THE OPENING **TIP**

- 1. Boise State men's basketball hits the road for the first time in 2023-24 as it begins a 10-day road trip on the East Coast. The swing begins on Sunday, Feb. 19, at Clemson. Tipoff is at 11 a.m. MT and will be streamed on ACCNX the ACC's streaming platform through ESPN+. Fans can listen to the game on KBOI 670 AM.
- 2. The Broncos showcased the defensive prowess the program has been known for in recent history in a 63-58 win over San Francisco. The Dons entered the game averaging 106 points per game tied for fourth nationally but were held to under 60 points on 4-of-19 shooting from beyond. Tyson Degenhart led all scorers with 17 points, while Chibuzo Agbo and Max Rice chipped in 15 apiece.
- **3.** Boise State is seeking its third-straight trip to the NCAA Tournament a feat which has

never been accomplished in program history. Four of the nine appearances in March Madness have come under the direction of head coach Leon Rice - the all-time wins leader and winningest coach in program history.

- **4.** This weekend's game continues a stretch of at least five consecutive opponents ranked in the top 100 of KenPom for the Broncos. The Tigers are currently 68th in KenPom, while only one potential opponent at next week's ESPN Events Invitational is ranked outside of the top 100 (VCU-115th).
- **5.** Boise State returns All-Mountain West players Tyson Degenhart (first team) and Max Rice (second team) from last year's squad, as well as Chibuzo Agbo he started 33 games in his first season in the Blue and Orange.

BY THE **NUMBERS**

Boise State is looking for its first victory against an ACC program. The Broncos are 0-4 against the current members of the conference — 0-2 in the Leon Rice era.

The Broncos have gone 6-1 against programs in a Power-5 conference the last three seasons. The lone loss came against Northwestern in the NCAA Tournament last season. Boise State was 3-0 against Power-5 schools in the regular season in 2022-23.

San Francisco entered the Nov. 12 game with the Broncos tied for fourth in the country averaging 106 ppg. Boise State's defense held the Dons 48 points below their average in a 63-58 win.



The Broncos have dominated the glass through two games this season and rank 11th in the country in rebounding marging (+18.5).

The Broncos rank 17th in KenPom in 3-point defense at 21.1-percent — KenPom only utilizes Division I data. To date, the Broncos have allowed only 10 3-pointers.

The Broncos field a much larger team than a year ago with an average heigh of 78.3" (6'5"). They are the 30th-tallest team in Division I, and are taller than Clemson by 0.01"

HE'S BUILT DIFFERENT: During Mountain West play last season, Degenhart established himself as a difference maker for the Broncos. The sophomore averaged 15.1 points per game, 5.2 rebounds per game, with a 31:17 assist-to-turnover ratio while shooting 59.3% from the field

EFFICIENT SHOOTER: Degenhart's 53.7% clip from the field was 21st nationally among players with 348+ field goal attempts last season. His field goal percentage was the highest of any Mountain West player with 300 field goal attempts.

A LITTLE BIT OF EVERYTHING: Degenhart led the Broncos in points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks at least once during last season. The sophomore was one of 18 players in the country, the only from the Mountain West, last season to average 14.1 points per game, 5.3 rebounds per game, 1.8 assists per game and shoot 53.7% from the field.

OLD RELIABLE: Famous for his Degenhart Dozen NIL deal, Degenhart has been reliable for the Broncos in stuffing the stat sheet. He had 16 games with at least 10 points and five rebounds last season and had back-to-back double-doubles against Utah State and UNLV — the first of his career.

Against UNLV on Jan. 11, Degenhart became the only Boise State player since at least 2010-11 to have 17 points, 12 rebounds, six assists to zero turnovers in a game.

SCORING THREAT: Max Rice is the only Boise State player since at least 1992-93 to shoot 43.4% from the field, 40.9% from three and 88% from the free throw line in the same season. He set a career-high for points in a season with 476 points — the 68th time a Bronco has scored 400+ points in a season. In Mountain West games Rice averaged 15.9 points per game.

DOUBLE FIGURES: Max Rice has scored in double figures on 41 occasions with two double-doubles in his career. In 2022-23, Rice reached double figures in 27 games and has hit 20 points six times, including his first career 30-point game against New Mexico.

Boise State is 32-9 when Rice reaches double figures, and 6-1 when he scores at least 20 points.



CHIBUZO AGBO SENIOR | GUARD

HEAT CHECK: Chibuzo Agbo was one of Boise State's best 3-point shooters last season. He was one of three players in the conference (Max Rice and Steven Ashworth) to shoot at least 40.8% from beyond the arc on at least 64 makes. Agbo had seven games with at least four 3-pointers last season.

