#### NOTES

TCU will face No. 24 Clemson on Saturday, Dec. 9 at 3 p.m. CT. in the Discount Tire Hall of Fame Series Toronto. The game will be held at Coca-Cola Coliseum in Toronto, Ontario and televised on FS1.

It will be the Horned Frogs' first regular season game out of the country since the 2015-16 season when they competed in the Cancun Challenge in Cancun, Mexico. TCU has never played in Canada.

TCU and Clemson are two of 13 schools unbeaten on the season. TCU is one of three schools with undefeated reo and cleanson are two or 13 schools dimediated on the season. Too is one or different differenced men's and women's basketball programs, joining Baylor and Colorado State.

TCU's six wins against AP Top 25 teams last season were the most wins over ranked teams in program history.

Of TCU's 34 wins over AP Top 25 teams in its history, 19 have come in the last six seasons under Dixon.

The Horned Frogs are 7-0 for the first time since the 2017-18 season when they were 12-0.

TCU's remaining strength of schedule rank is No. 3 nationally according to ESPN's BPI.

TCU has won its games by an average of 25.6 points per game, which ranks fourth nationally for scoring margin. Emanuel Miller is the reigning Big 12 Player of the Week after averaging 24 points over the two games last week.

Miller, a native of Scarborough, Ontario is averaging 15.9 points per game, which ranks 10th in the Big 12.

Assistant Coach Jamie McNeilly is also from Scarborough, a district of Toronto.

JaKobe Coles ranks fourth in the Big 12 in field goal percentage (61.8) and Peavy ranks sixth (57.8).

Jameer Nelson Jr. leads the Big 12 and ranks sixth nationally with 3.1 steals per game.

Nelson is one of three players nationally that is averaging at least 11.0 points, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game.

TCU leads the nation with 29.0 fastbreak points per game.

TCU ranks second nationally (Kansas) in assists with 22.1 per game and shooting percentage at 53.5 percent.

TCU ranks second in the Big 12 and sixth nationally with 91.7 points per game.

TCU ranks first in the Big 12 and fourth nationally with 18.4 turnovers forced per game.

TCU ranks first in the Big 12 and fourth nationally with 11.9 steals per game.

TCU ranks first in the Big 12 and 12th nationally with 6.1 blocks per game.

TCU ranks second nationally in average possession length at 13.5 seconds per offensive possession. Under Dixon, TCU has gone 75-11 in the months of November and December combined.

Under Dixon, TCU is 29-13 in neutral site games.

TCU was picked to finish fifth in the Big 12 in a poll voted on by the league's coaches.

TCU is receiving votes in the AP Top 25. TCU was No. 22 in the final ranking of the 2022-23 season.

Emanuel Miller scored a career-high 29 points including a buzzer-beating 3-pointer led the TCU men's basketball team to an 84-83 win at Georgetown on Saturday, Dec. 2 at Capital One Arena in Washington, D.C.

JaKobe Coles added 17 points and Avery Anderson III had 11 points.

#### ABOUT THE OPPONENT

Clemson is off to its best start since the 2008-09 season (16-0) after a 72-67 win over South Carolina Wednesday. The Tigers are led by PJ Hall's 20.5 points and 7.8 rebounds per game.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

Clemson leads the all-time series 3-0.

The last meeting was a 62-60 overtime win by the Tigers in Las Vegas, Nev., part of the MGM Resorts Main Event at T-Mobile Arena. Desmond Bane had 17 points, 10 rebounds and six assists.

TCU will play Arizona State on Saturday, Dec. 16 at 9 p.m. at Dickies Arena in Fort Worth, part of the US LBM Coastto-Coast Challenge.

Senior forward Emanuel Miller and assistant coach Jamie McNeilly are both from Scarborough, a district of Toronto.

- ➤ Miller played for Team Canada at the 2022 GLOBL Jam and the 2018 FIBA U18 Americanas Championship. In 2017, he helped Canada to its first-ever gold medal at the 2017 FIBA U19 World Cup.
- > Miller began his high school career at Bill Crothers Secondary School in Markham, Ontario.
- ➤ McNeilly has spent numerous years coaching with Team Canada. Most recently, McNeilly was an assistant coach for the U23 GLOBL Jam this past summer. He also helped lead the gold medal-winning Canadian team in the 2017 FIBA U19 Basketball World Cup with Miller on the team.

#### MILLER NAMED BIG 12 POW

Coming off a career-high 29 points in a win at Georgetown, Emanuel Miller was named the Big 12 Conference Player of the Week on Dec. 4.

