### CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 12-1 home record, swept UNC Greensboro at home last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 8.1 runs per game and hitting .315 with a .554 slugging percentage, .424 on-base percentage and 15 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 4.12 ERA, .225 opponents' batting average and 2.17 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .959.

### MANHATTAN OVERVIEW

- Manhattan, which has played all its games on the road and is averaging 4.1 runs per game, is led by second-year Head Coach David Miller.

- The Jaspers lost all four games at Gardner-Webb last weekend. They are hitting .212 and have a 5.66 ERA and .973 fielding percentage.
- Daniel Perez is hitting .311, Trevor Hansen is batting .306 with a team-high eight RBIs and Garret Garbinski has a team-high two saves.

### QUICK HITS

- Manhattan Head Coach David Miller (1993-95) was an All-American at Clemson in 1995 and was a first-round draft pick after that season.
- Clemson has won 11 straight regular-season weekend series dating to 2023, its longest streak since 2001-02.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 9-0 record, three saves, a 4.06 ERA, .200 opponents' batting average and 71 strikeouts in 68.2 innings pitched.

### ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 4,827 fans per home date (13), the 12th-highest figure in the nation and first in the ACC (through games of March 10).
- Entering 2024, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average attendance for 30 straight seasons.

### POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 8 in the nation by NCBWA this week, its fifth weekly ranking in a row in 2024.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks in 2023. It has a current streak of 13 weeks in a row.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

### CAPTAINS

- Billy Barlow, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Jacob Jarrell, Jimmy Obertop, Ty Olenchuk and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains.

## DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

- Wright was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2023.
- Joe Allen, Nolan Nawrocki, Rocco Reid and Will Taylor were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Aidan Knaak, Jarren Purify and Drew Titsworth were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

### GRAND MOMENTS

- Clemson has hit three grand slams in 2024 after hitting six grand slams in 2023.
- The Tiger record for grand slams in a season is eight, set in 2010.
- In the season opener against Xavier on Feb. 16, Clemson hit two grand slams (Alden Mathes, Nolan Nawrocki) to tie the school record.
- It was the third time Clemson hit two grand slams in a game, as it did so on March 3, 1991 (Louisiana) and March 7, 2010 (South Carolina).
- Jarren Purify hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-3 win against Presbyterian on Feb. 20 for his first career hit.

### CANNARELLA CAN

- Sophomore outfielder Cam Cannarella has picked up in 2024 where he left off in 2023, when he was ACC Freshman-of-the-Year.
- He is hitting .411 with five doubles, three homers, 15 RBIs and a .476 on-base percentage in 13 games.
- He has seven multiple-hit games, including five three-hit games.
- He hit safely in each of his first eight games in 2024 and had a 17-game hitting streak dating to 2023.
- He had a 25-game on-base streak dating to 2023.
- He is hitting .500 with runners on base and .462 with two outs.
- In his career, he is hitting .392 with 21 doubles, three triples, 10 homers, 62 RBIs and 84 runs in 72 games.
- In his career, he has a .578 slugging percentage, .465 on-base percentage and 24 steals.
- He has reached base via a hit or walk in 68 of his 72 games in his career.

### DARDEN PITCHING EFFECTIVELY AGAIN

- Sophomore lefthander Ethan Darden emerged as a freshman in 2023 as a dependable weekend starter.
- He has picked up where he left off with consistent outings in 2024.
- He is 2-0 with an 0.87 ERA, a .184 opponents' batting average and 11 strikeouts in 10.1 innings pitched over five relief appearances.
- He has only allowed two walks and no extra-base hits.
- He is holding opponents to .067 with runners on base and .083 with two outs.
- He has 15 groundball outs compared to five flyball outs.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of one-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on Feb. 27.

- In his career, he is 5-2 with a 4.80 ERA, .257 opponents' batting average and 56 strikeouts in 65.2 innings pitched over 24 appearances.

### HUGHES CLOSING

- Sixth-year senior and graduate righthander Rob Hughes has become Clemson's predominant closer in 2024.
- He is 0-0 with one save, an 0.00 ERA, a .150 opponents' batting average and seven strikeouts in 6.2 innings pitched over five appearances.
- He suffered an injury in 2022 that forced him to miss the entire season.
- In his three active seasons at Clemson, he is 1-1 with three saves, a 2.66 ERA and .206 opponents' batting average in 47.1 innings pitched.
- In his two seasons (2023,24) since returning from injury, he is 0-1 with three saves and a 1.13 ERA in 24.0 innings pitched over 17 outings.

### MATHES PUTTING UP NUMBERS

- Senior outfielder Alden Mathes transferred in from Richmond and has made an immediate impact.
- He is hitting .400 with two homers, two doubles, 10 RBIs, 14 runs, a .569 on-base percentage and three steals in 14 games in 2024.
- He has 15 walks and four hit-by-pitches against only six strikeouts.
- He hit a grand slam in his first plate appearance as a Tiger against Xavier on Feb. 16.

### NAWROCKI HITTING HARD

- Redshirt freshman infielder Nolan Nawrocki has patiently waited his turn to enter the lineup and has made the most of his opportunities.
- He is hitting .381 with three homers, a double, 13 RBIs, 12 runs, a .426 on-base percentage and four steals in 11 games in 2024.
- He has hit safely in all 11 of his career games.
- He is hitting .417 with runners on base and .467 with runners in scoring position.
- His solo homer in the sixth inning gave Clemson the lead for good in its 5-4 win over No. 12 South Carolina on March 3.

### SMITH ENTERS WEEKEND ROTATION

- Sophomore lefthander Tristan Smith was a reliever and spot starter as a freshman in 2023, but has emerged as a weekend starter in 2024.
- He is 1-0 with a 2.89 ERA, .180 opponents' batting average and 26 strikeouts against nine walks in 18.2 innings pitched over four starts.
- He allowed only three hits, one run and one walk with nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched against No. 12 South Carolina on March 2.
- In his career, he is 1-1 with a 3.93 ERA, .202 opponents' batting average and 69 strikeouts in 50.1 innings pitched over 28 appearances.
