### CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has an 18-2 home record, lost at home against USC Upstate by a score of 9-5 on Tuesday night.
- The Tigers are averaging 8.2 runs per game and hitting .289 with a .507 slugging percentage, .408 on-base percentage and 34 steals.

- The pitching staff has a 4.07 ERA, .232 opponents' batting average and 2.54 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .969.

### NC STATE OVERVIEW

- NC State, which has a 2-8 road record and is averaging 7.7 runs per game, is led by 28th-year Head Coach Elliott Avent.
- The Wolfpack lost at UNCW 5-4 on Tuesday. They are hitting .288 and have a 6.73 ERA and .969 fielding percentage.
- Garrett Pennington is hitting .374 with 10 homers, Alec Makarewicz is batting .350 with 13 homers and Jacob Dudan has three saves.

### QUICK HITS

- Clemson, which hosted Florida State in March, is the only ACC team that has played less than two home conference series in 2024.
- Clemson's bullpen has an 18-2 record, nine saves, a 4.53 ERA, .221 opponents' batting average and 150 strikeouts in 139.0 innings pitched.
- Clemson pitchers are holding opponents to a .190 batting average with two outs, including 13-for-110 (.118) in the last 12 games.

### POLLS

- Clemson is ranked No. 2 in the nation by all five polls this week, its ninth weekly ranking in a row in 2024.
- The No. 2 ranking this season is Clemson's best since Collegiate Baseball ranked the Tigers No. 2 in the nation on May 28, 2018.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll in each of the last eight weeks in 2023. It has a current streak of 17 weeks in a row.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

## DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

## ACC STANDINGS

- Clemson is in first place in the ACC Atlantic Division standings with a 10-2 league mark.
- Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in first place.

## SERIES WIN STREAK

- Clemson has won all eight weekend series in 2024 and has a current streak of 15 regular-season weekend series wins in a row dating to 2023.
- It is Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 regular-season weekend series in a row from 2001 (5) to 2002 (10).
- Six of the 15 series wins were ACC road series.
- Eight of the 15 series wins were three-game sweeps, one was a two-game sweep of South Carolina (2024) and the other six were won 2-1.
- In the 14 three-game series, Clemson is 14-0 in the series finales.
- In the six series that Clemson won 2-1, five of the Tigers' losses in the series were in series openers.
- The last series loss for the Tigers came against No. 2 Wake Forest at Doug Kingsmore Stadium from March 30 to April 1, 2023.
- The Tiger record for the longest regular-season weekend series winning streak is 20, set from 1993 (1) to 1994 (11) to 1995 (8).
- Clemson won its last seven ACC regular-season series in 2023 and has won all four in 2024. It has an active streak of 11 in a row.
- It is Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 ACC regular-season series in a row from 1993 (1) to 1994 (8) to 1995 (6).
- Six of the ACC regular-season series wins were three-game sweeps and the other five were won 2-1. Clemson is 28-5 in the last 11 ACC series.
- Clemson lost its first game of the first series during the streak, meaning it is 28-4 in its last 32 ACC regular-season games.
- Clemson also went 4-0 in the 2023 ACC Tournament. Therefore, Clemson is 32-4 in its last 36 games against ACC teams.
- Clemson began playing three-game ACC weekend series in 1990.

## COMEBACK TIGERS

- Clemson has 16 come-from-behind wins among its 28 overall victories in 2024.
- Clemson has scored first in only 17 of its 32 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the fourth inning 10 times and is 8-2 in those 10 games.
- Clemson has trailed at the start of the eighth inning five times and is 3-2 in those five games.

- Clemson is 28-1 when scoring three or more runs in 2024. Its lone loss in that situation was a 9-5 setback against USC Upstate on April 9.
- Clemson trailed Kennesaw State 6-5 at home in the eighth inning before rallying for an 8-6 win on Feb. 24.
- Clemson trailed Notre Dame 3-1 in the eighth inning on the road before rallying for a 7-3 win on April 5.

