CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has played all of its games at home, defeated USC Upstate 12-6 on Tuesday behind five homers, its most since 2022.
- The Tigers are averaging 8.6 runs per game and hitting .330 with a .570 slugging percentage, .441 on-base percentage and six steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.62 ERA, .236 opponents' batting average and 2.20 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .950.

SOUTH CAROLINA OVERVIEW

- South Carolina, which has played all its games at home and is averaging 9.3 runs per game, is led by seventh-year Head Coach Mark Kingston.
- The Gamecocks defeated Gardner-Webb 7-1 on Tuesday. They are hitting .285 and have a 2.40 ERA and .968 fielding percentage.
- Former Tiger Dylan Brewer is hitting .519, Ethan Petry is batting .357 with three homers and Garrett Gainey has the team's lone save.

STORIED RIVALRY

- South Carolina is Clemson's most-common opponent in history, as the two have played 333 times dating to 1899.
- The two have met at least once every year since 1945, with the exception of 1984. Therefore, the two have met each of the last 39 years.
- The season matchups went to a three-game, weekend-series format in 2010 after the two teams played four midweek games for decades.
- South Carolina leads the series 8-6 in regular-season, neutral-site contests since 2010.
- South Carolina leads the series 12-6 at Founders Park (opened in 2009).

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,807 fans per home date (8), the 11th-highest figure in the nation and first in the ACC (through games of Feb. 28).
- Entering 2024, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance for 30 straight seasons.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 10 in the nation by Baseball America and D1Baseball this week, its third weekly ranking in a row in 2024.

- Clemson was ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks in 2023. It has a current streak of 11 weeks in a row.

- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

CAPTAINS

- Billy Barlow, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Jacob Jarrell, Jimmy Obertop, Ty Olenchuk and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains.
- Wright was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2023.
- Joe Allen, Nolan Nawrocki, Rocco Reid and Will Taylor were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Aidan Knaak, Jarren Purify and Drew Titsworth were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

GRAND MOMENTS

- Clemson has hit three grand slams in eight games in 2024.
- Clemson hit six grand slams in 2023.
- The Tiger record for grand slams in a season is eight, set in 2010.
- In the season opener against Xavier on Feb. 16, Clemson hit two grand slams (Alden Mathes, Nolan Nawrocki) to tie the school record.
- It was the third time Clemson hit two grand slams in a game, as it did so on March 3, 1991 (Louisiana) and March 7, 2010 (South Carolina).
- Jarren Purify hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-3 win against Presbyterian on Feb. 20 for his first career hit.

CANNARELLA CAN

- Sophomore outfielder Cam Cannarella has picked up in 2024 where he left off in 2023, when he was ACC Freshman-of-the-Year.
- He is hitting .517 with a double, two homers, 10 RBIs, eight runs and a .576 on-base percentage in seven games.
- He has four three-hit games.
- He has hit safely in all seven of his games in 2024 and has an active 16-game hitting streak dating to 2023.
- He has an active 24-game on-base streak dating to 2023.
- He is hitting .700 with runners on base, .600 with runners in scoring position and .667 with two outs.
- In his career, he is hitting .401 with 17 doubles, three triples, nine homers, 57 RBIs and 80 runs in 66 games.
- In his career, he has a .581 slugging percentage, .474 on-base percentage and 24 steals.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 64 of his 66 games in his career.

DARDEN PITCHING EFFECTIVELY AGAIN

- Sophomore lefthander Ethan Darden emerged as a freshman in 2023 as a dependable weekend starter.
- He has picked up where he left off with consistent outings in 2024.
- He is 2-0 with an 0.00 ERA, .111 opponents' batting average and six strikeouts in 5.1 innings pitched over three relief appearances.
- He has only allowed one walk.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of one-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on Feb. 27.
- In his career, he is 5-2 with a 5.04 ERA, .257 opponents' batting average and 51 strikeouts in 60.2 innings pitched over 22 appearances.

MATHES PUTTING UP NUMBERS

- Senior outfielder Alden Mathes has transferred in from Richmond and has made an immediate impact.
- He is hitting .409 with a homer, double, seven RBIs, nine runs, a .622 on-base percentage and two steals in eight games in 2024.
- He has 11 walks and three hit-by-pitches against only two strikeouts.
- He hit a grand slam in his first plate appearance as a Tiger against Xavier on Feb. 16.
