### CLEMSON BASKETBALL HEADLINES

#### CLEMSON vs. BAYLOR

• This will be just the fourth meeting between Clemson and Baylor, the first since the 1983-84 season. Baylor has a 2-1 lead in the series. Clemson won the most recent meeting at Clemson on December 19, 1983 by a 102-52 score. It was the seventh consecutive victory to open the 1983-84 season for Bill Foster's last Clemson team. Clemson shot 40-for-60 from the field in the game and the 66.7 percent shooting night is tied for the ninth-best in Clemson history.

• The other two meetings between the two teams took place in consecutive seasons in the 1960s at regular season tournaments. Baylor won both of those games. The Bears won on December 30, 1963 at the Sun Bowl Carnival in El Paso, Texas by a 73-71 score, then won on December 29, 1964 at the Poinsettia Classic in Greenville, S.C. by a 68-59 score.

#### CLEMSON BASKETBALL NOTES

• Clemson defeated New Mexico in the first round of the NCAA Tournament by a score of 77-56 on Friday, March 22. It marked the second-largest margin of victory for a Clemson team in the NCAA Tournament. (Record is 31 vs. Auburn, 84-53, on 3/18/18).

• The Tigers moved to 12-13 all-time in the NCAA Tournament with the victory over the Lobos. This tournament was the sixth in which the Tigers have recorded a victory.

• Clemson limited New Mexico to just 29.7 percent shooting - the second lowest for a Clemson team in tournament history (Record is 25.8 percent vs. Auburn on 3/18/18).

• The 29.7 percent shooting for New Mexico was their lowest of the 2023-24 season - by a considerable margin. Their previous low was 35.4 percent in a three point loss to UNLV on Feb. 10.

• Clemson held New Mexico to 13 percent three point shooting on Friday, the best three point defense in Clemson history in an NCAA Tournament game. New Mexico was just 3-23 from distance in that game.

• Clemson won points off turnovers in that game by a 19-6 margin. New Mexico came into the game with an average points off turnovers margin of 18-11. The six points off turnovers for Clemson rank as tied for the fewest against New Mexico this year.

• Clemson held New Mexico to 56 points, the Lobos fewest points in a game all year. The previous low was 58 in a game against Boise State.

• Clemson held Jamal Mashburn, Jr. (10th) and Jaalen House (11th), two of the top 11 scorers in New Mexico history, to a combined 18 points in 5-25 shooting from the field and 2-14 on three-point shooting.

• Chase Hunter netted his second 20-point game of the year with a game-high 21 points on 8-of-16 shooting from the floor. Ian Schieffelin totaled his 10th double-double of the season with 16 points and 12 rebounds. PJ Hall (14) was the Tigers third scorer in double figures.

• With his 10th double-double, Schieffelin is just the second Clemson player to record double figures in double-doubles in a season since 2008-09. Hunter Tyson did it last year with 16, but that is the only other player to do it since Trevor Booker had 13 double-doubles in 2008-09.

• Schieffelin also now has 16 double-digit rebounding games this season and 18 for his career.

• With 14 points in the game, PJ Hall moved into ninth on Clemson's all-time scoring list. He passed Dale Davis and now sits ninth with 1,670 career points.

• Joseph Girard III saw his Clemson record free throw streak come to an end after he made 67 consecutive free throws from Jan. 13 to March 22. That broke the previous ACC mark of 66 in a row by Scott Wood of NC State during the 2011-12 season. Girard made the first of that one-and-one situation, then missed the second to end his streak at 67, one ahead of Wood's record.

• Girard made two more 3-pointers against the Lobos and is now just one away from tying and two away from breaking Terrell McIntyre's single season record of threes made (99). Girard now has 98 this season. For his career he has made 395 - the third most in ACC history.

• The Tigers recorded their 10th win away from home this season which is tied for the second-most in program history. Clemson is 4-1 on neutral floors and 6-6 in true road games. It's the ninth time in school history Clemson has recorded 10 wins away from home.

• With the win over New Mexico, Brad Brownell set the Clemson record for NCAA Tournament victories in a career. It was his fourth NCAA Tournament win. He had one in 2010-11, his first year, when the Tigers defeated UAB, 70-52 in a First Round game in Dayton. He then took the Tigers to the Sweet 16 in 2018 with wins over New Mexico State and Auburn.