## COMEBACK WINS AGAINST SEMINOLES

- Tiger fans experienced one of the most memorable series in program history when Clemson swept No. 7 Florida State at home on March 23, 24.
- Clemson rallied from deficits of four runs (1st inning), seven runs (9th inning) and nine runs (6th inning) in the games, respectively.
- The Tigers ended the games on runs of 15-1, 8-0 and 12-1, respectively, against Florida State, who entered the series with a 19-0 record.
- Therefore in those three games, Florida State combined for leads of 23-3, but Clemson finished the games on a combined run of 35-2.
- In the first game, Florida State scored four runs in the first inning, but the Tigers scored in five of the seven innings to win 15-5.
- In the second game, Florida State led 8-1 entering the ninth inning, but 11 of the 12 Tigers reached base and Clemson won 9-8.
- Jacob Hinderleider, who hit a three-run homer earlier in the ninth, hit a walkoff single after Blake Wright hit a game-tying grand slam.
- In the third game, Florida State led 11-2 until the Tigers scored five runs in the sixth and six runs in the seventh to take the lead.
- Wright hit another grand slam in the seventh inning to give Clemson the lead for good.
- Clemson hit .346 with 38 runs, four doubles, seven homers, 23 walks, five hit-by-pitches and a .485 on-base percentage in the series.
- Wright totaled three home runs and 12 RBIs in the series.
- It marked Clemson's first series sweep of the Seminoles since 2015 and its first home sweep of the Seminoles since 2010.

## GRAND MOMENTS

- Clemson has hit six grand slams in 2024 after hitting six grand slams in 2023.
- The Tiger record for grand slams in a season is eight, set in 2010.
- In the season opener against Xavier on Feb. 16, Clemson hit two grand slams (Alden Mathes, Nolan Nawrocki) to tie the school record.

# NOTES

- It was the third time Clemson hit two grand slams in a game, as it did so on March 3, 1991 (Louisiana) and March 7, 2010 (South Carolina).
- Jarren Purify hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-3 win against Presbyterian on Feb. 20 for his first career hit.
- Tristan Bissetta hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- Blake Wright hit grand slams in back-to-back wins over No. 7 Florida State at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on March 23,24.
- Wright's first grand slam tied the score in the ninth inning in Clemson's eight-run frame and 9-8 win.
- Wright's second grand slam in the seventh inning gave Clemson a 13-11 lead in its 14-12 win after the Tigers trailed 11-2 in the sixth.
- Clemson is 23-for-61 (.377) with six grand slams, three doubles and 75 RBIs with the bases loaded in 2024.

## CAPTAINS

- Billy Barlow, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Jacob Jarrell, Jimmy Obertop, Ty Olenchuk and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains.
- Wright was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2023.
- Joe Allen, Nolan Nawrocki, Rocco Reid and Will Taylor were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Aidan Knaak, Jarren Purify and Drew Titsworth were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

## BISSETTA BOLSTERING LINEUP

- Sophomore outfielder Tristan Bissetta received his chance to start in the lineup and has made the most of his opportunity.
- He is hitting .267 with three homers, a double, 11 RBIs, eight runs and a .400 on-base percentage in 18 games (12 starts).
- He did not start any of the first 12 games, but has started 12 of the last 20 games.
- He is hitting .357 with runners in scoring position.
- He hit his first two career homers in his first start of the season against UNC Greensboro on March 9.
- He hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- In his career, he is hitting .241 with two doubles, three homers, 12 RBIs, eight runs and a .362 on-base percentage in 30 games (15 starts).

## CANNARELLA CAN

- Sophomore outfielder Cam Cannarella has picked up in 2024 where he left off in 2023, when he was ACC Freshman-of-the-Year.
- He is hitting .331 with nine doubles, six homers, 31 RBIs, 30 runs and a .414 on-base percentage in 30 games.
- He has 13 multiple-hit games, including six three-hit games.
- He hit safely in each of his first eight games in 2024 and had a 17-game hitting streak dating to 2023.
- He had a 25-game on-base streak dating to 2023.
- In his career, he is hitting .369 with 25 doubles, three triples, 13 homers, 78 RBIs and 102 runs in 89 games.
- In his career, he has a .554 slugging percentage, .446 on-base percentage and 24 steals.

