SHORT HOPS

- Longwood continues a busy week heading to No. 10/11 Clemson for the Tiger Invitational for five games Friday-Sunday.
- The Lancers dropped their home opener to Virginia Tuesday, 4-1, giving up three home runs, including two in the first five pitches. Longwood cut the deficit to 3-1 in the fifth, manufacturing a run on a **Lauren Taylor** RBI groundout.
- Catcher Maggie Hiatt earned Big South Freshman of the Week Monday after hitting .600 (6-for-10) with a home run, two doubles, seven RBIs with a 1.100 slugging percentage, helping LU to a 3-1 week with two wins over Brown and one against Stetson at the Tennessee Classic. It was the second consecutive week the Lancers earned a Big South weekly honor following Sophia Knock's Player of the Week nod Feb. 27.
- Sophia Knock hit two more home runs in Knoxville last week in sweeping Brown and Stetson Saturday and ranks 22nd in the country in home runs per game (0.39) and 15th total homers with seven. As a team, is second in the Big South league at 0.67 per game.

BY THE NUMBERS



Longwood finished 60th overall in the NCAA's final 2023 RPI standings, ahead of two of this weekend's opponents - Mercer (209th) and Fordham (227th).

The Lancers were slated to play eight teams that advanced to the 2023 tournament, including Women's College World Series teams, Alabama and Tennessee.

LU earned a pair of victories in 2023 against teams in the top 10 of the national polls, winning at No. 4 Florida State on Feb. 11, 5-4, and versus No. 8 Duke April 26, 4-3.

A league-high five Lancers were named to the 2024 preseason All-Big South Team -Korynna Anderson, Er'ron Burton, Lauren Fox, Maryanna Guy and Lauren Taylor.

Longwood has played to a 486-315 (.607) record since becoming Division I eligible for the 2007 season. The Lancers are in their 18th season in Division in 2024.

GAME NOTES

LANCERS TIED ATOP BIG SOUTH PRESEASON POLL

Longwood was picked in a tie for the top spot the 2024 Big South Conference Preseason Poll, released Jan. 24. The Lancers received four first-place votes and 45 points in the poll to tie with USC Upstate.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Last season, Longwood played the 55th most difficult schedule in the nation. In 2024, the Lancers scheduled at least 10 games against eight teams that advanced to the 2023 NCAA tournament, including two Women's College World Series participants. The Lancers scheduled Alabama and Auburn two times each and single games against Charlotte, Clemson, Duke, Liberty Minnesota and Tennessee.

BIG SOUTH DOMINANCE

Since joining the Big South Conference in 2013, Longwood has emerged as the league's premier team. Under former head coach Kathy Riley, who retired after the 2020 season, the Lancers won five of seven Big South titles, doing so in 2013, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2019.

Longwood's five Big South championships are the third most in league history and the most by any team in a seven-year span. Only Coastal Carolina (1992-2012) and Winthrop (1987-Present) have won more, with six titles apiece.

The Lancers have won the last two consecutive Big South regular-season titles under fourth-vear head coach Dr. Megan Brown.

LONGWOOD IN NCAA REGIONALS

Longwood has advanced to five NCAA Division I regionals and reached the regional final in 2016 and 2017. The Lancers played in the NCAA postseason in 2013, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2019, tying former member Coastal Carolina for the most regional appearances in Big South history.

Longwood is 5-10 overall in NCAA Division I regional play, securing the most NCAA postseason wins by any Big South softball team. The Lancers played to a 2-4 in a pair of NCAA Division II regionals in 2002 and 2003.

KNOCK, KNOCK, KNOCK

Against Northern Iowa Feb. 23, infielder Sophia Knock become the fourth Longwood player in history with a three-homer game and first since Emily Murphy did it in an 8-6 Big South tournament victory over Campbell on May 11, 2013. Knock also joined Stanford's Aly Kaneshiro and Kassidy Moore of Mercer, as one of the only three players to hit three home runs in a game this season. She leads the Big South in home runs per game (0.44) and home runs (seven), ranking eighth and 14th, respectively, in the NCAA.

CHAPIN STRONG IN THE CIRCLE AT EAST CAROLINA

Right-hander Maggie Chapin posted consecutive complete-game wins versus Fairfield and in defeating East Carolina, 5-2, in game one on Feb 18. Chapin handed the 11-1 Pirates their first loss, allowing six hits, one walk and one earned run with a career-high nine strikeouts. She finished the weekend 2-1 with a 1.62 ERA in 17 1/3 innings pitched.

CHAPIN CONTINUES STRONG START AT TENNESSEE

Maggie Chapin went 3-0 with a 2.19 ERA in 16 innings at the Tennessee Classic last week. She posted her second complete-game shutout, 4-0, over Brown Saturday, scattering three hits and two walks while striking out four. Chapin also beat Stetson, 9-6, in 5 1/3 innings Saturday and vultured a win out of the bullpen against Brown Sunday, tossing 3 2/3 scoreless innings to win 6-4 in eight innings.

KEEPIN' IT 100

Fourth-year head coach Dr. Megan Brown is just two wins away from 100 career coaching wins, coming into play this weekend at 98-85 (.536) overall.

