## **CLEMSON OVERVIEW**

- Clemson, which has a 19-4 home record, won one of three games at home against NC State last weekend.
- The Tigers are averaging 7.9 runs per game and hitting .285 with a .493 slugging percentage, .404 on-base percentage and 35 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 3.89 ERA, .229 opponents' batting average and 2.54 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .966.

· Charlotte, which has a 4-8 road record and is averaging 5.9 runs per game, is led by fifth-year Head Coach Robert Woodard.

## **DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM**



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse. coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

## · Overall in the ACC standings, Clemson is in second place, behind first-place North Carolina (14-4).

#### **SERIES WIN STREAK**

- Clemson won its first eight weekend series in 2024 and had a streak of 15 regular-season weekend series wins in a row dating to 2023.
- The streak ended when NC State won two of three games at Clemson from April 12-14.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 regular-season weekend series in a row from 2001 (5) to 2002 (10).
- Six of the 15 series wins were ACC road series.
- · Eight of the 15 series wins were three-game sweeps, one was a two-game sweep of South Carolina (2024) and the other six were won 2-1.
- In the 14 three-game series. Clemson was 14-0 in the series finales. Clemson has an active streak of 16 wins in weekend series finales.
- Clemson won its last seven ACC regular-season series in 2023 and won its first four in 2024. It had a streak of 11 ACC series in a row.
- It was Clemson's longest such streak since winning 15 ACC regular-season series in a row from 1993 (1) to 1994 (8) to 1995 (6).
- Six of the ACC regular-season series wins were threegame sweeps and the other five were won 2-1. Clemson is 29-7 in the last 12 ACC series.
- Clemson went 4-0 in the 2023 ACC Tournament. Therefore, Clemson is 33-6 in its last 39 games against ACC teams.
- Clemson began playing three-game ACC weekend series in 1990.

## **COMEBACK TIGERS**

- Clemson has 16 come-from-behind wins among its 29 overall victories in 2024.
- Clemson has scored first in only 18 of its 35 games and is 17-1 in those 18 games.
- . Clemson has trailed at the start of the fourth inning 11 times and is 8-3 in those 11 games.
- · Clemson has trailed at the start of the eighth inning seven times and is 3-4 in those seven games
- Clemson is 24-1 when scoring six or more runs in 2024. Its lone loss in that situation was an 11-8 setback against NC State on April 12.
- Clemson trailed Kennesaw State 6-5 at home in the eighth inning before rallying for an 8-6 win on Feb. 24.
- Clemson trailed Notre Dame 3-1 in the eighth inning on the road before rallying for a 7-3 win on April 5.

#### **COMEBACK WINS AGAINST SEMINOLES**

- Tiger fans experienced one of the most memorable series in program history when Clemson swept No. 7 Florida State at home on March 23,24.
- Clemson rallied from deficits of four runs (1st inning), seven runs (9th inning) and nine runs (6th inning) in the games, respectively.
- The Tigers ended the games on runs of 15-1, 8-0 and 12-1, respectively, against Florida State, who entered the series with a 19-0 record.
- Therefore in those three games, Florida State combined for leads of 23-3, but Clemson finished the games on a combined run of 35-2.
- In the first game, Florida State scored four runs in the first inning, but the Tigers scored in five of the seven innings to win 15-5.
- In the second game, Florida State led 8-1 entering the ninth inning, but 11 of the 12 Tigers reached base and Clemson won 9-8.
- Jacob Hinderleider, who hit a three-run homer earlier in the ninth, hit a walkoff single after Blake Wright hit a game-tying grand slam.
- In the third game, Florida State led 11-2 until the Tigers scored five runs in the sixth and six runs in the seventh to take the lead.
- Wright hit another grand slam in the seventh inning to give Clemson the lead for good.
- Clemson hit .346 with 38 runs, four doubles, seven homers, 23 walks, five hit-by-pitches and a .485 onbase percentage in the series.
- Wright totaled three homers and 12 RBIs in the series.
- It marked Clemson's first series sweep of the Seminoles since 2015 and its first home sweep of the Seminoles since 2010.