- ➤ Miller's 29 points came on a career-best 12-of-18 from the field and matched a career-high with three made 3-pointers on four attempts. His final points came on a game-winning 3-pointer at the buzzer give the Horned Frogs the 84-83 win over the Hoyas.
- ➤ Miller, who earned the award for the second time in his career, also led the Frogs in scoring in the win over Houston Christian earlier that week on Nov. 27 where he had 19 points.
- ➤ He averaged 24 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and one block for the week.

#### IN RARE COMPANY

Jameer Nelson Jr. is one of three players nationally that is averaging at least 11.0 points, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game. Arturo Dean at FIU and Tamin Lipsey at Iowa State is the other. Nelson is averaging 11.7 points, 4.1 assists and 3.1 steals per game.

#### FROG BREAK

TCU leads the nation with with 29.0 fastbreak points per game. The Horned Frogs also led last season at 17.5 fastbreak points per game.

TCU recorded 43 fastbreak points against Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 17. It was the most fastbreak points for a TCU team under Jamie Dixon (since 2016-17).

#### FROG HOME BREAK

TCU has 35 days between it's home games with Houston Christian on Nov. 27 and Texas A6M Commerce on Jan. 1. The 35-day span is the third longest stretch without a home game among NCAA DI programs.

> Delaware is first on the list at 38, followed by UTA at 36.

#### CAPTAIN FROG

> JaKobe Coles, Xavier Cork, Chuck O'Bannon Jr., Emanuel Miller and Micah Peavy are TCU's returning scholarship players and have been named captains for the season by head coach Jamie Dixon. It is the first time in his eight seasons as TCU's head coach that captains have been named.

> Those five captains helped TCU win a game in each of the past two NCAA Tournaments. It was the first time the Frogs have reached consecutive NCAA Tournaments in 70 years.

> This season, TCU is looking for its third-straight trips to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history.

#### OVER 100

TCU has scored 100 or more points in a game twice this season.

- > TCU has scored 100 or more points three times in a season only nine times in its history with the last season coming in 2001-02 when the Frogs reached 100 four times.
- > TCU's 108-75 win over Southern marked the secondhighest-scoring home opener in program history. It was the most in an opener since 1984 when TCU defeated St. Edwards (Texas), 112-71.
- ➤ It was the most points a TCU team had scored since a 108-99 triple overtime win over Texas State on Nov. 4, 2009. It was the most scored in regulation since Jan. 5, 2002, in a 117-108 loss at USF.
- > TCU reached the century mark again in a 101-64 win over Houston Christian on Nov. 27 on the first-career 3-pointer from Darius Ford.

#### NUMBER NUGGETS

- Ernest Udeh Jr. is the first Horned Frog to wear No. 8
- > It is the 11th consecutive season that a player will wear No. 1 (Isaiah Manning).
- $\succ$  Essam Mostafa is the first TCU player in 10 seasons to wear No. 444.
- > Jace Posey is the first TCU player in 12 seasons to wear No. 41.

#### MILLER NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG 12 CONFERENCE

Emanuel Miller was named Preseason All-Big 12 Conference by the league's coaches.

- > Miller became the fourth Horned Frog to be named one of the top five players in the Big 12, prior to the start of the season. Mike Miles Jr. was on the team last season, Desmond Bane was recognized in 2019 and Vladimir Brodziansky was on the 2017 preseason team.
- > Miller was joined on the team by Houston's L.J. Cryer, Texas' Max Abmas and Dajuan Harris Jr. and Hunter Dickinson from Kansas. Dickinson was named the Preseason Player of the Year and Preseason Newcomer of the Year. Baylor's Ja'Kobe Walter was named Preseason Freshman of the Year.

#### FROGS PICKED FIFTH IN BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL

TCU was picked to finish fifth in the Big 12 Conference Preseason Poll, voted on by the league's coaches.

- > TCU was picked fourth last season before matching its best finish ever in the conference, fifth, at 9-9.
- > The entire preseason poll: 1. Kansas, 2. Houston, 3. Texas, 4. Baylor, 5. TCU, 6. Kansas State, 7. Iowa State, 8. Texas Tech, 9. West Virginia, 10. Oklahoma State, 11. Cincinnati, 12. Oklahoma. 13. BYU. 14. UCF.

#### **AGE AND EXPERIENCE**

TCU returned five players from last season's team and added five experienced transfers along with two freshmen.

