MARVIN BASS, SOUTH CAROLINA: "It went right down to the wire, didn't it. I thought both teams played well and this has to be the greatest victory of my life. This is our first share of a conference football championship and it sure feels great. I hope this gives us impetus for next year because we have some great young football players on this squad. If they believe in themselves, they can go a long way. There were many plays that could be called crucial, or turning points, but if I had to pick out a turning point I would say the 50 yard pass from Fair to Wilburn — a great pass by a great sophomore and a great catch by a great senior.
