When asked to compare Oklahoma with Tech, Howward said Tech has a lot better passing attack than the Sooners and added "On a wet field, it's lot harder to defend against passes. That receiver knows where he's going and the defender don't. It's the same way on a dry field, but a defender can't recover as good in conditions the like today. But the field didn't have anything to do with it way we played.