- > TĈU's roster is made up of five 1,000-point scorers, the most in the country. Those five are Avery Anderson III, Emanuel Miller, Essam Mostafa, Jameer Nelson Jr. and Trevian Tennyson. St. Johns is second on that list with four 1,000-point scorers.
- Born March 1, 1999, Chuck O'Bannon Jr. is the sixth oldest NCAA DI player. When March Madness occurs, Chuck will be 25 years old. TCU's other 90's baby is Essam Mostafa is the 18th oldest on that list, born Aug. 3, 1999.
   Only Juan Munoz at Hawaii and Seth Towns at Howard,
- ➤ Only Juan Munoz at Hawaii and Seth Towns at Howard, who are in their eighth year playing college basketball, have played more years than Chuck O'Bannon Jr. O'Bannon is in his fourth season at TCU after playing three seasons at USC.

- > TCU is second in the Big 12 in minutes returning from last season at 49.9 percent. BYU is first at 74.3 percent.
- > TCU ranks as the fourth-most experienced team by KenPom at 3.27 years.
- TCU's average roster age of 21.4 is tied for the fifth oldest. Cincinnati is the oldest at 22.5, Middle Tennessee State is second at 21.9, followed by St. Bonaventure (21.7), Illinois State (21.6) and UTA (21.4).
- > TCU has nine players on its roster who have a careerhigh of 20 points or more in a game, which is the most in the nation. BYU, Missouri and New Mexico are tied for second with eight.

#### TOTAL POINTS ON THE ROSTER

TCU boasts the most points per game (2022-23 season) on its roster heading into this season.

- > The Frogs have 41.2 points per game returing and add 62.4 points per game via the incoming transfer class. The total of 103.6 returning points per game leads the country. Arkansas is second at 103.3 points per game and Clemson is third with 100.1 points per game.
- Entering the season, TCU's roster totaled 8,499 career points, which led the country. Arkansas was second on the list at 7,026 and St. Bonaventure was third at 6,969.

#### WHO IS YOUR DADDY AND WHAT DOES HE DO

TCU has three players whose fathers played in the NBA.

Jameer Nelson Jr.'s dad, Jameer Nelson, was the 20th overall pick in the 2004 NBA Draft. He played for seven teams over 14 seasons (2004-2018) and averaged 11.3 points and 5.1 assists. Nelson is currently the GM of the Delaware Blue Coats of the NBA G League.

- > Chuck O'Bannon Jr.'s dad, Charles O'Bannon, was a second round pick in the 1997 NBA Draft. He played for the Detroit Pistons for two seasons (1997-99). The O'Bannon's share the same jersey number, 5.
- > Jace Posey's dad, James Posey, was the 18th overall pick in the 1999 NBA Draft. He played for eight teams over 12 seasons in the NBA and averaged 8.6 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.6 assists. Jace wears the same number as his father, 41.

#### FALL COMES, FROGS RISE

> Since the 2014-15 season, the Frogs have gone 50-6 in the month of November and 90-15 in November and December combined. Under Jamie Dixon (since 2016-17), TCU has gone 75-11 in November and December combined.

#### 2023 SIGNING CLASS

TCU signed Malick Diallo, David Punch, Micah Robinson and Ashton Simmons on Nov. 8.

➤ For the second-straight signing period, the Horned Frogs have a class that's nationally acclaimed. The signing class, which features three players from Texas, ranks 11th in the nation according to 247Sports. In the 2023 spring signing period, TCU added five transfers, which ranked third

nationally in the 2023 transfer rankings.

- > The three Texans are all ranked in the top 10 in the state with Robinson (Frisco) at No. 4, Punch (Killeen) at No. 8 and Simmons (Beaumont) at No. 10. Punch and Robinson are also listed in the top 100 nationally. Punch is No. 99 and Robinson is No. 73.
- > With a grade of .9637, the 6-6 forward, Robinson is the third-highest rated recruit in program history according to 247Sports. Ranked above Robinson were No. 1 Blake Adams (2003) and No. 2 PJ Fuller (2019). Punch is eighth on that list and Diallo is ninth.
- > The one player not from the state of Texas is Diallo, who is a native of Bamako, Mali. At 6-10, Diallo is a rated as four-stars by ESPN. Currently in his final season at Wasatch Academy in Mt. Pleasant, Utah, Diallo is ranked as the 113th player in the country according to 0n3 Sports.

#### FROGS ABROAD

Allowed once every four years by the NCAA, TCU went on a foreign tour to Paris and London, Aug. 4-12. The team was able to have 10 additional practices leading up to departure on Aug. 3. The Horned Frogs cruised to four wins, but also spent time sightseeing which included a cruise on Seine River, visiting the Eiffel Tower, the Trocadero Steps, PSG Stadium, a Millwall-Bristol City soccer match and Arc de Triomphe.