EVERYDAY TAYLOR

Graduate shortstop Lauren Taylor has played in 202 career games for the Lancers, a figure that ranks 49th in NCAA Division I among active players.

VINSON WINS NFCA RAWLINGS GOLD GLOVE AWARD

Junior outfielder Emily Vinson played errorless ball in 68 chances in left field last year to earn an NFCA Rawlings Gold Glove Award. Vinson, who had seven outfield assists, became the first mid-major player to earn the recognition in the award's second year of existence.

The program high marks in Brown's third season, including wins over No. 4 Florida State and No. 8 Duke, a second consecutive 30-win season, and another Big South regular-season title. In addition, the Lancers finished the season ranked 60th in the NCAA RPI, the highest ranking in school history.

Several players earned high-level recognition after the 2023 season, including Big South Player of the Year and NFCA First Team All-Region for Jaden Pone and NFCA Rawlings Gold Glove for Emily Vinson.

In her second year at the helm, she guided LU to a share of the Big South regular-season title while also making a run to the Big South title game, finishing as runner up.

Six earned 2022 All-Big South honors, with Sydney Backstrom winning her second straight Big South Pitcher of the Year award, both coming under Brown. Backstrom broke the program's single-game, single-season and career strikeout record in 2022, and has her name throughout the Longwood record book, ranking second in career wins while in the top five in a host of other categories.

In addition, Pone was named the Big South Freshman of the Year after leading the team with a .416 batting average. Pone led the charge for an offense that racked up 416 hits, more than 100 more than the year prior.

The Lancers went 34-24 against the toughest schedule in the conference, facing 14 opponents inside the top 75 of the final RPI.

In Brown's first season at the helm, Backstrom was named the Big South Pitcher of the Year while shouldering a heavy load, and the Lancers finished 26-28 against a schedule that was the toughest in the Big South. The team played seven opponents that were part of the top 75 in the final RPI.

Brown came to Longwood with a coaching resume that includes time in the ACC, Pac-12 and SEC, along with extensive playing credentials that include a record-setting All-American career at Florida Southern and six years on the professional softball circuit at home and abroad.

During that time, she has coached under and played for some of the most decorated head coaches in college softball, including National Fastpitch Coaches Association Hall-of-Famers Diane Ninemire at Cal and Karen Mullens at UConn, SEC Coach of the Year Tina Deese at Auburn, and 1,200-game winner and NFCA Hall-of-Famer Chris Bellotto at Florida Southern.

Brown served as an assistant coach at Pac-12 member Cal (2020) and ACC member Boston College (2016-19), with stints at Akron (2015), UConn (2014), UNC Pembroke (2012-13) and Auburn (2010-11). She has coached at the highest level of international softball, serving as pitching coach and guest player for the Great Britain women's national team from 2011-14.

Brown has worked under some of the best to ever coach at the collegiate level, including under Ninemire at Cal in 2020. With the Golden Bears, Brown worked with Ninemire in the coaching legend's 33rd and final season, helping her cap a career that saw her finish ninth in Division I wins. Prior to Cal in 2020, she was the top assistant at Boston College from

2016-19 and transformed the pitching staff into one of the best in the ACC. Under her tutelage, BC ranked second in the conference in ERA in 2017 behind only top-10 power Florida State. ranked among the league's top four in opponent batting average and strikeouts three consecutive years from 2016-18, and led the league in strikeouts looking in both 2016 and 2017. Leading

that charge were Brown's pupils Jessica Dreswick and Allyson Frei, two NFCA All-Region pitchers whose names littered the school's record books. Among a wealth of school records, Dreswick set the program's single-season wins record and threw BC's first no-hitter of the ACC era under Brown.

That dominance in the circle propelled BC to the upper tier of the ACC, finishing in the top four of the league three consecutive years from 2016-18. The Eagles reached 30 wins and double-digit ACC victories in each of those seasons, leading to the program's winningest three-year run of its ACC era.

That five-year stretch at Cal and Boston College followed two years that Brown held assistant coach positions at MAC member Akron in 2015 and The American's UConn in 2014. At Akron, she oversaw the development of one of the best pitchers in program history in Erin Seiler. Seiler set Akron's single-season strikeout record with 305 that year, her highest total in a four-year career that ended with her atop the program leaderboards in career wins, complete games and strikeouts. Meanwhile at UConn, Brown learned under NFCA Hall of Fame inductee and 862-game winner Karen Mullins in the last of her 31 seasons leading the Huskies program.

Prior to her return to the Division I level at UConn, Brown cut her teeth in the college coaching ranks at Division II UNC Pembroke in 2012-13 and at SEC power Auburn in 2010 and 2011. At Auburn, she worked toward her doctorate degree while serving the Tiger program as a student manager in 2010 and a volunteer assistant coach in 2011, helping the program reach two of its nine NCAA tournaments under Tina Deese.

She was a three-time All-American for a Florida Southern team that finished Nos. 2, 3 and 4 in the NCAA Division II College World Series from 2004-07, with a four-year record of 200-42. Brown won a school-record 124 games with a career ERA of 0.69, two of the 11 school records she still holds. Also among those are 58 career shutouts and 12 no-hitters. which rank among the NCAA Division II top 10 along with her 124 wins and 58 shutouts.
