COACHES' POST GAME QUOTES

NUGENT: "That's the best Clemson team I've seen for many years. Potentially, I'd say they had the best talent on its three units of any team in the conference.

At that it was an interesting, good, close game, typical of Mary, and Clemson games of recent years.

I'd say that 95 percent of our players played well, but it was our miscues on the clutch plays that was the deciding factor. Mostly these miscues were on the part of upper-classmen; I'd have to say our sophomores played the best ball--John Kenny at end, George Stem in the backfield and Buddy Humphries.

We'd practiced all week against Clemson's punt formations and yet they continued to draw us offside, especially on fourth down. It was one of the key factors in the result.

Probably the biggest thing that hurt us ~~was~~ Humphries' fumble after he'd caught that pass during the drive when it looked like we might go all the way. Clemson recovered, and we ~~never~~ never did.

If we hadn't made as many mistakes, it could have gone down to the wire in another one of those wild finishes. I really think it was a closer game than the score indicates."

HOWARD: Nugent told Howard at ~~the~~ midfield: "Nice game, but you got a little hungry there at the last."

Howard didn't think his Tigers looked too sharp, "but you can't look sharp every Saturday. We didn't look good all week in practice."

"I kinda wished they hadn't got that touchdown. If it hadn't been for that, our pass defense would have been perfect."

Someone asked about the number of passes Darryl Hill caught, and ~~he~~ Howard was told 10. "I don't care if he caught 25, they still didn't score ~~me~~ with their offense, and I'd say that was pretty good defense on our part. But the only thing that pleases me is that 21-6 score."

"Maryland has a good passing attack, <sup>AUD</sup> ~~but~~ we couldn't afford to rush the passer too much because they have some good screens and flat passes and we would have been trouble rushing Shiner all the time. We did though on occasion."

"I think this team this year has played harder under more adverse conditions than any team I've ever had. You don't have any idea what we've been ~~is~~ through. But the boys have never given up."

Howard figured since the Tigers won today, "it won't be too hard to get ~~is~~ 'em ready for South Carolina." Informed that South Carolina had lost to Wake Forest, Howard said "I don't care how that game came out. We're just going to get ready for those Gamecocks next week."

## COACHES' POST GAME QUOTES

NUGENT--"That's the best Clemson team I've seen for many years. Potentially, I'd say they had the best talent on its three units of any team in the conference.

At that it was an interesting, good, close game, typical of Mary, and Clemson games of recent years.

I'd say that 95 percent of our players played well, but it was our miscues on the clutch plays that was the deciding factor. Mostly these miscues were on the part of upper-classmen; I'd have to say our sophomores played the best ball--John Kenny at end, George Stem in the backfield and Buddy Humphries.

We'd practiced all week against Clemson's punt formations and yet they continued to draw us offside, especially on fourth down. It was one of the key factors in the result.

Probably the biggest thing that hurt us ~~was~~ Humphries' fumble after he'd caught that pass during the drive when it looked like we might go all the way. Clemson recovered, and we ~~never~~ never did.

If we hadn't made as many mistakes, it could have gone down to the wire in another one of those wild finishes. I really think it was a closer game than the score indicates."

HOWARD: Nugent told Howard at ~~the~~ midfield: "Nice game, but you got a little hungry there at the last."

Howard didn't think his Tigers looked too sharp, "but you can't look sharp every Saturday. We didn't look good all week in practice."

"I kinda wished they hadn't got that touchdown, If it hadn't been for that, our pass defense would have been perfect."

Someone asked about the number of passes Darryl Hill caught, and ~~he~~ Howard was told 10. "I don't care if he caught 25, they still didn't score ~~me~~ with their offense, and I'd say that was pretty good defense on our part. But the only thing that pleases me is that 21-6 score."

"Maryland has a good passing attack, ~~but~~ <sup>AND</sup> we couldn't afford to rush the passer too much because they have some good screens and flat passes and we would have been trouble rushing Shiner all the time. We did though on occasion."

"I think this team this year has played harder under more adverse conditions than any team I've ever had. You don't have any idea what we've been ~~through~~ through. But the boys have never given up."

Howard figured since the Tigers won today, "it won't be too hard to get ~~them~~ 'em ready for South Carolina." Informed that South Carolina had lost to Wake Forest, Howard said "I don't care how that game came out. We're just going to get ready for those Gamecocks next week."
