

THE GAME: TCU and Clemson are meeting for the second time in history today. In the 1959 Bluebonnet Bowl game Clemson took the first game, 23-7. Today's action is pick 'em. TCU has a 1-4 record while Clemson is 2-3 for the year.

WEATHER: Indian Summer with temperature at 75 and the wind out of the Southeast at 8 mph. Expected to be clear all afternoon.

THE TOSS: Clemson wins it, will take South goal and kickoff. TCU elected to receive.

Statement by Coach Frank Howard of Clemson

Coaches Frank Howard of Clemson and Abe Martin of TCU had quite a lengthy conversation at midfield following the game.

Howard told Martin, "I won the first half and you won the second. That namesake of mine (quarterback Randy Howard) was the one that beat me. We had done a pretty good job containing you until he went in there.

"The play that broke our back was that halfback pass play. And you know, we worked on that thing all week."

Martin said the Clemson line was giving his tackles the devil. "They really hit us hard in the first part of the game."

"It's never a pleasure to beat my friends," Martin said, "but I believe I needed the win worse than you ~~did~~ did," Martin told Howard.

"I don't know about that", Howard said, "my butter's been spread pretty thin so far."

Howard also praised the running of Fauver. "He's a real fine runner."

Martin said "We were lucky to break those two long ones loose on you because we weren't doing much good anywhere else."

Howard and Martin parted with an agreement "that we'll play for the championship next year."

Clemson defeated TCU in the 1959 Bluebonnet Bowl game and TCU's win today made the teams 1-all. TCU will return the game next year at Clemson.

The Clemson dressing was extra quiet. About the only word being spoken was <sup>s</sup> by Dr. Robert C. Edwards, president of Clemson, who was going around shaking the hand of each player whether he had been in the game or not.

Howard said he thought his Tigers played a good game, "but you can't bust your brains out stopping <sup>v</sup> team for the short yardage and then letting them get the 'bomb' on you."

"I'm pretty well satisfied with out ~~your~~ performance, but when you don't win--regardless of how good you look--it kinda puts a sour taste in your mouth."

TCU DRESSING ROOM--

ABE MARTIN--"Of course, I would have to start and say that Fauver had a great day...he made the big plays for us...he's got to be one of the top halfbacks in our League...But Randy (Howard) came in and sparked us...he gave us that change of pace...He played a big role in us winning, I'll tell you that...They (Clemson) had Kent (Nix) and Sonny (Campbell) figured pretty well...Randy came in and started making yards with just our regular staff...the play-pass patterns worked real well....Clemson has a good football team...this was a real good game...Clemson hurt us early with ~~the~~ dive plays...we stopped them at first, then that fumble really hurt on the next play....it's sure good to put two victories back-to-back."

JIM FAUVER--"Boy, did I have good ~~the~~ blocking today...We just made up our minds at half to go out there and play better football... (on TD pass to Batton)--"I could see him wide open early..knew their backs were playing close..all I had to do was throw the ball..yes, that was the first TD pass in my life...I never threw any at all until this year...(on TD run of 70 yards)--~~I~~ I had the blocking...the hole was there...I hit in there quick, and thought I might have a chance to go all ~~way~~ the way...again, I can't say enough for the blocking."

RANDY HOWARD--"Coach Martin showed us at halftime what we needed to do, and we went out there and did it....we just hooked up and got after them...(on TD pass call, Fauver to Batton)--in past, we have used the power sweep to get the 5-yards...thought they might fall for it... you know I'm known as the "running" quarterback....our line did a good job of blocking in second half...That made a lot of difference."
