# HEAD COACH ALLISON KWOLEK

Since being hired on August 2, 2021, Head Coach Allison Kwolek has established Clemson lacrosse as one of the nations premiere programs. She recruited her first two classes in three months time and then brought on board transfers from across the country to solidify her inaugural roster. The 2027 class that Kwolek recruited was named the No. 4 overall class in the country. Unlike other first year programs, Clemson jumped right into playing games when its players arrived on campus in August of 2022.

Coach Kwolek led the Tigers to win four games in the ACC, upset No. 13 Duke, be ranked in the top 25 nationally for nine straight weeks, earn an automatic bid to the ACC quarterfinals and finish sixth in the ACC. She coached two players to earn ACC All-Freshmen Team, two players to the South's All-Region Second Team, and one player to Honorable Mention for USA Lacrosse's All-American Team.

That spring, not only did Kwolek have to navigate coaching a brand new team through their first season, but she also had to fight breast cancer. After upsetting No. 13 Duke, Kwolek announced her diagnosis to the public and began treatment. Coach Kwolek would only miss several games before returning to the sidelines.

Before Clemson, Kwolek has served as head coach at the University of Richmond since 2013, which includes a 64-16 (.800) winning percentage, a 27-5 conference record and two conference tournament and two league regular-season championships in the past five seasons. Richmond was nationally ranked in the top-10 each of the last two seasons and has qualified for the NCAA postseason in two of the last three tournaments, which doesn't include the 2020 season in which the Spiders started 7-0 and defeated No. 6 UVA before the season was cut short due to COVID-19. The Spiders have enjoyed their most successful run in their program's history under Kwolek's leadership. When the William and Mary graduate took over the program in 2013, Richmond had accumulated just 10 winning seasons since their inaugural season in 1983. Kwolek racked up seven winning records in her nine seasons as the head coach.

Kwolek's success was not limited to the regular season, although she did garner two A10 regular-season championships over the past five campaigns. The Spiders are 11-5 in postseason play under Kwolek, including a 3-0 run in the 2019 A10 Tournament, culminating in being crowned conference champions for a second-straight year. Kwolek has qualified for seven straight A10 Tournaments and has reached the championship game in six of those appearances. She has coached five Atlantic 10 Players of the Year, along with numerous all-conference selections. Two of her players have been named to the watch list for the Tewaaraton Award, a recognition earned by the best player in NCAA men's and women's lacrosse.

Prior to her time at Richmond, she served as an assistant at the College of William and Mary, Columbia University, and Dartmouth College. Formerly known as Allison Evans, Kwolek was an All-CAA midfielder at William & Mary and defender on the USA Team. She was inducted into the Lacrosse Hall of Fame, Potomac Chapter in February 2015 and named to the William & Mary Athletics Hall of Fame in 2020.

# SEASON OUTLOOK



Coming off of an impressive inaugural season, Clemson will be playing its second season at their lakefront state-of-the-art lacrosse stadium. For the first time in program history, Clemson sold season and single game tickets in addition to offering a unique tailgating experience as an add-on to enhance the gameday experience

“We’re excited for Clemson fans to have the opportunity to see some great lacrosse as we open our world-class facility this spring,” said Head Coach Allison Kwolek. “We look forward to this competitive slate, and building on what we accomplished last year.”

The new facilities, which feature a 1,000-seat stadium and a 9,000-square-foot operations building, make Clemson the only school in the country to have a stadium and facility solely designated to its women’s lacrosse program. Their operations building houses coaches offices, an athletic training room, a locker room, a player lounge, and a hype tunnel. Adjacent to its own facilities is the brand new Athletic Recovery Center which includes space for sports science, nutrition and sports medicine.

In addition to Head Coach Allison Kwolek, Clemson is led by Associate Head Coach Bill Olin and Assistant Coaches Madison Carter and Marina Miller. At the end of fall ball, the team voted in Ella Little, Bella D’Gracia, Shannon Brazier and

Kerri Thornton as this year’s captains.

The team’s roster is made up of eight freshmen, nine sophomores, three juniors, five seniors and nine graduates. 17 players return from the inaugural roster, while eight freshmen and eight transfers join the Tigers for their first season.

