CLEMSON BASKETBALL HEADLINES

CLEMSON vs. ALABAMA

- This will be the second meeting between Clemson and Alabama this season. The Tigers defeated the Crimson Tide by an 85-77 score in Tuscaloosa on Tuesday, November 28 in front of 10,725 fans at Coleman Coliseum.
- This will mark the first time Clemson has faced a team in the NCAA Tournament that it had played earlier in the season.
- Clemson holds an 8-4 lead in the series with Alabama that dates to the 1929-30 season when Alabama beat the Tigers 33-22 in the Southern Conference Tournament in Atlanta. That Alabama win ended Clemson's season with a 16-9 record. Clemson had won six of its last seven entering that game.
- Alabama won the first two games of the series, but Clemson has won eight of the last 10, including three in a row. All three of Clemson's wins in the recent streak have been away from home, two at Alabama, and one in Atlanta. This will be the fifth meeting between the two schools since the 2015-16 season.
- Clemson defeated Alabama in a neutral site game in Atlanta during December of 2020 by a 64-56 in the most recent contest prior to this year.
- Alabama's last win over Clemson took place at Clemson in 2015-16 by a 51-50 score. The game was played at Bon Secours Arena in Greenville, S.C. as Clemson's Littlejohn Coliseum was being renovated. Shannon Hale made a steal and dunk with 25 seconds left that gave Alabama the 51-50 lead and that turned out to be the final score.
- Alabama's last win against Clemson away from Clemson's home court took place in Puerto Rico during the 1989-90 season, a 57-48 Crimson Tide victory over a Clemson team led by Dale Davis and Elden Campbell that would win the school's only regular season ACC title.
- Clemson defeated Alabama in Tuscaloosa earlier this year, a victory that gave Clemson a 6-0 record to start the season. PJ Hall led Clemson with 21 points and eight rebounds in just 21 minutes. He also blocked fourth shots and hit 3-5 three-point shots.
- Joseph Girard added 16 points and four assists and he made 4-7 three-point shots in 33 minutes. Chase Hunter had 15 points and made 3-5 three-point shots in 29 minutes. Ian Scheffelin had nine points, but had a game high 14 rebounds in 30 minutes. R.J. Godfrey made 5-6 shots off the bench and scored 11 and added three rebounds in 14 minutes.
- Clemson shot 32-60 from the field for 53.3 percent, including 11-21 on three point shots. The rebounding was tied at 41 apiece. Clemson won points in the paint 32-22, but Alabama won fast break points 7-0.
- Alabama was led by Mark Spears with 23 points, while Aaron Estada added 16 and Grant Nelson had 14. Clemson had a 33-32 lead at intermission, but then won the second half 52-45. Alabama led by seven points with 13 minutes remaining, but Clemson outscored the Crimson Tide by 15 points over the last 13 minutes.

CLEMSON BASKETBALL NOTES

Clemson's First Elite 8 Berth in 44 Years

Clemson's win over Arizona advanced the Tigers to the Elite 8 of the NCAA Tournament for just the second time in history, the first time since 1980. According to research by CBS Sports the 44 years in between Elite 8 appearances is the fourth longest in the history of the tournament. The longest is a 54-year stretch by Loyola (Chicago).

Clemson's 1980 Team

- You can certainly say this 2023-24 Clemson team is the best in terms of NCAA Tournament performance since the 1979-80 team under Bill Foster reached the Elite Eight. It was the first Clemson team chosen for the NCAA Tournament. That 1979-80 Clemson team finished the year with a 23-9 record, 8-6 in the ACC and had six wins over top 25 teams. The six wins over ranked teams is still a season record. Clemson was ranked as high as No. 10 in the nation at one point and recorded the school's first win over the No. 1 team in the nation, defeating top ranked Duke on Jan. 9, 1980 by an 87-82 score in overtime.
- Like this year's Tigers team, Clemson was a No. 6 seed in the NCAA Tournament and reached the Elite Eight with wins over Utah State, BYU (and guard Danny Ainge) and Lamar. That Clemson team was 8-6 in the ACC, 7-0 at home and 1-6 on the road.
- Clemson reached the West Regional Finals at the University of Arizona, where it lost to UCLA by an 85-74 score.
- The top player on that Clemson team of 44 years ago was Billy Williams, who made first-team All-ACC and was an honorable mention All-American according to the Associated Press. He had nine 20-point guards against conference foes the year and had a 17.6 scoring average overall.
- The most famous player on that team was junior forward Larry Nance, who went on to stardom for many years in the NBA. He was the first NBA Slam Dunk Championship in 1984. His jersey has been retired by the Cleveland Cavaliers. Nance was named to the All-West Regional team that year.

Clemson Sets Record for Wins Away from Home

- Clemson's win over Arizona gave the Tigers a 12th victory away from home this year. Clemson's 24 wins are evenly split, 12 wins at Littlejohn Coliseum and 12 wins away from home, six on the opponent's home court and six at neutral sites.
- The 12th win away from home against Arizona set a school record for wins away from home in a season. The Tigers of 1996-97 that went to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament had 11 wins away from home.
- Clemson's wins away from home have been against quality competition. Seven of the 12 wins away from home have been against NCAA Tournament teams UAB, Alabama, TCU, North Carolina, New Mexico, Baylor and Arizona.

