THE OPENING TIP

- Pitt opens ACC play Sunday, Dec. 3 at the Petersen Events Center against Clemson. Opening tip is scheduled for 2 p.m. with James Westling and Randolph Childress calling the action on the ACC Network.
- · The Panthers are 3-2 under Jeff Capel in conference openers and 5-5 in the ACC opener in their first 10 seasons in the league. Pitt is opening ACC play at the Petersen Events Center for the first time since the 2019-20 season.
- · Sunday's game marks the fourth of five consecutive contests against Power Six conference teams for the Panthers. Pitt concludes the stretch with a road game in the Backyard Brawl at West Virginia (Dec. 6).
- Blake Hinson ranks fifth in the ACC in scoring (19.6 ppg.) and first in three-point field goals (24) for the season. He has scored 16 or more points and made three or more three-pointers in each of the past six contests.
- Ishmael Leggett has grabbed seven or more rebounds in six consecutive contests and leads ACC guards in rebounding. He is averaging 14.9 points, 7.9 rebounds, 3.3 assists, and 1.7 steals per game this season.
- · Carlton Carrington, a two-time ACC Rookie of the Week honoree, has scored in double figures six times and is averaging 14.9 points, 5.6 rebounds, and 5.9 assists through the first seven games of the season.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Blake Hinson has started 42 of 43 games at Pitt and scored in double-figures 37 times as a Panther, including all seven games this season. He has topped the 20-point mark in three of the past six contests.
- Ishmael Leggett has started 76 consecutive games with 50 double figure scoring efforts in that stretch. He has scored 10 or more points in 35 of his past 38 games, including all seven games this season. Leggett is averaging 14.9 points, 7.9 rebounds, and 3.3 assists per game this season.
- Carlton Carrington leads the ACC in assists (5.9 apg.) while also ranking among the league leaders in three-point field goals (T-8th 2.43 3PG), free throw percentage (15th .826), and assist-to-turnover ratio (5th 3.15:1). He has scored in double figures six times with five or more assists on four occasions.
- Federiko Federiko has grabbed four or more offensive rebounds in five games and ranks second in the ACC in offensive rebounding (3.57 orpg.). He has also blocked two or more shots in six of the first seven games and is tied for third in the ACC in blocks (2.43 bpg.).
- Zack Austin is averaging 8.0 points, 6.1 rebounds, and 1.7 blocks in 24.5 minutes per game. He has a pair of double-figure scoring games, five games with five or more rebounds, and three games with two or more blocks.
- Twins Guillermo Diaz Graham and Jorge Diaz Graham combine to average 12.3 points and 8.0 rebounds per game, while shooting 28-of-53 (.528) from the field, including 10-of-27 (.370) from three-point range.
- Blake Hinson is averaging 20.8 points per game, while going 19-of-41 (.463) from three-point range in five games at the Petersen Events Center this season. He has three 20+ point games at home on the season.
- The post tandem of **Federiko Federiko** and **Guillermo Diaz Graham** combines to average 13.5 points, 11.5 rebounds, and 3.1 blocks in 39.5 minutes per game.

- Pitt has won six consecutive ACC contests at the Petersen Events Center, its longest home winning streak in conference play since joining the league prior to the 2013-14 season. The Panthers were 8-2 a season ago against ACC foes at the Pete.
- The Panthers rank fourth in the NCAA in rebound margin (+14.6) and sixth in rebounds per game (46.3 rpg.). Pitt outrebounded its first six opponents of the season before losing the rebounding battle against Missouri.
- Pitt has six players Ishmael Leggett (7.9 rpg.), Federiko Federiko (6.6 rpg.), Zack Austin (6.1 rpg.), Carlton Carrington (5.6 rpg.), Guillermo Diaz Graham (4.9 rpg.), and Blake Hinson (4.7 rpg.) averaging at least 4.5 rebounds per game.
- Pitt is averaging 10.0 three-point field goals per game (2nd in the ACC; T-24th in the NCAA) with Blake Hinson and Carlton Carrington combining for 41 of the team's 70 threes. Clemson enters Sunday's contest leading the ACC in three-pointers (61), while ranking second in three-point percentage (.415).
- The Panthers lead the ACC and rank 15th in the NCAA in three-point percentage defense (.255). Pitt has held two opponents below 10 percent shooting and four of its seven opponents below 30 percent shooting from beyond the arc.