TWO FOR TWENTY: Chibuzo Agbo led the Broncos in scoring nine times last season with two 20-point outbursts. Agbo scored 18 points in the first half of the win against Utah Valley, and he had a 24-point performance against Loyola Chicago.

MAKE IT DOUBLE: Despite suffering a sprained ankle leading into the Dec. 3 win against Texas A&M, Chibuzo Agbo wasn't slowed down at all. Agbo recorded his first career double-double, scoring 13 points (3-of-8 on 3FG) and a career-high 11 rebounds. Agbo followed up with a 15-point, 11-rebound double-double at Nevada on Dec. 28.

THE TALISMAN: Getting Agbo going has proven to be a difference maker for Boise State this season. The Broncos are 11-3 when Agbo scores at least 15 points, with one loss being by two points, and another coming in overtime at San Jose State.

Broncos Down the Dons

NOV. 12, 2023 | BOISE, IDAHO (EXTRAMILE ARENA)

BOISE, Idaho - Boise State men's basketball held one of the nation's highest-scoring teams to under 60 points and relied on clutch defense down the stretch to defeat San Francisco 63-58, Sunday at ExtraMile Arena.

The Dons entered the game averaging 106 points per game and were held to 21.1-percent from beyond the arc.

San Francisco's Jonathan Mogbo led a blitz coming out of the half - his dunk in the first 70 seconds of the period trimmed Boise State's lead to four points, its smallest since the final media timeout of the first half.

The talisman that is Max Rice made back-to-back 3-pointers in the span of 19 seconds to get the 10,520 crowd at ExtraMile Arena back on its feet and push the Bronco (2-0) lead back to double digits.

A four-minute 25-second scoring drought gave the opening for an 8-0 San Francisco (2-1) run to pull the score within one possession. Chibuzo Agbo drove in from the right corner, fighting through two defenders to score a lay-up and extend Boise State's narrow lead.

Post plays from Agbo and Tyson Degenhart in the final six minutes drew the foul for a pair of and-1's to maintain a narrow Bronco lead. The duo combined to score 16 of Boise State's final 17 points.

San Francisco was threatening to score on a half-court inbound play, but Max Rice was able to poke the ball out of Jonathan Mogbo's hands with 1:25 remaining in a 61-56 game. While the Broncos were unable to score on the ensuing possession, they ran 30 seconds off the clock to limit the Dons to only two possessions the remainder of the game.

San Francisco scored only two points over the final two minutes.

Quotable

- "We had the largest crowd in November, and I like that," said head coach Leon Rice. "We felt the crowd when USF made a run, they lifted us up and got us through those tough moments.'
- "Playing with Tyson (Degenhart), I've noticed him being around makes things so much easier," said Max Rice. "You can give it to him in the post, and if he's doubled they have to rotate so it makes things easier for everyone else."

Top Broncos

- Tyson Degenhart led the Broncos with 17 points, grabbing five rebounds and three steals.
- Max Rice added 15 points and finished with six rebounds and two steals.
- Chibuzo Agbo scored 15 points for Boise State and collected five rebounds.
- O'Mar Stanley shot 3-4 from the field, recording nine points, four rebounds, two assists, a block and a steal off the bench.

Notables

- The announced attendance of 10,520 is the first time Boise State has had a crowd of 10,000 for a November home game.
- Boise State is 16-4 against schools from the WCC under head coach Leon Rice.
- The Broncos improved to 41-18 at home against current members of the WCC.
- Boise State has won 16-straight games at home dating back to a Nov. 26, 2022 win over Utah Valley.
- Chibuzo Agbo and Tyson Degenhart combined to score 16 of Boise State's final 17 points.
- The Broncos held San Francisco the nation's fourth-highest scoring team with an average of 106 per game - to under 60 points.
- Boise State never trailed and led for 38:33.

What's Next

Boise State continues a difficult stretch to open the season with a 10-day road trip through the Southeast. The Broncos return to action Nov. 19 at Clemson before departing straight for the ESPN Events Invitational, Nov. 23-26, in Orlando, Fla.



20 WINS IN 10 OF 13 YEARS: Under head coach Leon Rice, Boise State has hit the 20-win plateau in 10 of his 13 seasons, including nine of the last 11 and six-straight years from 2013-18. The aforementioned streak marked the first time in school history the Broncos won 20 games in six-consecutive seasons. Head coach Bobby Dye and guard Chris Childs led the Broncos to at least 20 wins in 1986-87, 1987-88 and 1988-89, the only previous three-year run. The Broncos had just seven 20-win campaigns since joining Division I before Rice took over.


