POST GAME QUOTES FROM EARLE EDWARDS:

"Clemson played well, but I thought we had a chance at the half. But we gave the ball up too many times at mid-field. We moved the ball in the third quarter, but just as we were establishing a beach-head, we gave the ball away.

"Mauldin rushed hard, their kicking was good and their fullbacks did a good job. We gave some ground on the kicking, particularly the punts.

"I thought we might kick a little better. A great many sophs played well. We knew where our problems might be, but I thought some of the new boys played hard and did well.

"I think we are going to get better. As to the results, you'll just have to wait and see the relative strengths of the teams later in the season.

"The temperature effected both sides,

"We are going to stick to platooning. We are short of some people, but we knew it. Nothing can be done about that.

"Maybe I'm overlooking some of their boys, but they all ~~just~~ played well.

"We'll get better, I'm sure of that."

POST GAME QUOTES FROM FRANK HOWARD:

"I think numbers won the game for us. I decided at halftime to give the first unit offense one more chance. After they didn't move I put the second units in."

"After watching them, I plan to use four teams every game. There ain't a lot of difference in them four teams anyway.

Why did you keep shuffling players?

"Mauldin ain't in shape (only 11 days of live practice) and we did it mostly to give him a blow w. I'm hopin' we can have Gore back by the Tech game. He's got that speed ~~that~~ that we don't have back there now. All the yardage we got was thru hard running, not speed.

Did you want to pass more than you did?

"I can't exactly say that. ~~Mr~~ Gentlemen, whether you realize it or not, passing got us down to that goal line everytime."

"We were calling some of the plays, and Charlie (waller, offensive coach) call the play that ray scored the last td on. Ruffner caught some key passes because he wasn't covered by State. He was the ~~third~~ ^{third} man out of our backfield and they didn't have a man on him."

"Another ~~mr~~ reason I played them second unit boys ~~was~~ was to kinda baptize them. You see, there's twenty of them that ain't never been in a ball game on that unit.

"I was disappointed in my defense. I mean my first unit defense; before

"I am proud of the way the second defense played. They just went out there and hit State hard.

"I think there wasn't any masterminding on my part; it just boiled down to the fact that we had better players and just hit them a little harder, 'specially when they ~~was~~ was getting tired in that third quarter."
