two minutes to play.

BARKER JOHN NAMED ACC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF WEEK

Damien Barker John was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Co-Offensive Player of the Week following Louisville's wins over Evansville and NC State.

The sophomore tallied three goals in the two victories, converting a penalty kick in the closing seconds at Evansville and finding the back of the net twice in the first half against NC State.

Barker John is the fourth Louisville player to earn a weekly ACC honor this season.

CARDINALS ON THE ATTACK EARLY

John Michael Havden's team has one of the better offensive attacks in the country once again. averaging better than two goals per match.

The Cardinals have been especially good early in matches, having scored first in eight of 10 matches this season. Louisville has gotten on the board in the first 10 minutes of three matches (UNC Greensboro, Kentucky, Virginia Tech) and the first 15 minutes of three others (Bellarmine, Syracuse, NC State).

ROED CLIMBING CAREER ASSISTS CHART

Louisville midfielder Sander Roed had one of the top assist seasons in program history in 2022, tying for the seventh-most in program history with eight.

Roed is already halfway to his total from last season, having notched his fourth of the year and 17th career assist against NC State, moving him into a tie for seventh all-time at Louisville.

Tim Kubel (2014-17) owns the program's career record with 26.

GUERRA DELIVERS EARLY SEASON SCORING BINGE The reigning Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year at Army, Gage Guerra has been dynamic in his first run in a Louisville uniform.

The junior forward scored the opening goal in wins over Bellarmine and UNC Greensboro, earning him ACC Offensive Player of the Week and College Soccer News Team of the Week honors. He followed that up with a brace against Kentucky and again at Syracuse for his second straight ACC Player of the Week honor.

His six goals were the most by a Louisville player through five matches since at least 2001.

CARDINALS MATCH BEST START IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Louisville got off to a perfect 4-0-0 start with wins over Saint Louis, Bellarmine, UNC Greensboro and Kentucky - three of which were ranked inside the top 20 in the preseason poll.

It marked just the second time in the 45-year history of Louisville men's soccer that the Cardinals won each of their first four matches, joining the 1998 team.

LOUISVILLE SURGES INTO TOP FIVE

Louisville opened the 2023 season just on the outside of the United Soccer Coaches preseason rankings as one of 12 teams receiving votes outside of the top 25.

The Cardinals needed just one week to return to the top 25, coming in at No. 13 in the rankings following a win over No. 16 Tulsa in the season opener. Louisville then soared into the top 10 at No. 7 after a 3-0-0 start. Following a win over No. 19 Kentucky and draw at No. 4 Syracuse, the Cardinals moved up to No. 5.

The No. 5 ranking was Louisville's best since Nov. 13, 2018 when the Cardinals were also ranked fifth.

SVETANOFF, CARDS OPEN SEASON WITH 331 SCORELESS MINUTES

Redshirt-freshman goalkeeper Alex Svetanoff and the Louisville defense made a statement to start the season, turning in clean sheets through the first three matches.

The scoreless run finally came to an end in the second half against Kentucky, but not before the Cardinals had registered 331 minutes without conceding.

Louisville posted three straight shutouts to open the season for the first time since 2009 when they

defeated Bowling Green (3-0), IUPUI (2-0) and SIU-Edwardsville (2-0) in succession.

SVETANOFF, LEBEL EARN WEEKLY HONORS

The Cardinals collected a trio of honors following a season-opening shutout victory over No. 16 Tulsa.

Redshirt-freshman goalkeeper Alex Svetanoff was named the ACC Defensive Player of the Week in addition to earning a spot on the College Soccer News Men's National Team Of The Week.

Senior defender Bryce LeBel was also named to the TopDrawerSoccer Men's Team of the Week.

CARDS PICKED THIRD IN ATLANTIC IN ACC PRESEASON POLL

Louisville was picked to finish fourth in the Atlantic Division in the ACC Men's Soccer Preseason Coaches' Poll.

The Cardinals received 34 overall points, slotting in fourth behind Clemson (58), Wake Forest (56) and Syracuse (53). Boston College (23) and NC State (22) rounded out the rest of the Atlantic Division.

Pitt (56) narrowly edged out Duke (51) and Virginia (50) for the top spot in the Coastal Division. North Carolina (39), Notre Dame (28) and Virginia Tech (22) filled out the division.

GUERRA ON MAC HERMANN TROPHY PRESEASON WATCH LIST

Gage Guerra was one of 37 players named to the 2023 MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List.

