POST-GAME STATEMENTS BY COACHES

"THE FIRST QUESTION ASKED ME AFTER THE FOCTBALL GAME WAS "COACH DODD DON'T YOU THINK AFTER TODAY YOU CAN SAY THAT THIS IS A GOOD FOOTBALL TEAM?" ALL I COULD SAY WAS THAT WE LOOKED VERY GOOD, BUT WHEN I THINK OF TENNESSEE (XM) COMING UP NEXT SATURDAY --- WELL, I GUESS IT'S ALWAYS NEXT WEEK WHEN YOU FIND OUT.

"WE MADE MANY ERRORS TODAY, BUT WE HAD MANY GREAT PLAYS THAT MADE UP FOR MOST OF THE ERRORS. IT IS OBVIOUS THAT WE ARE PLAYING LOTS OF BOYS --PARTICULARILY BACKS -- THAT WE HADN'T COUNTED ON, AND THEY ARE COMING THROUGH FOR US. CLEMSON HAS A FINE FOOTBALL TEAM BUT I AGREE WITH THE STATEMENT THAT I UNDERSTAND THAT COACH HOWARD MADE -- THAT WE JUST HAD TOO MUCH SPEED FOR THEM TODAY.

"YOU KNOW IT IS DIFFNCULT TO PICK OUT INDIVIDUALS FROM THE SIDELINES. THE YOUNG BACKS ALL DID A GOOD JOB, MAXIE BAUGHAN CONTINUES TO SPEARHEAD OUR DEFENSE AND OUT TACKLES SEEM TO IMPROVE EVERY WEEK. WE'VE COME FURTHER THAN I EVER THOUGHT WE COULD HAVE AT THIS STAGE OF THE SEASON."

I THOUGHT WE LOOKED SLUGGISH ALL AFTERNOON, BUT IN SAYING THAT I DON'T MEANTO TAKE ANYTHING AWAY FROM THE FINE TEAM THAT COACH DODD HAS. COMPARING THE FIRST TWO GAMES (NORTH CAROLINA AND VIRGINIA), I THOUGHT THIS WAS OUR WORST GAME OF THE THREE.

SOME OF MY BOYS I DIDN'T SEE ALL WEEK LONG BECAUSE OF A VIRUS, BUT I DIDN'T THINK THAT WOULD WEAKEN US TOO MUCH BECAUSE TWO YEARS AGO WE HAD THE SAME TROUBLE JUST BEFORE WE PLAYED RICE AND WE BEAT THEM.