- > TCU scored over 100 points in all four games and won by an average of 35.2 points per game.
- > TCU's wins were over Paris All-Stars (59-34), Elite Basket Congo (124-78), Barking Abbey Academy (106-86) and Surry (101-61).
- Essam Mostafa led TCU in both points (12.8) and rebounds (5.0) over four games. Mostafa was 20-of-26 for 76.9 percent.
- > Other standouts over the four days included Trevian Tennyson who averaged 10.5 points and was 17-of-24 from the field including 9-of-13 from three. JaKobe Coles averaged 10.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists.

- ➤ Under Dixon in Schollmaier Arena, TCU is 96-34 overall and 34-29 in Big 12 games.
- ➤ Under Dixon, TCU is 92-13 overall against nonconference teams overall and 61-5 against nonconference opponents at Schollmaier Arena. The five losses were to Northwestern State on Nov. 14, 2022, Providence on Dec. 9, 2020, Xavier on Dec. 22, 2019, Lipscomb on Nov. 20, 2019 and Auburn on Jan. 28, 2017.
- > TCU won 89 home games in the seven years under Dixon, the most wins at home in a seven-year period. Billy Tubbs is second on that list with 88.
- > The Frogs had won eight straight Big 12 home games until a loss to No. 14 Kansas on Feb. 11, 2019, which was the most for TCU in a conference since the 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99 seasons when the Frogs won nine straight in the Western Athletic Conference.

All practices are generally closed unless otherwise specified. TV crews and photographers are only permitted to shoot practice after receiving permission from the communications office.

All media passes available for pickup on game day will be left at media will call, located in the main tunnel of Ed and Rae Schollmaier Arena.

#### MEDIA CREDENTIAL REQUESTS

All credential requests for home TCU baskethall games will only be accepted through an online system. Please visit the site, located on the men's baskethall page of GoFrogs.com for complete instructions on submitting the application form. Requests should be received no later than noon, two days prior to the game.

The TCU Athletics Communications Office will provide rosters of both teams, game notes and statistics to accredited media members for each home contest inside the media room on the lower level of Schollmaier Arena. Complete statistics and game books will be available following each game. Media wishing to file stories after the game may do so in the press conference/media room, while food and drinks will be available for working media members prior to each home game in the same location.

#### RADIO BROADCASTS

Four (4) courtesy telephone lines, as well as two (2) ISDN SPIDS, are available courtside on press row for the visiting team's official radio station. The Frogs (4-1) led 52-37 after an RJ Nembhard layup with 7:39 remaining in regulation. However, the Tigers (5-1) forced the Frogs scoreless and forced eight turnovers the remainder of regulation to force overtime. Clemson ended the period on a 15-0 run.

The overtime period featured six lead changes, but Clemson's defense stepped up over the final 2:40 of overtime as it held TCU scoreless and forced two turnovers to seal the victory for the Tigers.

Senior Edric Dennis scored a team-high 18 points on 5-of-12 shooting from 3-point range. Senior Desmond Bane had 17 points and 10 rebounds for a double-double. Sophomore Kevin Samuel also had a double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds.

#### **ABOUT THE UNIFORMS**

For the first time in six seasons, TCU men's basketball debuted new uniforms in the 2022-23 season.

1,000-point scorers

- $\succ$  The design on the side of the uniforms are "SPINES" which represent the anatomical spines on the Horned Frog.
- > From an frontal and rear view, the "SPINES" are represented to imitate the spines on the top and bottom of the Frog. The view can be seen when a player is at the free-throw line and seeing just hints of the tips of the spines.
- > The red line in the middle has multiple meanings the bloodline that shoots from the eyes of the Horned Frog when threatened. It also a represents the 'Blood is Thicker Than Water' mentality that a close family has in their bloodline
- > The design originates from the myth/origin of the horned lizard itself. The "ZIG ZAG" motif is often found in Texas Native America culture as a representation of lightning striking the earth and the red representing the horned lizard fighting back to a much bigger foe.
- > The origin of the horned lizard is a fight between the lizard and lightning. Lightning states it can defeat anything on earth and challenged the lizard to four strikes (hence the four combined ZIG ZAGS on the sides of the uniform). Lightning missed the quick lizard and the Horned Frog "SPINED" the lightning from above. As payment, lightning now sends SPINES of light throughout the sky as homage to the tiny, yet mighty, Horned Frog.