Clemson vs. Ranked Teams

- Clemson defeated second seed (West Regional) and No. 9 ranked (AP) Arizona in the third round of the NCAA tournament on Friday. It was the fourth win over an AP Top 25 team for the Tigers this year. All four have been away from home. Clemson defeated No. 23 Alabama in November, won at No. 3 North Carolina in February, and now has beaten No. 14 Baylor and No. 9 Arizona in the NCAA Tournament. Clemson can gain a fifth win over a top 25 team if it defeats No. 19 ranked Alabama in the Elite 8 on Saturday.
- Clemson set a school record for ranked wins away from home with the win over Arizona. The 1996-97 Clemson team under Rick Barnes had three top 25 wins away from home.
- The Clemson record for wins over top 25 teams in a season is six, set by the 1979-80 Clemson team that had a 6-4 mark against ranked teams that year.

Holding Teams Under 40 Percent an Indicator

- One of the most telling indicators of victory this year for Clemson has been field goal percentage defense. The Tigers are 17-0 this season when holding the opposition under 40 percent field goal percentage. That includes a 3-0 mark in the NCAA Tournament.
- New Mexico shot 19-64 for a .297 percentage against the Tigers in the opening game of this year's tournament, including 3-23 (.130) on three-point shots. Baylor, who entered the tournament shooting .398 on three-point shots, was just 6-24 on three point shots and 21-54 overall (.389). Arizona made just 25-67 from the field (.373) overall and just 5-28 on three point shots (.179).
- For the three games in the tournament, opponents are 65-185 from the field (.351) and 14-75 from three point land (.186).

Clemson Goes for 25th Victory

- Clemson can tie the school record for wins in a season with a victory over Alabama on Saturday. Clemson enters the contest with a 24-11 mark and the school record is 25 wins by the 1986-87 team (25-6) led by Horace Grant, a 25-10 mark in 2017-18, the last Clemson team to reach the Sweet 16 before this year, and the 2006-07 team that had a 25-11 mark and reached the finals of the NIT.

Clemson Athletic Program Having Strong Year

- Clemson has had a strong athletic year in 2023-24. In the fall the Clemson men's soccer team won the National Championship with a 2-1 win over Notre Dame. The Clemson women's soccer team also reached the Final Four before losing in the semifinals to eventual National Champion Florida State. The Tigers finished ranked No. 3 in the nation.
- The Clemson baseball team is currently ranked third in the nation in the latest D1 Baseball Poll. Clemson's softball team is currently ranked 15th in the nation by D1 Softball. The Clemson gymnastics team, in its first year, was chosen for the NCAA Tournament earlier this week.
- The Clemson football team finished the season ranked 22nd in the final AP poll after a 9-4 season that included a five game winning streak to end the season. Clemson, Arizona, Duke and Tennessee are the only schools to win a bowl game and reach the Sweet 16 of the NCAA men's basketball tournament.

Chase Hunter Playing His Best Basketball

- Chase Hunter is playing the best basketball of his career in the NCAA Tournament. The fifth year senior who played his first game at Clemson on November 5, 2019, has scored at least 18 points in each of the three NCAA Tournament games, the first streak of three consecutive 18-point scoring games of his career.
- Hunter had 21 points and six assists against New Mexico, then had 20 points and six assists against Baylor. That marked just the second time in his career he had consecutive 20 point scoring games.
- He has 59 points in the three games of the NCAA Tournament the most points in any three-game streak of his 132-game career.
- For the NCAA tournament Hunter is shooting 21-41 from the field, has averaged 19.3 point per game and has 17 assists against nine turnovers.

Hall Needs Seven Points for Season Scoring Mark

- Clemson senior center PJ Hall has 645 points this year in 35 games, an 18.4 average per game. Hall needs just seven points against Alabama to set the school record for points in a season. The existing record is 651 points by Horace Grant in 1986-87 and Bill Yarborough in 1954-55.
- Hall had 21 points in just 21 minutes in the first meeting between Clemson and Alabama earlier this year at Alabama.
- Hall's 18.4 scoring average is the best by a Clemson player since 2018-19 when Marquise Reed had a 19.4 average. Hall's figure this year is the third best over the last 24 seasons.

Schieffelin Rebound Total Among Clemson Best

- Ian Schieffelin had seven rebounds against Arizona and now has 329 for the season, a 9.4 average for his 35 games. Schieffelin's total is the best by a Clemson player since 1998-99 when Harold Jamison had 346. Schieffelin's rebound average is the second best by a Tiger over the last 15 years. The only average better was Hunter Tyson's 9.6 average last year. Tyson is in his rookie season with the Denver Nuggets.
- Schieffelin has 96 offensive rebounds this year and needs just four to become the first Tiger with 100 offensive rebounds since 2016-17 when Sidy Djitte had 116.
- Schieffelin has 10 double-doubles this year, the second most by a Clemson player in the last 15 years to reach that total. Hunter Tyson had 16 last season.

Football Powers Battle for Final Four Basketball Berth

- This will be the first meeting between Clemson and Alabama in the NCAA Basketball Tournament, but the two schools have met four times previously in the College Football Playoff, which started in 2014. The two teams are 2-2 against each other in the CFP with Clemson winning two of the three games that were National Championship Games.
- Alabama won the 2015 season National Championship by beating Clemson 45-40, then Clemson won the next season in the National Championship game 35-31 on a touchdown pass from Deshaun Watson to Hunter Renfrow with one second left, one of the most famous plays in Clemson football history.
- Alabama won a 2017 CFP semifinal game in the Sugar Bowl in 2017 by a 24-6 score. Alabama went on to win the National Championship.

Clemson Success in California

- Clemson has a 3-0 record in NCAA Tournament games in the state of California. That includes two wins in San Diego during the 2018 tournament, and the victory over Arizona in Los Angeles on Thursday night.
- Clemson is also 1-0 in College Football Playoff games in California, the aforementioned 44-18 win over Alabama in Santa Clara in the championship game at the end of the 2018 season.