LAST TIME OUT

- Pitt nearly recovered from a season-low shooting effort before falling to Missouri, 71-64, in a tightly contest matchup at the Petersen Events Center.
- Blake Hinson scored a game-high 22 points on 7-of-12 shooting from the field, but the rest of the Panthers went just 9-of-35 (.257) from the floor as Pitt moved to 5-2 on the season.
- Hinson went 5-of-8 from three-point range and snapped an eight-minute stretch with no field goals with consecutive threes with 2:59 and 2:30 remaining to cut the score to 64-62.
- Pitt shot a season-low 34.0 percent (16-of-47) from the field, including a 7-of-25 (.280) effort from three-point range. The Panthers remained in striking distance with a 25-of-31 (.806) effort from the free throw line.
- Carlton Carrington added 13 points, seven rebounds, and four assists, while Ishmael Leggett finished with 10 points, seven rebounds, three assists, and two steals.
- Pitt was outrebounded, 36-33, for the first time this season. The Panthers entered the game ranked among the ACC leaders in rebounding and rebound margin.

PANTHER SPOTLIGHTS



• Carlton Carrington is one of seven players in the NCAA currently averaging at least 14.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, and 5.5 assists per game.



• Ishmael Leggett has made 20 consecutive free throw attempts and now ranks sixth in the ACC in free throw percentage (.903 - 28-of-31) on the season.



• Blake Hinson has made at least one threepointer in 20 consecutive games and in 41 of 43 games as a Panther. He is 121-of-317 (.382) from three-point range at Pitt.

BUILDING ON ALL-ACC SEASON

- · Blake Hinson has scored in double figures in each of the first seven games, while topping the 20-point mark three times. He currently ranks among the ACC leaders in scoring (5th - 19.6 ppg.), three-point field goals (1st - 3.43 3pg.), and three-point percentage (4th - .393).
- Hinson has registered 1,235 points (12.0 ppg.), 473 rebounds (4.6 rpg.), and 212 three-point field goals in 103 career games.
- · Hinson has scored in double-figures 61 times in his career and has made three or more threepointers in a game 35 times.
- · A Second Team All-ACC selection a year ago, Hinson was one of two players in the NCAA last season to average at least 15.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, while making more than 95 three-point field goals. He is one of 25 players to accomplish that feat since the 1992-93 season.
- · Hinson scored a season-high 26 points on 8-of-14 shooting from the field, including 4-of-9 from three-point range, in a win over Binghamton.
- · Hinson made three threes and finished with 18 points and five rebounds against FGCU.
- · Hinson scored 25 points in just 21 minutes of action in a win over Jacksonville. He scored 21 of his 25 points in the opening half, while posting the fifth best scoring efficiency per minute in a 20-point game in program history. Hinson went 4-of-9 from three-point range in the contest and grabbed six rebounds.
- · Hinson averaged 16.5 points per game, while making three three-pointers against Florida and Oregon State in the NIT Season Tip-Off.
- · Hinson went 7-of-12 from the field, including 5-of-8 from three-point range, and finished with 22 points and five rebounds against Missouri.

STUFFING THE STAT SHEET

- Transfer Ishmael Leggett gives the Panthers an experienced and productive player in the backcourt. Last season at Rhode Island, he averaged 16.4 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 2.4 assists per game.
- · Leggett scored in double figures in 28 of 31 games played with six 20+ point efforts and a pair of 30+ point outings a year ago.
- Leggett, who has two seasons of eligibility remaining, has scored 1,036 career points.
- · Leggett is averaging 14.9 points, 7.9 rebounds, 3.3 assists, and 1.7 steals per game, while shooting 90.3 percent (28-of-31) from the foul line. He has scored in double figures in all seven games and grabbed seven or more rebounds in each of the past six games.
- · Leggett's 14.9 points per game scoring average this season is tied for fifth best among ACC transfers.
- · Leggett ranks among the ACC leaders in scoring (T-19th - 14.9 ppg.), rebounds (T-7th - 7.9 rpg.), free throw percentage (6th - .903), steals (T-9th - 1.7 spg.), offensive rebounds (10th - 2.29 orpg.), and defensive rebounds (10th - 5.57 drpg.).
- · Leggett posted 18 points, 11 rebounds, five assists, and four steals in a win over Binghamton to become the first Pitt player with 15+ points, 10+ rebounds, 5+ assists, and 4+ steals since Kellii Taylor accomplished that feat during the 1996-97 season.
- · Leggett recorded 17 points, seven rebounds, five assists, and two steals against FGCU.
- · Leggett delivered 14 points, nine rebounds, and four assists in a win over Jacksonville.
- Leggett made three three-pointers and finished with 19 points, nine rebounds, and two steals against Florida.
- · Leggett went 6-of-12 from the field in a 15-point, 7-rebound, 3-assist effort in an NIT Season Tip-Off win over Oregon State.