- #1. Desmond Bane (6'6"-G-1998, played in 2016-20, plays pro in the NBA) led Memphis Grizzlies to a surprising victory over the Dallas Mavericks (11-7) 108-94 in the NBA on Friday night. He was MVP of the game. Bane recorded 30 points (!!!), 4 rebounds, 5 assists and made 2 blocks in 34 minutes. The Memphis Grizzlies have not so impressive 5-13 record this season. But this is still an early stage of the season and everything may happen. Bane has individually a very good year with high stats. He averages 23.6ppg, 4.5rpg, 5.2apg and 1.3spg.
- #2. Kenrich Williams (6'6"-G/F-1994, played in 2014-18, plays in the NBA) could not help the Oklahoma City Thunder (12-6) in their last game. Despite Williams' good performance the Oklahoma City Thunder (12-6) lost 123-127 on the road to the Philadelphia 76ers. He recorded 11 points. But the season just started, so everything may happen. It's Williams' fourth year with the team. This season Williams averages 5.8ppg, 2.6ppg and 2.0apg in eight games he played so far.
- #3. Damion Baugh (6'4"-G-2000, graduated '2024, currently in the NBA G League) led South Bay Lakers to an easy victory against the G League Ignite (0-8) crushing them 150-126 in the NBA G League last Sunday. He scored 17 points, had 7 rebounds and dished 5 assists in 33 minutes; quite an impressive performance considering it's only Baugh's first season in pro basketball. The South Bay Lakers have a solid 5-3 record this season. It was his team's fourth consecutive victory in a row. But the season is still in its first stage and everything can happen. It's Baugh's first year with the team. This season he averages 8.8ppg, 3.7rpg, 3.5apg and 1.3spg.
- #4. Experienced Jarvis Ray (6'6"-F-1990, played in 2010-14, plays pro in Georgia) led Delta to an easy victory against the closely-ranked Rustavi (3-1) 94-79 in the Georgian Superleague on Sunday night. Ray recorded 16 points. It was the game of the round between two top 4 ranked teams. Delta Gurjaani (5-2) is placed first in the Superleague. There are only three games left until the end of the Regular Season. So now every game will be critical. It's Ray's first season with the team. He has relatively good stats this year 12.6ppg, 4.4rpg and 1.9apg in seven games.
- #5. Garlon Green (6'7"-F-1991, played in 2009-13, plays in France) was not able to help Sharks Antibes (5-3) in their game last Friday. Despite his very good performance Sharks Antibes was badly defeated93-77 in Evreux by the much lower-ranked ALM Evreux (#10). Green was the second best scorer with 16 points in 32 minutes. But the season is still in its first stage and everything can happen. It's Green's first year with the team. He has relatively good stats this season 14.1ppg, 3.4rpg and 1.8apg.
- #6. Chauncey Collins (6'1"-PG-1995, played in 2014-16, currently in Lithuania) led Mazeikiai to a victory against the closely-ranked Gargzdu 77-66 in the Lithuanian LKL last Saturday. He scored 13 points and added 3 assists. This year Collins averages 9.1ppg, 2.1rpg, 2.7apg and 1.1spg in 11 games.
- #7. Mike Miles Jr. (6'2"-G-2002, played in 2020-23, plays pro in the NBA G League) was not able to secure a victory for the Texas Legends in their game against the Rio Grande Valley Vipers in the NBA G League. Miles Jr. scored 6 points and added 3 assists in 18 minutes. His team were defeated 123-114 in the NBA G League. This season he averages 6.7ppg, 2.3rpg and 2.0apg.
- #8. Kevin Langford (6'8"-C/F-1985, played in 2005-05, plays in Switzerland) contributed to an easy victory against the closely-ranked Geneve 77-60 in the Swiss SBL in Saturday night's game. Langford recorded 7 points. This year he averages 6.7ppg and 3.4rpg in 10 games.
- #9. Kyan Anderson (5'11"-PG-1992, played in 2011-15, currently in Turkey) couldn't help Ankaragucu in their game against Gaziantep in the Turkish TBL (second division). He scored 7 points and added 8 passes in 34 minutes. His team was defeated 96-85. This season Anderson has very high stats. He averages 20.7ppg, 2.2rpg and 6.2apg.
- #10. Nikola Gacesa (6'9"-F/C-1987, played in 2010-11, plays pro in Serbia) contributed to Gajdobra's victory against the tenth-ranked KK Klik Arilje 109-103 in the Serbian 2MLS (second division) on Sunday night. He had a double-double by scoring 18 points and getting 10 rebounds. Gacesa has very impressive stats this year 18.2ppg, 6.1rpg and 2.4apg in nine games.
