STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

It's an altogether different prospective when you win. We played the same kind of pass defense in this game as we have the past two weeks, we were just reacting a little better today. one thing that made our pass defense look a little better was our line rushing the passer. That's about the best pass defense you can have.

howard was asked why he used his third unit so early and he said mainly to give the other two units a rest. STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOUARD OF CLEMSON

It's an altogether different prospective when you win. We played the same kind of pass defense in this game as we have the past two weeks, we were just reacting a little & better today. one thing that made our pass defense look a little better was our line rushing the passer. That's about the best pass defense you can have.

howard was asked why he used his third unit so early and he said mainly to give the other two units a rest. I thought was we might need it in the fourth period. there are some pretty good ball players on that third unit, but we just haven't given them a chance toplay and the only way they'll know what it is all about is to get in there and play.

one thing i regret is that we made all of our mistakes a last week. i just wish we could have played this good against against nugent. i think hickey is one of the nicest people in the coaching business.

this this probably the finest—not the post—beam i've ever had. they work together, play together good and just do what you tell them to do. it's really a pleasure to coach them.

one thing nice about today, i don't have to anything about the pass defense or fumbles. it's better to win than to lose anytime.

COACH HICKEY'S STATEMENT

We simply were beaten by a good football team. I have no alibis and no excuses. We couldn't do anything right, however. Our pass defense was week and we couldn't move the ball.

I didn't think that Clemson would through onus that easily, but that Barnes is a fine receiver. He caught it all over the field. I thought our safety man played the second touchdon pass very poorly. The permitted Barnes to catch it right in fromt of him and score.

We never could getout of our territory so that we could do anything. Then when we did get he apportunity when we were down 14-0 in the third period, the interceptuon hurt. Farris zbz said that someone tipped that ball just as he threw it.

Our biggest problem today was that we couldn't get a pass

But we are a better football team than we piaxedzkodx showed today. We will come back. There is little I can say. We justneed to get down to work.

I thought that we could run better than we did, and also thought we might pass against Clemson which had been having some pass defense trouble of their own. But they played good pass defense today.