TRIPLE-DUB BUB

- Carlton 'Bub' Carrington is averaging 14.9 points, 5.6 rebounds, and 5.9 assists per game. He became the first Pitt freshman to score 15 or more points in each of his first four games and has six double-figure scoring games on the season.
- Carrington is one of seven players in the NCAA currently averaging at least 14.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, and 5.5 assists per game.
- Carrington leads the ACC in assists, while also ranking tied for 19th in scoring, tied for eighth in three-point field goals (2.43 3pg.), 15th in free throw percentage (.826), and fifth in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.15:1).
- Carrington was named ACC Rookie of the Week in each of the first two weeks of the season. He is the first Pitt freshman to earn conference ROTW accolades in back-to-back weeks since DeJuan Blair (Dec. 17 & 24, 2007).

- Carrington delivered a memorable debut as a Panther becoming just the second freshman in ACC history to record a triple-double in their first collegiate game. Carrington finished with 18 points, 12 rebounds, and 10 assists for the first Pitt triple-double since the 1997-98 season and the fifth overall in program history.
- Carrington posted the 10th triple-double by an ACC freshman in league history. He and Dennis Scott (Georgia Tech) are the only freshman to record a triple-double in their first game.
- Carrington also became the first Division I player to record a triple-double in his debut since Notre Dame's Chris Thomas accomplished that feat against New Hampshire Nov. 16, 2001.
- Carrington's triple-double against NC A&T was the 22nd by a freshman in the NCAA since the start of the 2009-10 season.
- Carrington knocked down three three-pointers and finished with 18 points and four assists against Binghamton.
- Carrington scored 19 points to go along with four rebounds and seven assists in a win over FGCU.
- Carrington had 17 points, three rebounds, and four assists against Jacksonville. He went 5-of-8 from three-point range with the five threes tied for third most in a game by a Pitt freshman.
- Carrington delivered 14 points, four rebounds and seven assists against Florida in the NIT Season Tip-Off.
- Carrington finished with 13 points, seven rebounds, and four assists against Missouri in the ACC-SEC Challenge.

- Federiko Federiko averaged 6.6 points, 5.3 rebounds, and 1.66 blocks in 23.4 minutes per game, while shooting a team-best 94-of-141 (.667) from the field last season. He had eight double-figure scoring games, 15 games with seven or more rebounds and 12 games with three or more blocks.
- Federiko became just the fourth player (five times) in program history to shoot 60 percent or better from the field in a season (minimum 4.0 attempts per game).
- Federiko is averaging 6.1 points, 6.6 rebounds (3.57 orpg.), and 2.43 blocks per game this season. He has one double-double and has blocked three or more shots in four games.

- Federiko has two double-figure scoring efforts and is shooting 61.5 percent (16-of-26) from the field.
- Federiko ranks among the ACC leaders in blocks (T-3rd 2.43 bpg.) and offensive rebounds (2nd 3.57).
- Federiko recorded his second career doubledouble in the season opener against NC A&T, finishing with 13 points and 10 rebounds to go along with a career-high matching four blocks.
- Federiko had nine points, seven rebounds, and three blocks against FGCU. Six of the seven rebounds came on the offensive end of the floor and he also had three dunks in the win.
- Federiko went a perfect 3-of-3 from the field and 4-of-4 from the foul line in a 10-point, 5-rebound, 2-assist, 2-block effort in a win over Oregon State.

THREE & D PROFILE

- Newcomer Zack Austin is averaging 8.0 points, 6.1 rebounds, and 1.7 blocks through the first seven games of the season. He had scored in double figures twice and grabbed seven or more rebounds three times.
- Austin ranks among the ACC leaders in blocks (7th 1.71 bpg.), rebounds (T-17th 6.1 rpg.), and defensive rebounds (T-14th 4.86 drpg.).
- The 6-7 forward is the only player to make 60 or more threes and block 60 or more shots in each of the past two seasons. He is one of nine players to accomplish that feat in the past 31 seasons of college basketball. Austin and Shane Battier (Duke) are the only two players to reach the 60/60 mark in multiple seasons.
- Austin, who has two seasons of eligibility remaining, has posted 953 points, 467 rebounds, 147 blocks, and 135 three-pointers in 70 career games.
- Ausin posted seven rebounds and a seasonhigh four blocks in a win over Jacksonville.
- Ausin had 10 points, nine rebounds, one block, and one steals against Florida in the NIT Season Tip-Off.
- Ausin scored a season-high 19 points to go along with eight rebounds and two steals in a win over Oregon State. He was 5-of-9 from the field, including 3-of-6 from three-point range, versus the Beavers.