## DARDEN PITCHING EFFECTIVELY AGAIN

- Sophomore lefthander Ethan Darden emerged as a freshman in 2023 as a dependable weekend starter.
- He has picked up where he left off with consistent outings in 2024.
- He is 5-0 with a 3.90 ERA, a .257 opponents' batting average and 23 strikeouts in 27.2 innings pitched over 10 appearances (three starts).

- He is holding opponents to .071 with two outs.
- He has 41 groundball outs compared to 15 eight flyball outs.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of one-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on Feb. 27.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing five hits, no earned runs and no walks with five strikeouts to earn the win at Notre Dame on April 6.
- In his career, he is 8-2 with a 4.99 ERA, .265 opponents' batting average and 68 strikeouts in 83.0 innings pitched over 29 appearances.

## HINDERLEIDER MAKING A MOVE

- Jacob Hinderleider transferred to Clemson for his final season in 2024 and has made a successful transition.
- Not only is he one of the team's top hitters, he was the primary starter at first base early in 2024 after never having played there before.
- He has also taken over starting duties at shortstop since early April.
- He is hitting .330 with seven homers, a triple, eight doubles, 33 RBIs, 19 runs, a .420 on-base percentage and seven steals in 31 games.
- He has made 30 starts, 21 at first base, five at shortstop and four at third base.
- He is hitting .421 with two outs.
- He has 13 multiple-hit games and 12 multiple-RBI games.
- He is hitting .400 with four homers, five doubles, 16 RBIs and 10 runs in 12 ACC regular-season games.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak from March to April.

## HUGHES OFFERING RELIEF

- Sixth-year senior and graduate righthander Rob Hughes has had some impactful moments on the mound in 2024.
- He is 1-1 with three saves, a 7.15 ERA, .302 opponents' batting average and 12 strikeouts in 11.1 innings pitched over 11 appearances.
- He suffered an injury in 2022 that forced him to miss the entire season.
- In his three active seasons at Clemson, he is 2-2 with five saves, a 3.98 ERA and .233 opponents' batting average in 52.0 innings pitched.
- In his two seasons (2023,24) since returning from injury, he is 1-2 with five saves and a 3.77 ERA in 28.2 innings pitched over 23 outings.

## KNAAK OPENING THE DOOR

- Freshman righthander Aidan Knaak has stepped in to become one of the team's weekend starters.
- He is 2-0 with a 3.38 ERA, .218 opponents' batting average and 57 strikeouts against 14 walks in 45.1 innings pitched over eight starts.
- He leads the team in starts on the mound, innings pitched and strikeouts.
- Clemson has an 8-0 record in his eight starts.
- He is 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA, .204 opponents' batting average and 35 strikeouts against three walks in 25.1 innings pitched in four ACC starts.
- He has an 0.89 ERA, a .189 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts against one walk in 20.1 innings pitched over three road starts.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing two hits, no runs and one walk with 10 strikeouts to earn the win at Miami (Fla.) on March 30.

### MARCHAL RANKING AMONG BEST

- Senior righthander Matthew Marchal, a graduate transfer from Wofford, has been among the team's best and most consistent pitchers in 2024.
- With the injury to Tristan Smith, he has made a start on the mound each of the last two weekends.
- He is 4-0 with a 3.18 ERA, .244 opponents' batting average and 20 strikeouts against 10 walks in 22.2 innings pitched over 10 appearances.
- He is holding opponents to .111 with two outs.

### MATHES PUTTING UP NUMBERS

- Senior outfielder Alden Mathes transferred in from Richmond and has made an immediate impact.
- He's hitting .324 with six homers, a triple, four doubles, 21 RBIs, 32 runs, a .469 on-base percentage and three steals in 31 games in 2024.
- He has 25 walks and six hit-by-pitches against only 23 strikeouts.
- He hit a grand slam in his first plate appearance as a Tiger against Xavier on Feb. 16.
- He hit two homers against Presbyterian at Greenville, S.C. on March 20.
- He has made several highlight-reel catches in the outfield, including one in each of Clemson's close wins at No. 3 Duke in March.