The junior transferred to Louisville after being named the 2022 Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year after tallying 10 goals and three assists in 15 matches one season ago.

The Hermann Trophy is presented annually by the Missouri Athletic Club and is the nation's highest individual honor recognizing the National Player of the Year as determined by the voting of Division I coaches who are members of United Soccer Coaches.

ROED NAMED TO ACC PRESEASON WATCH LIST

Junior midfielder Sander Roed was the Louisville representative on the ACC Preseason Watch List.

Roed played in all 18 matches as a sophomore in 2022, starting all but one. He finished second in the ACC with eight assists on the season, the seventh-highest total in Louisville program history.

The native of Tranby, Norway is a two-time All-ACC selection, earning third team honors in 2021 and first team recognition last fall.

LOUISVILLE NAMES TWO CAPTAINS FOR 2022 SEASON

Graduate student Ryan Troutman and junior Josh Jones were selected as the team captains for the Cardinals this fall.

Troutman returns for his sixth collegiate season in 2023 and his second in a Louisville uniform. The Louisville native started the final 12 matches in goal for the Cardinals last fall, posting a 6-4-2 overall record with five clean sheets.

Jones has started 34 of 36 matches during the first two years of his Louisville career. He led the Cardinals with over 1,600 minutes played in 2022 and was one of two players to start all 18 matches. Despite playing center back, Jones has recorded five career goals and a pair of assists.

CARDINALS SCHEDULE FILLED WITH RANKED OPPONENTS

Louisville opens up the regular season against 16th-ranked Tulsa, kicking off a loaded 2023 schedule.

The Cards' slate features nine matches against teams that played in last season's NCAA Tournament, four of which reached the Round of 16.

Louisville will square off against seven of the top 20 teams in the United Soccer Coaches preseason rankings - No. 1 Syracuse, No. 3 Kentucky, No. 9 Clemson, No. 10 UNC Greensboro, No. 15 Virginia, No. 16 Tulsa and No. 18 Wake Forest, while having played No. 2 Indiana in a preseason exhibition.

THREE CARDS TAKING ADVANTAGE OF EXTRA COVID SEASON

Louisville's experience level on the pitch got an extra boost as three student-athletes took advantage of an extra year of eligibility due to Covid.

Brandon McManus, Bradley Sample and Ryan Troutman all return for one final season. This fall will mark the fifth collegiate seasons for McManus and Sample and the sixth for Troutman.

The trio combined for nearly 3,800 minutes on the pitch in 2022. McManus was second on the team with four goals, while Sample was one of two Cards to start all 12 matches, and Troutman started the final 12 matches in goal.

DR. MARK & CINDY LYNN STADIUM



After more than a decade of playing in the Cardinal Park Track and Soccer Stadium, the University of Louisville men's and women's soccer teams moved into the premiere soccer venue in the country in 2014.

Dr. Mark & Cindy Lynn Stadium, a \$18.5 million, state-of the-art soccer stadium features seating capacity for more than 5,300 and includes a 15,500-square-foot training center.

The natural turf field is surrounded by chairback seating for 2,300 in the main grandstand, bleacher seating for 900 in the east end zone and two berms, which can accommodate 2,100. It is the second-largest on-campus facility project the Cardinals have built.

In addition to the pitch, the complex surrounding the area is fully loaded to ensure Louisville's student-athletes enjoy their experiences. The building features separate team locker rooms in addition to their opponents, along with coaches' locker rooms. When they are not in competition or training, the men's and women's teams have the ability to spend time in their own lounge areas located in their respective locker rooms.

Also, Cardinal student-athletes and coaches will be provided an 830-square-foot meeting/video room for scouting purposes.

When Louisville is practicing or warming up before a match, they can take advantage of an approximately 700-square-foot indoor warm-up area designed to give the Cardinals the maximum space for training.

For fans entering arguably the best soccer stadium in the country, they are greeted by six ticket windows, staffed by Louisville's ticket office, to help limit long wait times. Upon gaining admission, fans will be greeted by the main concession stand that features up to 14 queues or they can stroll around the concourse that extends around the end lines.

Housed atop the grandstand at midfield, the press box has ample amounts of room and amenities to accommodate those covering the game. Adjacent to the press box is a donor suite, along with a separate television suite, radio suite, an area for the media as well as an operations room.

The Cardinals are 68-28-17 all-time at Dr. Mark and Cindy Lynn Stadium, including 20-13-7 against ranked foes. Lousiville hosted NCAA Championship matches at Lynn Stadium during the 2014, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2022 seasons.