#### **GRAND MOMENTS**

- · Clemson has hit six grand slams in 2024 after hitting six grand slams in 2023.
- The Tiger record for grand slams in a season is eight, set in 2010.
- In the season opener against Xavier on Feb. 16, Clemson hit two grand slams (Alden Mathes, Nolan Nawrocki) to tie the school record.
- It was the third time Clemson hit two grand slams in a game, as it did so on March 3, 1991 (Louisiana) and March 7, 2010 (South Carolina).
- Jarren Purify hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-3 win against Presbyterian on Feb. 20 for his first career hit.
- Tristan Bissetta hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- Blake Wright hit grand slams in back-to-back wins over No. 7 Florida State at home on March 23,24.

## **NOTES**

- Wright's first grand slam tied the score in the ninth inning in Clemson's eight-run frame and 9-8 win.
- Wright's second grand slam in the seventh inning gave Clemson a 13-11 lead in its 14-12 win after the Tigers trailed 11-2 in the sixth.
- Clemson is 25-for-66 (.379) with six grand slams, three doubles and 78 RBIs with the bases loaded in 2024.

#### **CAPTAINS**

- Billy Barlow, Nick Clayton, Rob Hughes, Jacob Jarrell, Jimmy Obertop, Ty Olenchuk and Blake Wright were voted team co-captains.
- Wright was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2023.
- Joe Allen, Nolan Nawrocki, Rocco Reid and Will Taylor were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Aidan Knaak, Jarren Purify and Drew Titsworth were voted rising leaders (underclassmen).

## **BISSETTA BOLSTERING LINEUP**

- Sophomore outfielder Tristan Bissetta received his chance to start in the lineup and has made the most of his opportunity.
- He is hitting .277 with three homers, a double, 11 RBIs, eight runs and a .404 on-base percentage in 20 games (12 starts).
- He did not start any of the first 12 games, but has started 12 of the last 23 games.
- He is hitting .375 with runners in scoring position.
- He hit his first two career homers in his first start of the season against UNC Greensboro on March 9.
- He hit a grand slam in Clemson's 8-7 win at No. 3 Duke on March 16.
- In his career, he is hitting .250 with two doubles, three homers, 12 RBIs, eight runs and a .366 on-base percentage in 32 games (15 starts).

#### **CANNARELLA CAN**

- Sophomore outfielder Cam Cannarella has picked up in 2024 where he left off in 2023, when he was ACC Freshman-of-the-Year
- He is hitting .319 with nine doubles, six homers, 32 RBIs, 31 runs and a .400 on-base percentage in 33 games.
- He has 14 multiple-hit games, including six three-hit games.
- He hit safely in each of his first eight games in 2024 and had a 17-game hitting streak dating to 2023.
- He had a 25-game on-base streak dating to 2023.
- In his career, he is hitting .363 with 25 doubles, three triples, 13 homers, 79 RBIs and 103 runs in 92 games.
- In his career, he has a .542 slugging percentage, .440 on-base percentage and 24 steals.

## **DARDEN PITCHING EFFECTIVELY AGAIN**

- Sophomore lefthander Ethan Darden emerged as a freshman in 2023 as a dependable weekend starter.
- He has picked up where he left off with consistent outings in 2024.
- He is 5-1 with a 3.19 ERA, .241 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts in 36.2 innings pitched over 11 appearances (four starts).
- He has allowed only seven walks and is holding opponents to .079 with two outs.
- He has 52 groundball outs compared to 24 eight flyball outs.
- He pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of one-hit ball with four strikeouts to earn the win against USC Upstate on Feb. 27.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing five hits, no earned runs and no walks with five strikeouts to earn the win at Notre Dame on April 6.

- He pitched a complete game against NC State on April 13, the first by a Tiger since 2021.
- In 9.0 innings pitched, he allowed just seven hits, one earned run and no walks with five strikeouts in throwing 105 pitches (80 strikes).
- In his career, he is 8-3 with a 4.60 ERA, .258 opponents' batting average and 73 strikeouts in 92.0 innings pitched over 30 appearances.

