JIM HICKEY QUOTE:

"It was one of the best games we've played in a long while. Of course, I said early in the year we wanted this one more than any MME on the schedule. We had a long seige of disappointments against Clemson. The boys were "up," obviously, about as much as they were "down" against Georgia.

"Gary Black called a good game for us and was moving the team. That's why he was in there most of the way. I saw no reason to experiment when we were dominating the game. We were alert. We gobbled up those fumbles and two of them led to touchdown that really set us off. That's the big thing in winning football: you must capitalize on every opportunity. In other games, we've had the scoring chance but didn't get the most out of it.

"Our defense was tremendous. Zarro played one of his best games at linebacker and so did Chris Hanburger. Incidentally, I falt the Clemson linebackers were awfully good boys.

"Our plan of atgack was just to play the kind of ball I know we are capable of playing. I think mental alertness did much for us, plus our defense giving us the ball time after time. We kept Clemson pretty much backed up.

"I know we were due from Frank. It was a bi, big win for us. Now we must forget Clemson and get ready for Virginia. I wish the Tigers the very best--and I know they can play well. They moved the ball. They just couldn't score."

STATEMENT BY COACH FRANK HOWARD OF CLEMSON

They just beat the devil out of us. I think we had a lot of false anthusiasm---the spirit was willing, but the bodies weren⁹t

Today wasn't out day. Our line just stood back. We didn't block, we didn't tackle, we didn't execute things right.

North Carolina played aggressive. They are a little hard to defense. But we didn't do a thing wrong in preparing for them. And I'd do it the same thing if we played again next week. We looked today kinda like they said North Carolina looked against Georgia last week.

We never did stop that Willard. He's a great football player. (Howard went into the UNC dressing room afterwards and kissed Willard good bys).

We had played pretty hard against Wake, TCU and Virginia, and I guess it's kinda hard to get 'em up every week. We looked weary.

Those two fumbles hurt mp us. I think his (Hickey's) two platoon probably has helped him. But we don't have the personnel to do it, or I might be using some of it. In fact, we don't have as much ability as a lot of people think. But you never can tell, we might come back next week and look great.