• Friday was Clemson's 12th all-time NCAA Tournament victory. Bill Foster had three in his only year in the tournament, a run to the Elite Eight in 1980, Cliff Ellis had three, one in 1989 and two in 1990 when he took the Tigers to the Sweet 16. Rick Barnes had two, both in 1997 when he took Clemson to the Sweet 16. Clemson is now 12-13 in the NCAA Tournament entering Sunday's game with Baylor.

# NOTES

## **A Win over Baylor would....**

- Give Clemson just its fifth appearance in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. Clemson reached the Elite 8 in 1980, the Sweet 16 in 1990, 1997 and 2018. Brad Brownell would be the first coach to lead Clemson to a pair of Sweet 16's.
- Give Clemson a 2-0 record against the Big 12 this year. On December 9, in Toronto, Clemson defeated TCU, 74-66.
- Give Clemson 23 wins for the second straight season. It would be just the 11th season of at least 23 wins in school history. It would give Brad Brownell four of the 11 seasons with at least 23 wins.
- Would give Clemson 11 wins away from home for just the second time in school history.
- Would give Clemson a seventh win over a non-conference NCAA Tournament team, five in the regular season and two this week in the NCAA Tournament.
- Would give Clemson at least 23 wins in back to back seasons for the first time since Clemson did it three years in a row under Oliver Purnell (2006-07, 25-11), (2007-08, 24-10) and (2008-09, 23-9).

## **Clemson Has 45 Wins over Last Two Years**

- Clemson had a 23-11 record last year and stands at 22-11 so far this year. That is a 45-22 record over the last two years. The 45 wins ties for the most in consecutive years in the Brad Brownell era, as Clemson also had 45 wins over consecutive years, 2017-18 and 2018-19. Prior to that year you have to go back to 2007-08 and 2008-09 when Clemson had 47 wins in a two year period. The record is 49 in back to back years, 2006-07 and 2008-08.
- Clemson has already set the school mark for ACC wins over consecutive seasons. Clemson was 14-6 in the ACC last year and 11-9 this year, giving the Tigers a 25-15 mark in the league over the last two years. The previous record for ACC wins over consecutive years was 19.

## **Clemson Has 10 Wins Away from Home**

- Clemson won its 10th game away from home when it defeated New Mexico 77-56 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament at Memphis, Tennessee. Clemson is 6-6 on the opponent's home court and 4-1 at neutral sites this year.
- A win over Baylor on Sunday would give Clemson a record tying 11 wins away from home in one season. That was done in 1996-97 when Rick Barnes Tigers had an 11-7 record away from home.

## **Great Comeback by Chase Hunter**

- Chase Hunter had a frustrating game in the ACC Tournament against Boston College as he was 0-10 from the field and scored just two points. But the senior was bound and determined to have an impact in this NCAA Tournament and he responded with 21 points on 8-for-16 field goal shooting and added six assists to lead Clemson in both categories.
- It was the eighth time in his career he has scored at least 20 points in a game, the second time this year. It was his most points in a game since the 2022-23 season when he scored a career high 26 at Florida State. Friday marked the third time in his career he had at least 20 points and six assists in the same game.

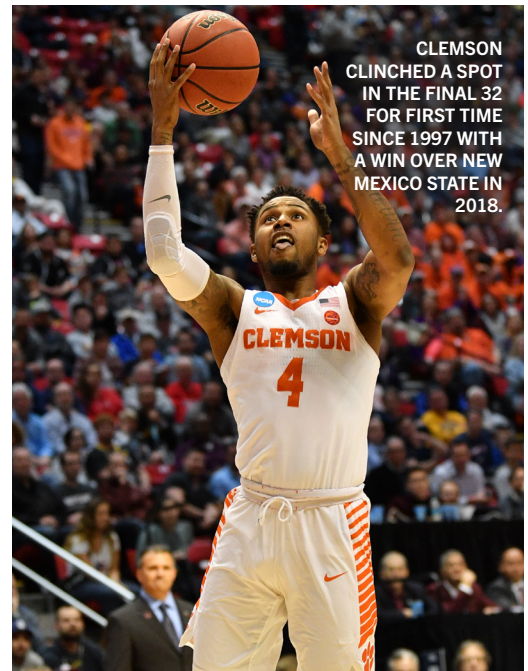