### NAWROCKI HITTING HARD

- Redshirt freshman infielder Nolan Nawrocki has patiently waited his turn to enter the lineup and has made the most of his opportunities.
- He has been a starter at third base, but has missed 12 games this season due in large part to medical reasons.
- He is hitting .290 with four homers, two doubles, 18 RBIs, 15 runs, a .367 on-base percentage and four steals in 20 games in 2024.
- He had at least one hit in each of his first 13 career games.
- He is hitting .325 with runners on base and .400 with runners in scoring position.
- His solo homer in the sixth inning gave Clemson the lead for good in its 5-4 win over No. 12 South Carolina on March 3.

### SMITH ENTERS WEEKEND ROTATION

- Sophomore lefthander Tristan Smith was a reliever and spot starter as a freshman in 2023, but has emerged as a weekend starter in 2024.
- He has missed the last three weeks due to injury.
- He is 2-0 with a 2.55 ERA, .179 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts against 11 walks in 24.2 innings pitched over five starts.
- He allowed only three hits, one run and one walk with nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched against No. 12 South Carolina on March 2.
- He allowed just four hits, one earned run and two walks with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched to earn the win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- In his career, he is 2-1 with a 3.67 ERA, .199 opponents' batting average and 79 strikeouts in 56.1 innings pitched over 29 appearances.

### WRIGHT ON TIME

- Senior infielder Blake Wright is having his best season as a Tiger.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- The co-captain has split time as the starter at third base (18 starts) and second base (14 starts) in 2024.

- He is hitting .314 with 13 homers, a triple, five doubles, 44 RBIs, 40 runs and a .650 slugging percentage in 32 games.
- He is hitting .392 with runners in scoring position and .346 with runners on base.
- He has 12 multiple-hit games, including five three-hit games and a four-hit game.
- He has 12 multiple-RBI games.
- He has a .959 fielding percentage, committing only four errors in 98 chances.
- He is the only Tiger to play all 32 games in 2024.
- He had a streak of at least one run, hit and RBI in 10 straight games in March.
- He went 4-for-4 with three RBIs and three runs against Winthrop on March 19.
- He hit a Clemson-record-tying three homers with six RBIs against Presbyterian at Greenville, S.C. on March 20.
- He became the 17th Tiger in history to hit three home runs in a game.
- He and Will Taylor, who hit three homers vs. USC Upstate on Feb. 27, became the first Tiger duo with three-homer games in a year since 1987.
- It was only the second time that feat was accomplished, as Steve Baucom and Chuck Baldwin did so in 1987.
- He hit a grand slam in the ninth inning to tie the score in the second game of a doubleheader against No. 7 Florida State on March 23.
- He hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning against No. 7 Florida State on March 24.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 25, as he was 13-for-22 (.591) with six homers, 21 RBIs, 10 runs and two walks in five games.
- He also earned national player-of-the-week honors by D1Baseball, NCBWA and Perfect Game.
- In his career, he is hitting .289 with 26 doubles, a triple, 33 homers, 134 RBIs, 109 runs and nine steals in 148 games (141 starts).

- Dominic Leone, Carson Spiers and Spencer Strider have played in an MLB game in 2024.
- Leone, who had a 16-8 career record at Clemson, made his major league debut with the Mariners in 2014.

- Strider, who had a 5-2 record in his two active seasons (2018,20) at Clemson, was a 2023 MLB All-Star Game selection.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2020 had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
- Clemson has had at least one former Tiger play in an MLB game each of the last 69 years (streak started in 1956).
- Clemson has had multiple former Tigers play in an MLB game each of the last 51 years (streak started in 1974).
- Clemson set a school record with 12 former Tigers in the majors in 2021, breaking the previous record of eight.