#### **HINDERLEIDER MAKING A MOVE**

- Jacob Hinderleider transferred to Clemson for his final season in 2024 and has made a successful transition.
- Not only is he one of the team's top hitters, he was the primary starter at first base early in 2024 after never having played there before.
- He has also taken over starting duties at shortstop since early April.
- He is hitting .323 with seven homers, a triple, eight doubles, 34 RBIs, 21 runs, a .410 on-base percentage and seven steals in 34 games.
- He has made 33 starts, 21 at first base, eight at shortstop and four at third base.
- He is hitting .400 with two outs.
- He has 14 multiple-hit games and 12 multiple-RBI games.
- He is hitting .371 with four home runs, five doubles, 17 RBIs and 12 runs in 15 ACC regular-season contests this season.
- He had an 11-game hitting streak from March to April.

## **HUGHES OFFERING RELIEF**

- Sixth-year senior and graduate righthander Rob Hughes has had some impactful moments on the mound in 2024
- He is 1-1 with three saves, a 7.15 ERA, .302 opponents' batting average and 12 strikeouts in 11.1 innings pitched over 11 appearances.
- He suffered an injury in 2022 that forced him to miss the entire season.
- In his three active seasons at Clemson, he is 2-2 with five saves, a 3.98 ERA and .233 opponents' batting average in 52.0 innings pitched.
- In his two seasons (2023,24) since returning from injury, he is 1-2 with five saves and a 3.77 ERA in 28.2 innings pitched over 23 outings.

## **KNAAK OPENING THE DOOR**

- Freshman righthander Aidan Knaak has stepped in to become one of the team's weekend starters.
- He is 3-0 with a 2.87 ERA, .201 opponents' batting average and 67 strikeouts against 15 walks in 53.1 innings pitched over nine starts.
- He leads the team in starts on the mound, innings pitched and strikeouts.
- Clemson has a 9-0 record in his nine starts.
- He is 2-0 with a 2.16 ERA, .179 opponents' batting average and 45 strikeouts against four walks in 33.1 innings pitched in five ACC starts.
- He has an 0.89 ERA, a .189 opponents' batting average and 28 strikeouts against one walk in 20.1 innings pitched over three road starts.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing two hits, no runs and one walk with 10 strikeouts to earn the win at Miami (Fla.) on March 30.
- He pitched 7.0 innings, allowing three hits, one earned run and no walks with nine strikeouts at Notre Dame on April 7.
- He did not allow a hit until the seventh inning and earned ACC Co-Pitcher-of-the-Week honors for his efforts at Notre Dame.
- He became the first Tiger freshman to earn ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors since 2016 and the first Tiger first-year freshman since 2013.

## **HEAD COACH ERIK BAKICH**

- Sophomore lefthander Tristan Smith was a reliever and spot starter as a freshman in 2023, but has emerged as a weekend starter in 2024.

- He is 2-0 with a 2.55 ERA, .179 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts against 11 walks in 24.2 innings pitched over five starts.

- Senior infielder Blake Wright is having his best season as a Tiger.
- He was one of 45 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- The co-captain has split time as the starter at third base (21 starts) and second base (14 starts) in 2024.
- He is hitting .322 with 14 homers, a triple, five doubles, 45 RBIs, 41 runs and a .651 slugging percentage in 35 games.
- He is hitting .377 with runners in scoring position and .337 with runners on base.
- He has 13 multiple-hit games, including six three-hit games and a four-hit game.
- He has 12 multiple-RBI games.
- He has a .952 fielding percentage, committing only five errors in 105 chances.
- He is the only Tiger to play all 35 games in 2024.
- He had a streak of at least one run, hit and RBI in 10 straight games in March.
- He went 4-for-4 with three RBIs and three runs against Winthrop on March 19.
- He hit a Clemson-record-tying three homers with six RBIs against Presbyterian at Greenville, S.C. on March 20
- He became the 17th Tiger in history to hit three home runs in a game.
- He and Will Taylor, who hit three homers vs. USC Upstate on Feb. 27, became the first Tiger duo with three-homer games in a year since 1987.
- It was only the second time that feat was accomplished, as Steve Baucom and Chuck Baldwin did so in 1987.
- He hit a grand slam in the ninth inning to tie the score in the second game of a doubleheader against No. 7 Florida State on March 23.
- He hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning against No. 7 Florida State on March 24.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on March 25, as he was 13-for-22 (.591) with six homers, 21 RBIs, 10 runs and two walks in five games.