TORRES GEMELAS

- Twin brothers **Guillermo Diaz Graham** (7-0) and **Jorge Diaz Graham** (6-11) are combining to average 12.3 points and 8.0 rebounds per game, while shooting 52.8 percent (28-of-53) from the field.
- Both brothers bypassed the opportunity to play for the Spain U21 team this summer and staying in Pittsburgh to continue to work on their strength and conditioning. The twins both gained roughly 15 pounds of muscle in the offseason, while continuing to develop their well-rounded skill sets.

GUILLERMO

- Averaging 7.4 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 1.0 steals per game. He has a pair of double-figure scoring games and one double-double.
- Ranks tied for 14th in the ACC in offensive rebounds (2.0 orpg.).
- Scored 12 points on 4-of-5 shooting from the field, including 2-of-3 from three-point range, against Binghamton. He added four rebounds, two steals and a blocked shot.
- Posted his first double-double with 23 points and 10 rebounds to go along with four assists, two steals, and a block against Jacksonville. He went 8-of-10 from the field and 6-of-9 from the foul line in the win.

JORGE

- Is contributing 4.9 points and 3.1 rebounds in 11.0 minutes per game, while shooting 55.6 percent (10-of-18) from the field.
- Scored a career-high 14 points on 5-of-5 shooting from the field, including 3-of-3 from three-point range, in the opener against NC A&T. He added five rebounds and a blocked shot in the win
- Posted eight points and grabbed six rebounds against Jacksonville.

RETURNING FROM REDSHIRT SEASON

- Redshirt junior **William Jeffress** returns to the Pitt rotation after missing the 2022-23 season due to a foot injury suffered in late July.
- Jeffress, a versatile defender with great rebounding instincts, used the redshirt season to continue to develop his body and has shown increased athleticism and explosiveness in the offseason.
- Jeffress posted seven points, four rebounds, three steals and a blocked shot in his return against NC A&T.
- Jeffress impacted Pitt's win over FGCU with a strong defensive and rebounding effort. The team was +14 with him on the floor as Jeffress finished with two points, five rebounds, two steals, and a blocked shot.

PORTAL ADDITIONS

- Pitt used the Division I transfer portal to add a trio of veteran players to the 2023-24 roster. Zack Austin (High Point), Ishmael Leggett (Rhode Island) and Michael Hueitt, Jr. (Old Dominion/UNC Greensboro) have combined for 2,199 points, 937 rebounds, 285 assists, and 288 three-point field goals in their careers.
- Austin and Leggett combined to average 30.5 points and 11.2 rebounds per game with 111 three-point field goals during the 2022-23 season.

TOP MARKS IN BIG WIN OVER JACKSONVILLE

- Pitt posted its highest scoring output (107) and largest margin of victory (+51) in a mid-November win over Jacksonville.
- Pitt made a season-best 15 three-point field goals, fifth most in program history, while also holding Jacksonville to just 1-of-15 (.067) shooting from beyond the arc.
- Pitt grabbed 50 or more rebounds for the third time in four games finishing the night with a 51-29 edge on the glass, including a 19-3 advantage in offensive rebounds. Jacksonville entered the contest ranked among the top teams in the NCAA in rebounding (49.5 rpg.). Six Panthers grabbed five or more rebounds in the game.

CUMMINGS & NDIAYE SIGN NLI

- Pitt signed Brandin Cummings and Amdy Ndiaye during the November signing period.
- Cummings, a four-star guard prospect from nearby Lincoln Park High School, was a Pittsburgh Post Gazette Fab 5 and 4A Co-Player of the Year selection after averaging 23.1 points, 3.3 rebounds, and 2.3 assists per game as a junior. He made 75 three-point field goals while helping the Leopards to WPIAL and PIAA Class 4A titles a year ago. Cummings, the younger brother of Pitt standout Nelly Cummings, enters his senior season at Lincoln Park with 1,482 points and 186 three-pointers in his career.
- Ndiaye, a three-star prospect currently playing a prep year at Putnam Science Academy, was a NYSSWA All-State selection last season after helping Long Island Lutheran to a 24-3 record, including a 10-2 mark in the National Interscholastic Basketball Conference. The 6-10, 215-pound forward averaged 8.4 points, 6.1 rebounds, and 1.2 blocks per game in conference play as LUHI finished the year ranked No. 3 nationally. Ndiaye, a versatile, high-ceiling player with the ability to impact the game on both ends of the floor, also shot 35 percent from three-point range a year ago.


