STATEMENT FROM COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON:

Two things working together made this one of our best games.: we controlled the ball and there was some good blocking in the line. I said after the N. C. State loss that we improved some from the week before and that we would continue to show progress. And that we have done.

I think one main thing that contributed to the win was the ball control in that White and Barbary were able to keep sustained drives going. They stayed on the ground most of the time and only passed when they thought necessary. I think the play selection the two boys employed was above par.

The play of tackles Jim Padgett and Harold Olson and center Bill Thomas on offense as well as defense can't be griped about. All of the boys are working together as a team, but we still got some tough ones ahead.

RICE DRESSING ROOM:

JESS NEELY --- "Clemson has a sound, strong football team. They simply just whipped us. We certainly hoped we would play better. There is just no comparison of tonight with our first three games. We looked tired, and maybe we are, though we haven't worked our crowd too hard in workouts since we've had a pretty rugged schedule. I guess you could say what hurt us most were those three penalties that simply were inexcusable. We're not good enough to give that much away."

(When asked why Owls didn't throw more, principally to utilize Dial more) "Well, we just didn't have the ball long enough to utilize anybody. Clemson's whole crowd impressed me. They are awfully strong."

Team physicians Dr. Hugh Welsh reported no injuries of consequence, although center Ronnie Kramer was limping noticeably when leaving the dressing room. But he should be okay shortly.

Larry Dueitt (halfback) --- "They had a fine team, but that sure was the worst we've ever played. Clemson is strong, but didn't hit as hard as Duke."