In its inaugural season last year, Clemson finished the regular season 12-5 with a 4-5 record against ACC opponents. The season was highlighted by an 11-10 upset over No. 13 Duke and a top 25 national ranking for nine straight weeks. Several returning Tigers earned postseason awards for their impressive seasons, namely Paris Masaracchia (ACC All-Freshman & USA U20 Training Team), Nakeeya McCardell (South’s All-Region Second Team), and Ella Little (USA Lacrosse All-American Honorable Mention). After narrowly missing a bid to the NCAA Tournament last year, the Tigers head into the 2024 season eager to prove themselves worthy to go dancing in May.

Throughout the season, Clemson will play a total of 16 games, including seven non-conference opponents, nine ACC opponents, eight home games and eight away games. Clemson will play several opponents for the first time in school history, including Davidson, Coastal, Mercer, Queens, and ECU. Clemson will open its season at home on

Saturday, February 10 against Davidson at 2:00 p.m. The following week Clemson will travel down the road to Greenville, S.C. where they will play Furman at 6:00 p.m. Then after hosting another non-conference opponent in Coastal on Saturday, February 17 at noon, Clemson will travel to Durham, N.C. to face Duke, their first ACC opponent, on Saturday, February 24 at 1:00 p.m.

Then Clemson will come back home to host UVA on Saturday, March 2 at 1:00 p.m. To break up ACC play, Clemson will go play at Mercer on Tuesday, March 5 at 12:00 p.m before coming back home to play UNC on Saturday, March 9 at 3:00 p.m. After that, Clemson has two back-to-back road games with Wofford on March 11 and then Louisville on March 17.

The Tigers will then return to Clemson for a three-game homestand, starting with Notre Dame on March 22, then Queens College on March 24, and then Virginia Tech on March 30. Up next, Clemson will travel to play ECU on Tuesday, April 2 at 5:00 p.m. Clemson’s slated to close out the regular season with three straight ACC opponents. First, Clemson is set to play at Boston College on Sunday, April 7 at 12:00 p.m., at home against Syracuse for their senior game on Saturday, April 13 at 12:00 p.m. and then finally at Pitt on Thursday, April 18 at 4:00 p.m

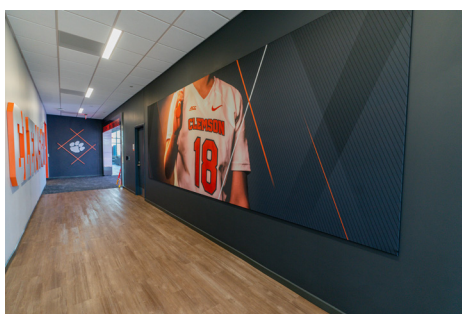
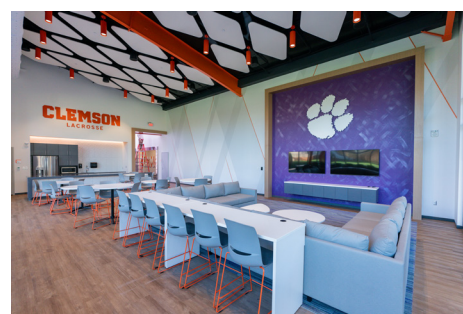
# NEW FACILITY



For the first time in program history, Clemson lacrosse will play in its new state of the art stadium on the banks of Lake Hartwell for the 2024 season.

The stunning new stadium is a part of Clemson's \$37M Women's Athletics Facility Expansion Project that features lakefront facilities for Clemson's lacrosse, gymnastics and rowing teams. Clemson lacrosse's new stadium includes bleacher seating for 2,000 fans, artificial turf, and a 9,000 square foot operations complex, including coaches offices, locker rooms, player lounge and other amenities. These new facilities makes Clemson Lacrosse home to the only school to have a stadium and facility be solely designated to its women's lacrosse program.

In addition to the lacrosse specific facilities, there is a brand new 10,000 square foot training and recovery center for the lacrosse team to share with gymnastics and rowing with designed space for sports science, nutrition, sports medicine, and strength and conditioning.
